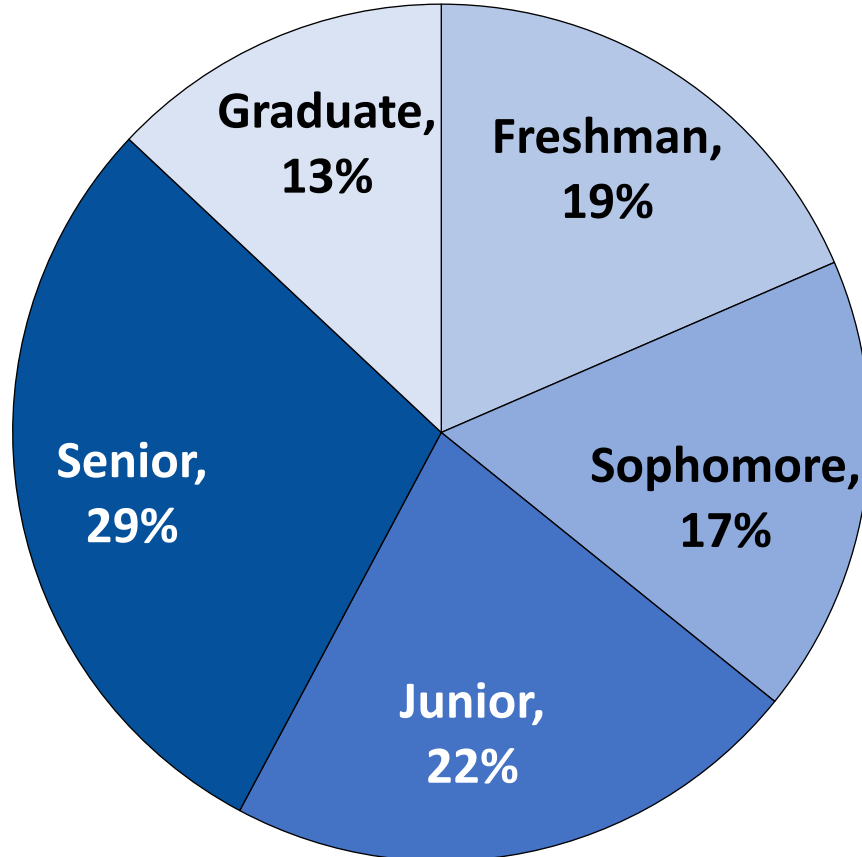
Student Campus Climate Survey, Spring 2020 Overview

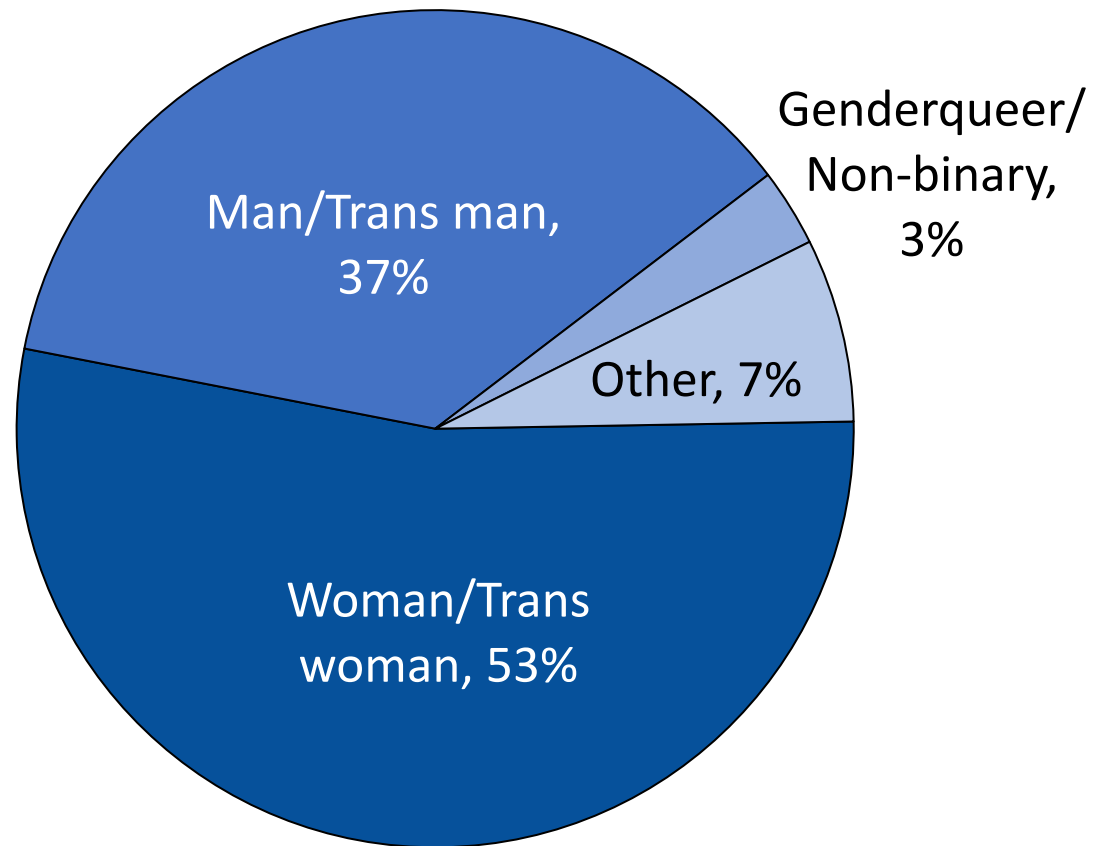

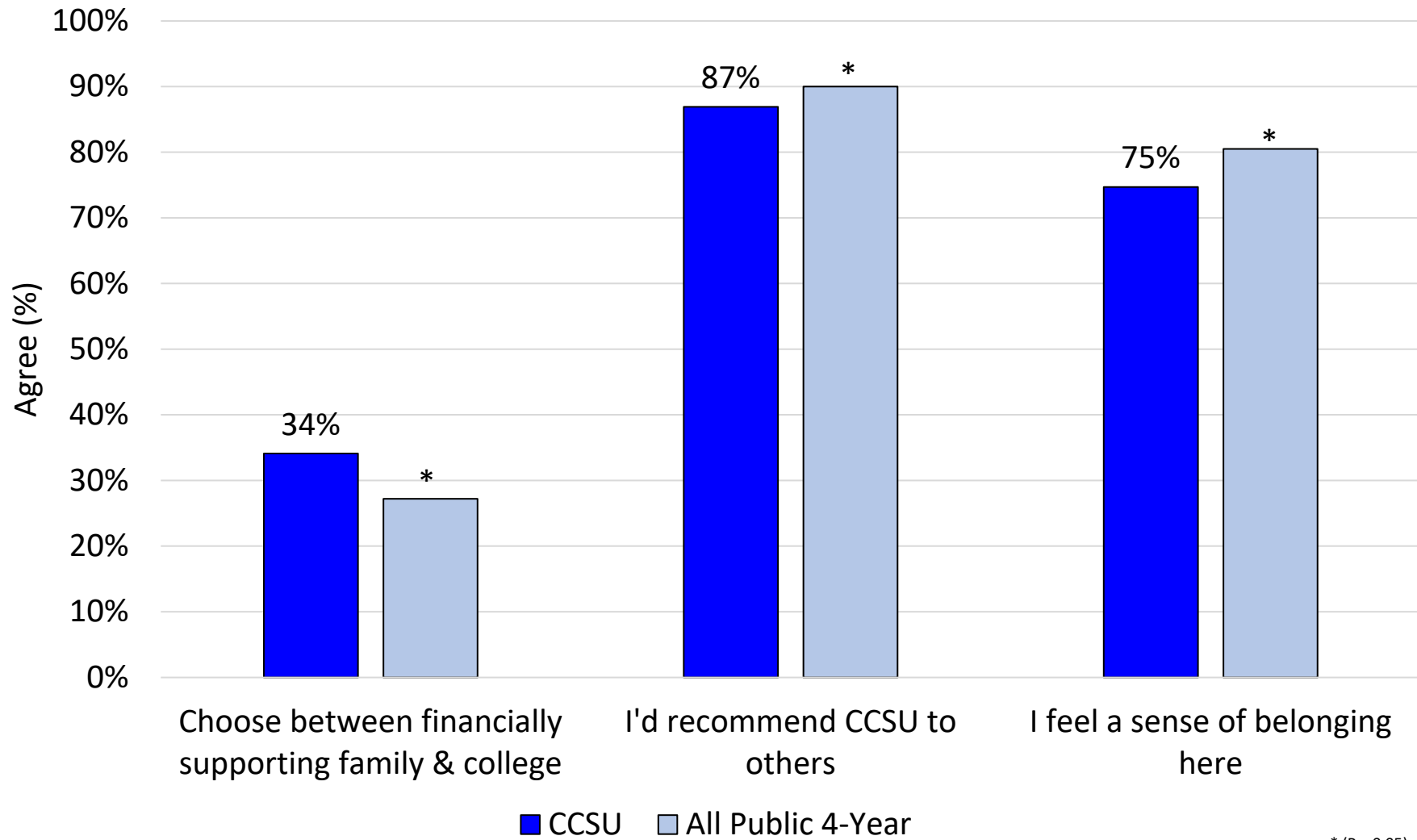

CCSU Student - Level of Agreement About this Institution (Strongly Agree/Agree)

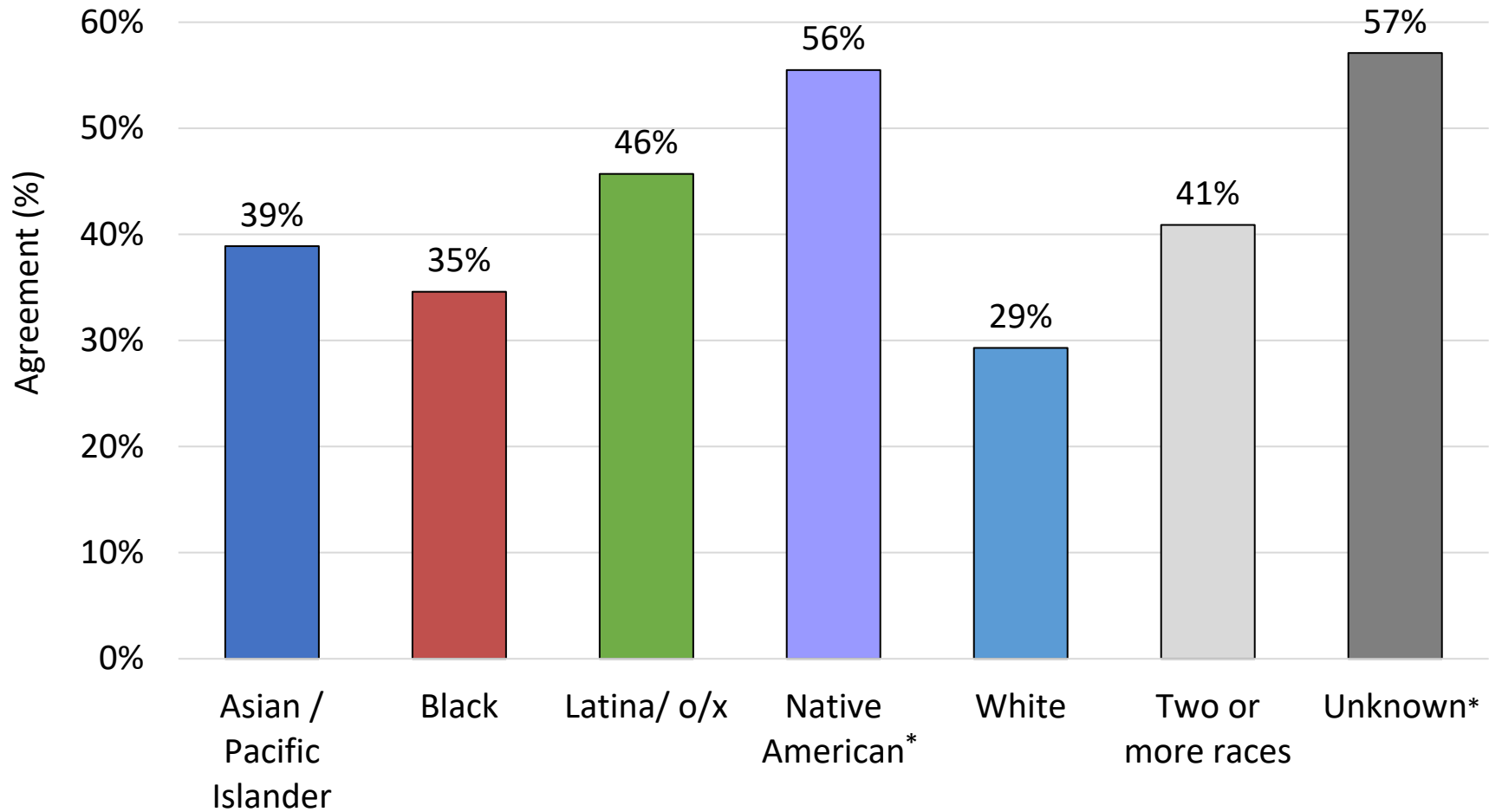

CCSU Student - Level of Agreement about College (Strongly Agree/Agree)

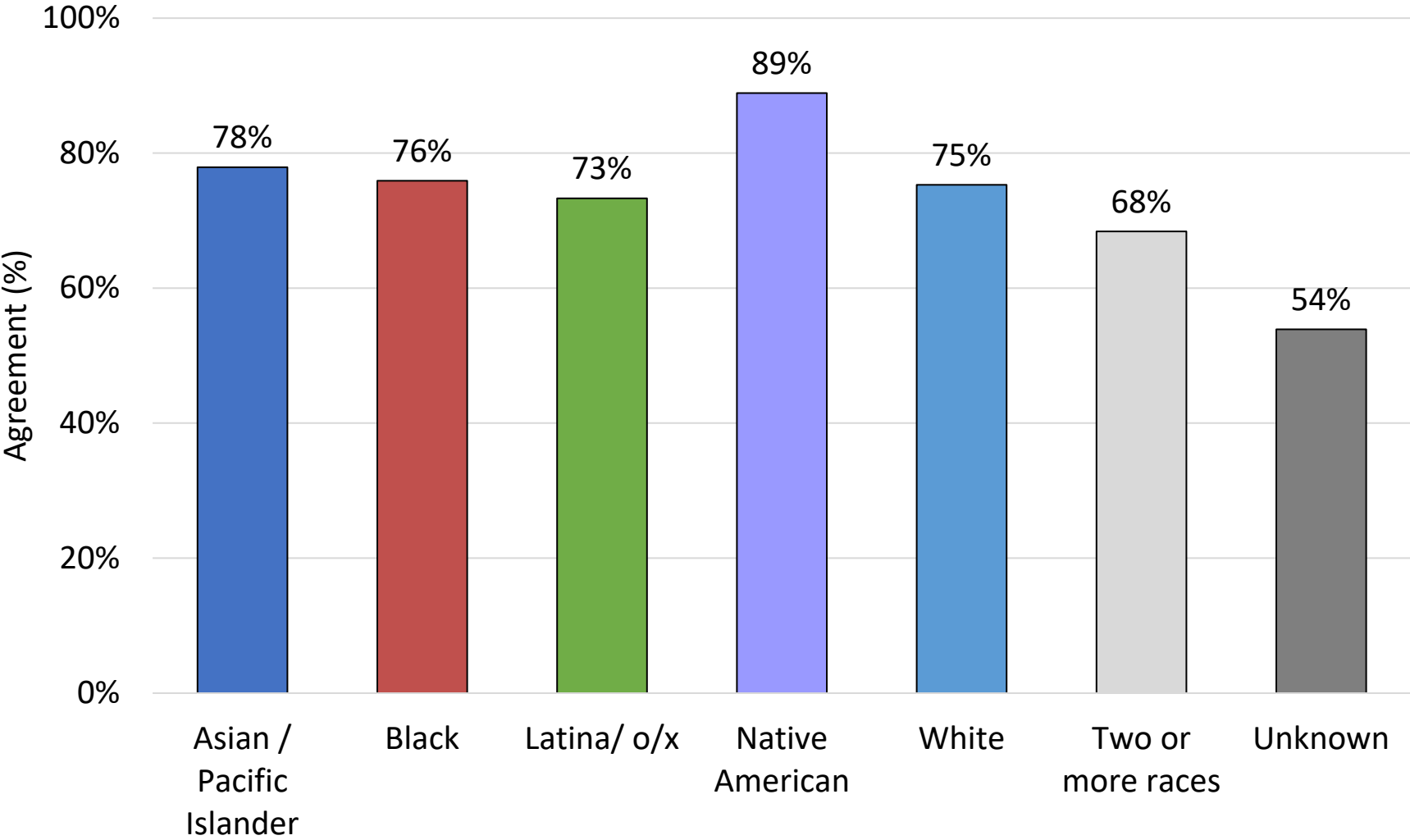


I may have to Choose Between Financially Supporting My Family and Going to College (Strongly Agree/Agree)

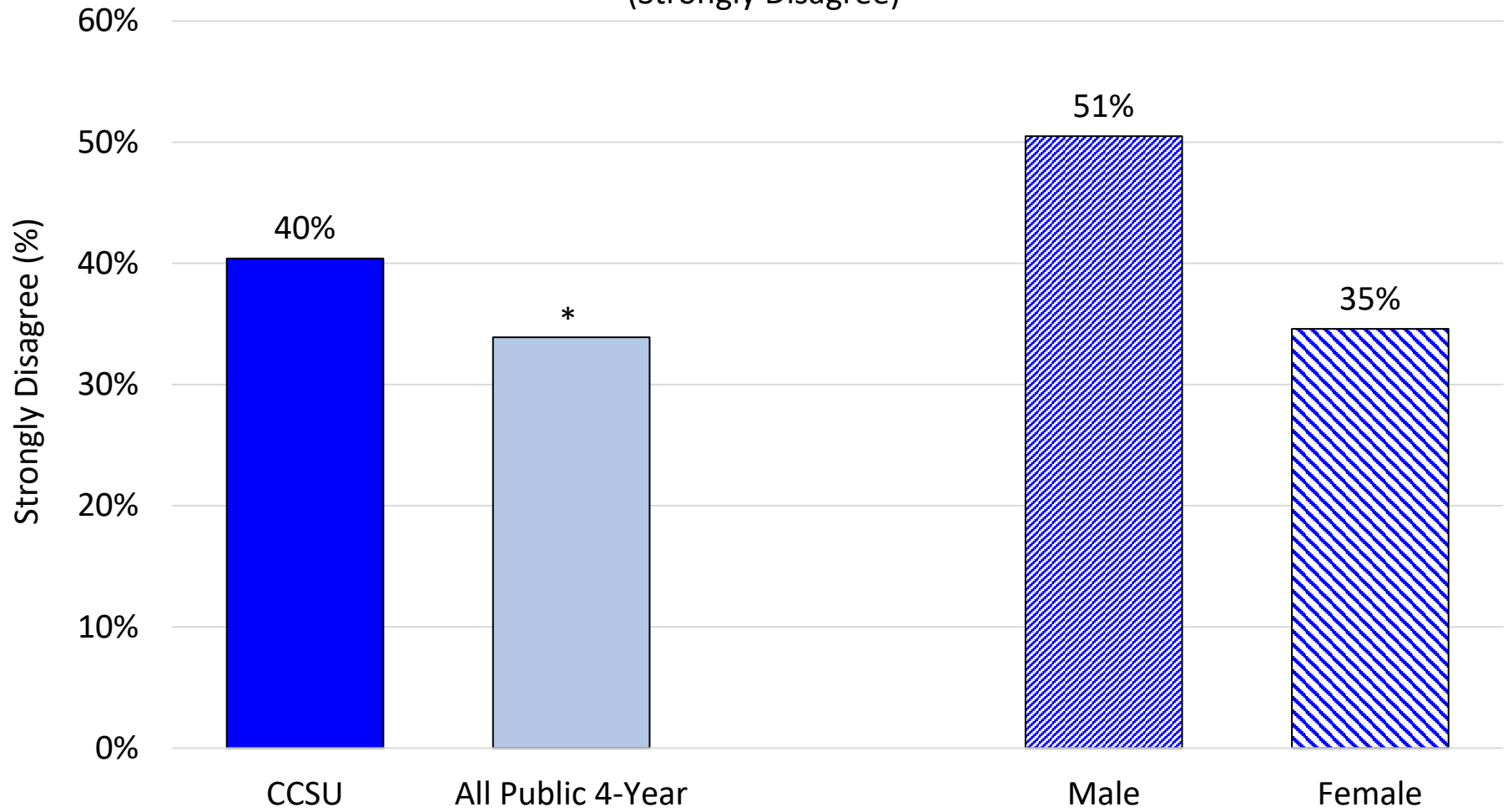


I Feel a Sense of Belonging to this Campus

(Strongly Agree/Agree)

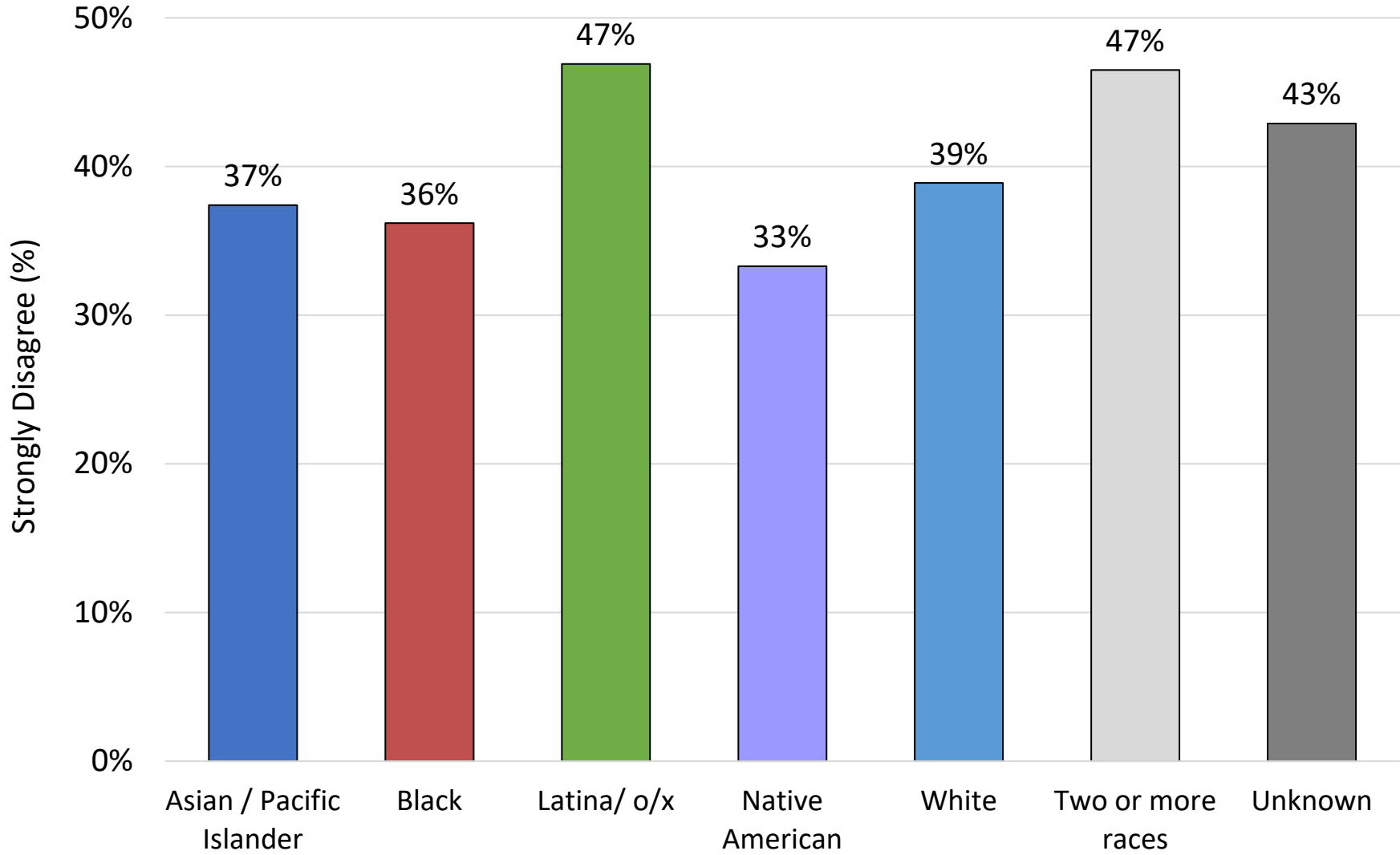


I feel unsafe on this campus (Strongly Disagree)



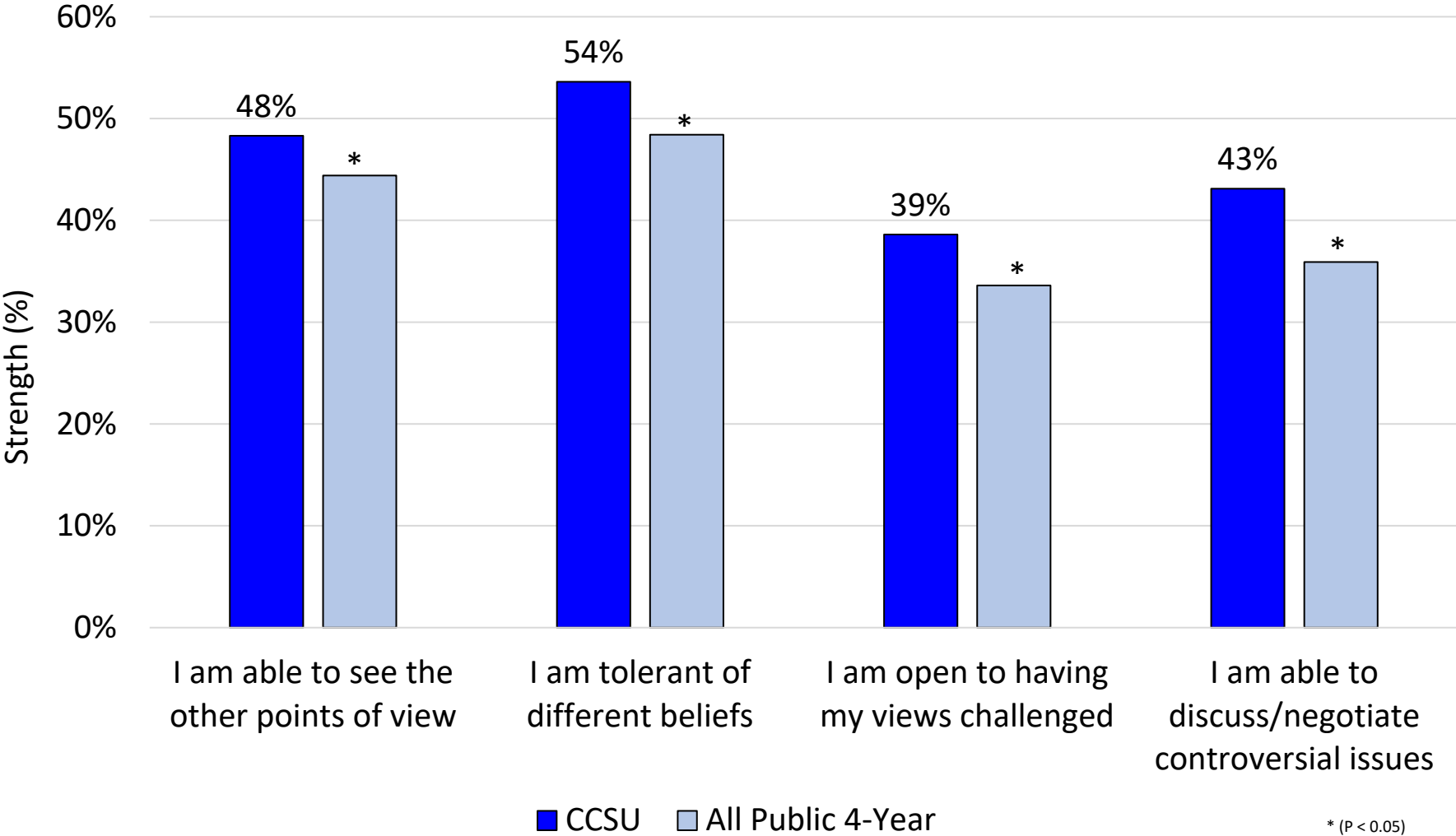

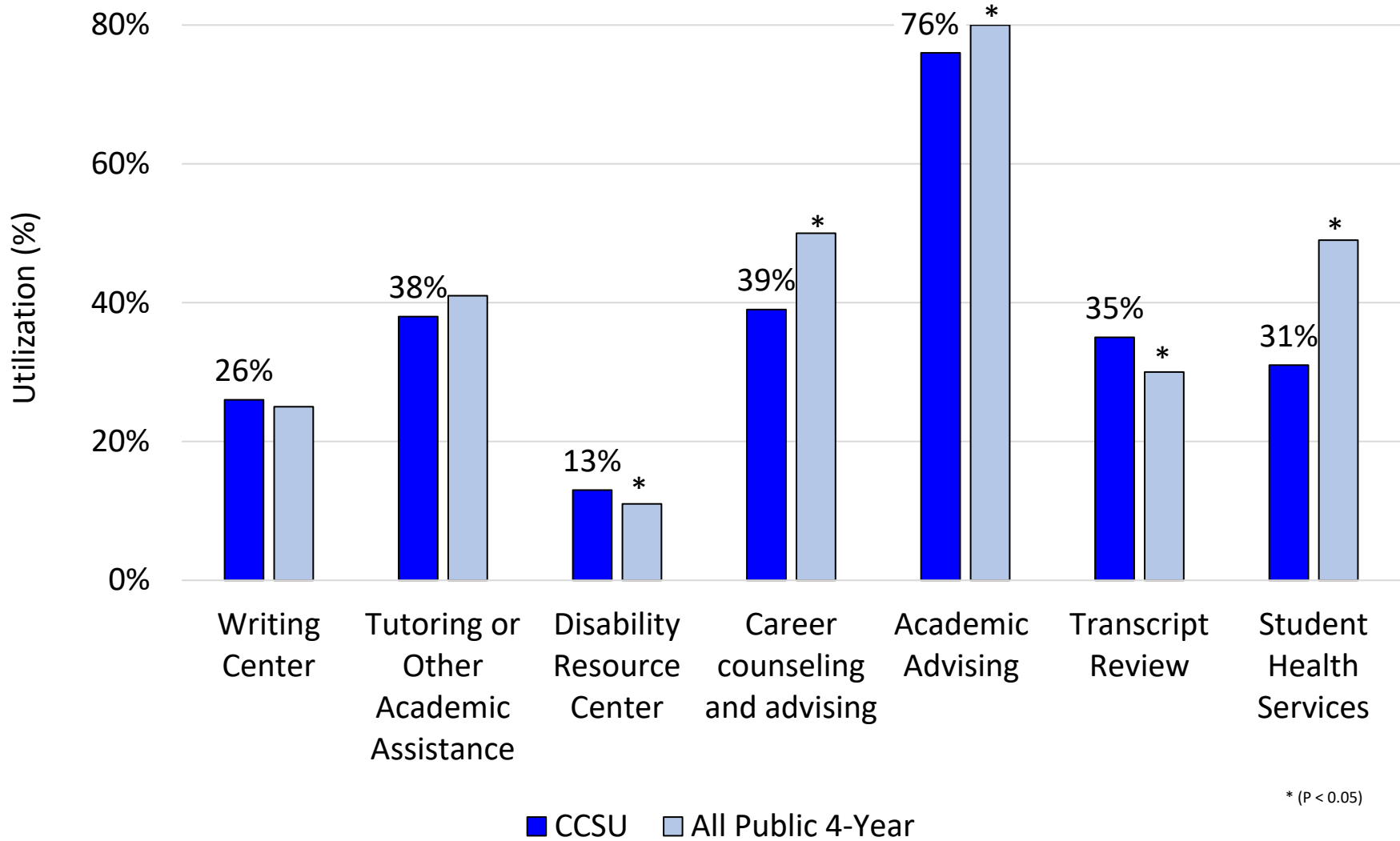

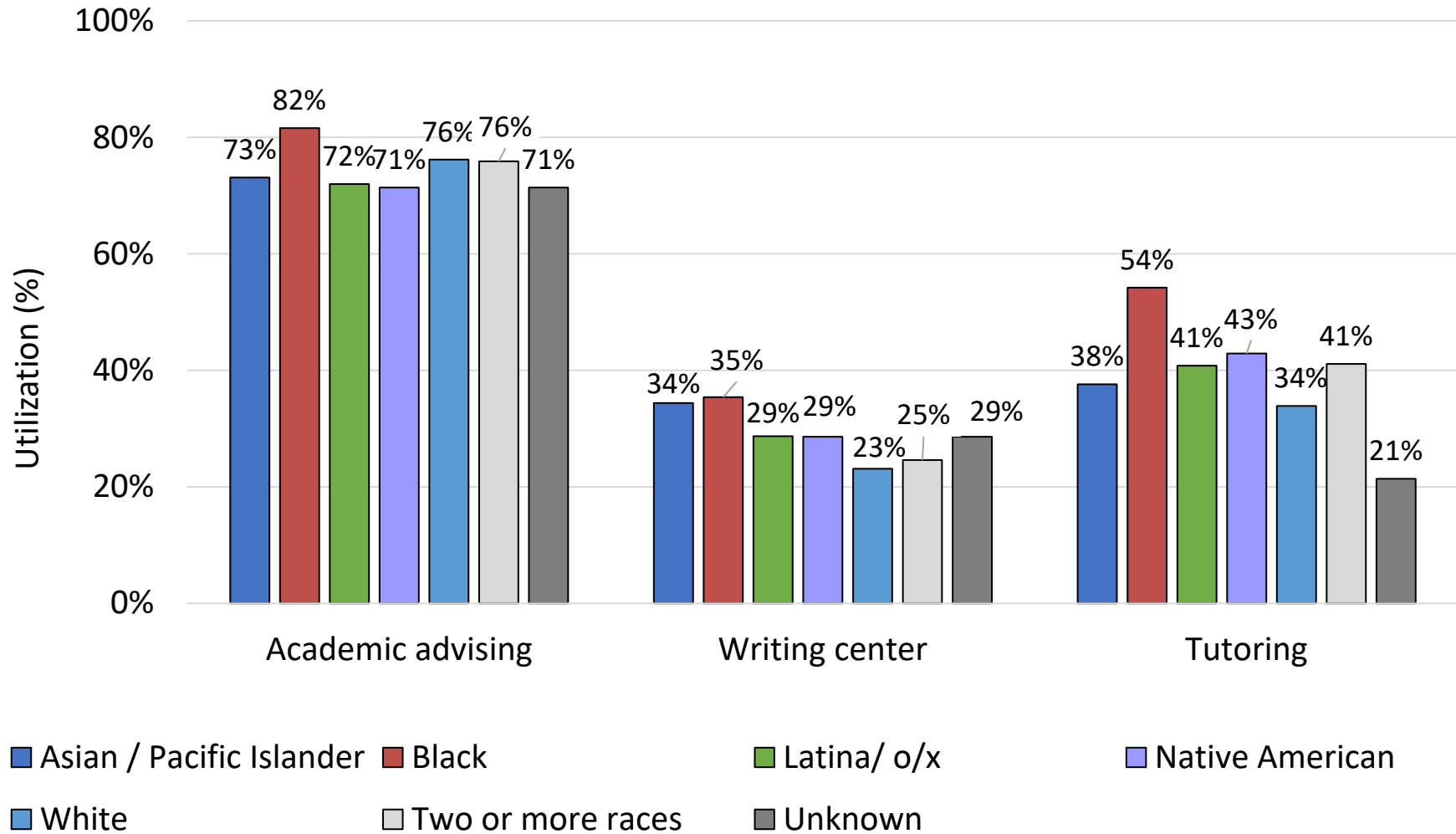
CCSU Student Attributes and Strengths (A Major Strength)

(Frequently/Occasionally)

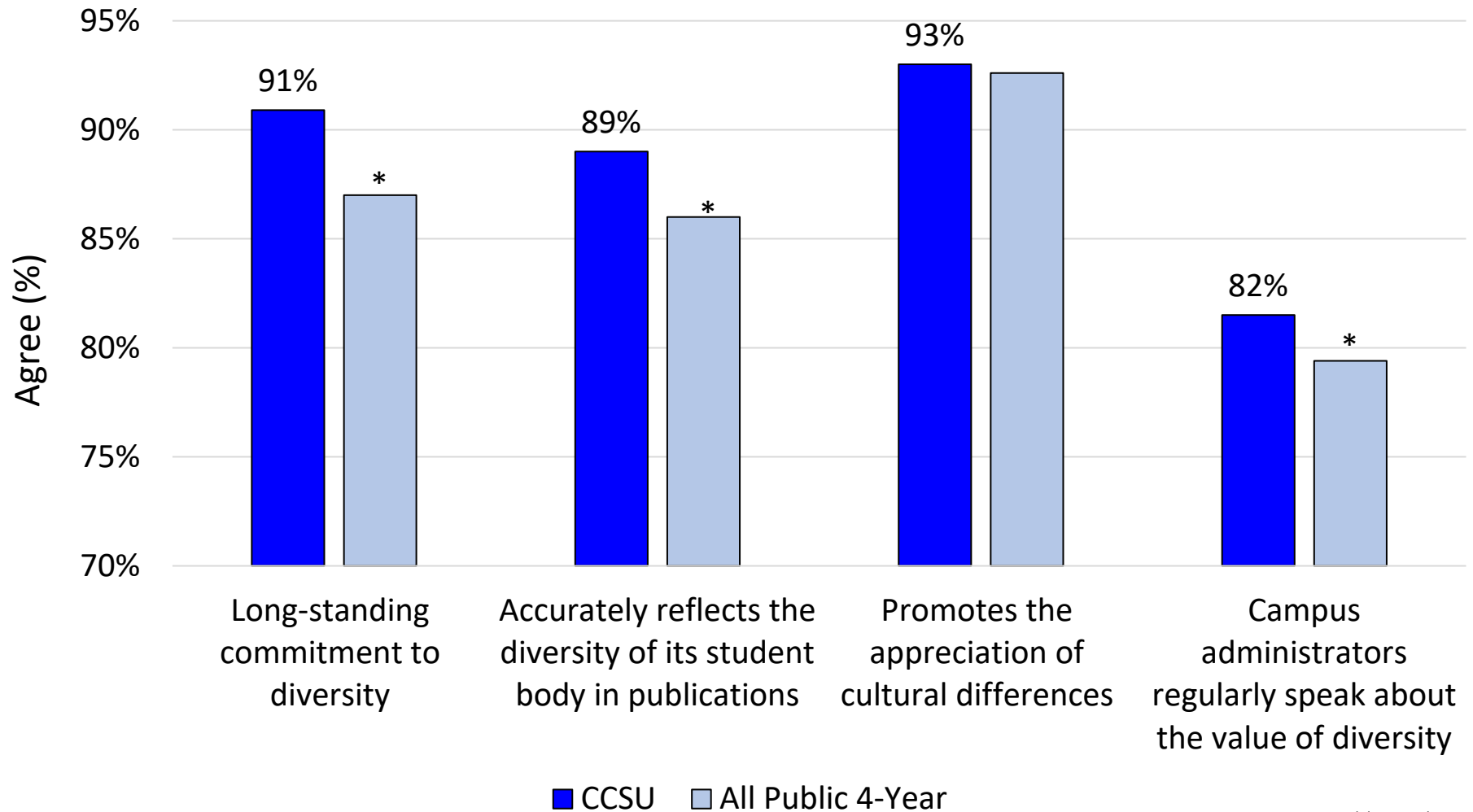

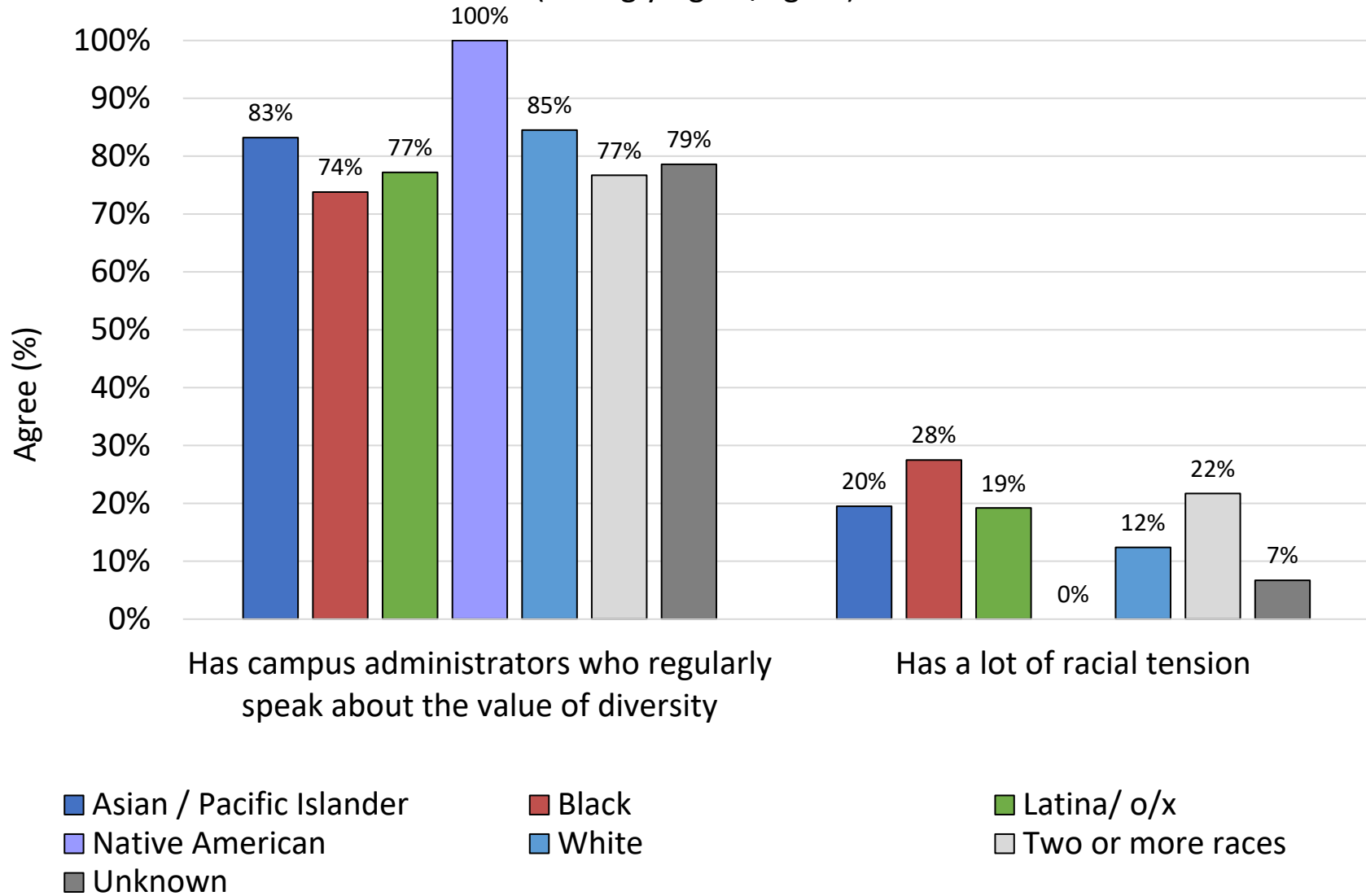

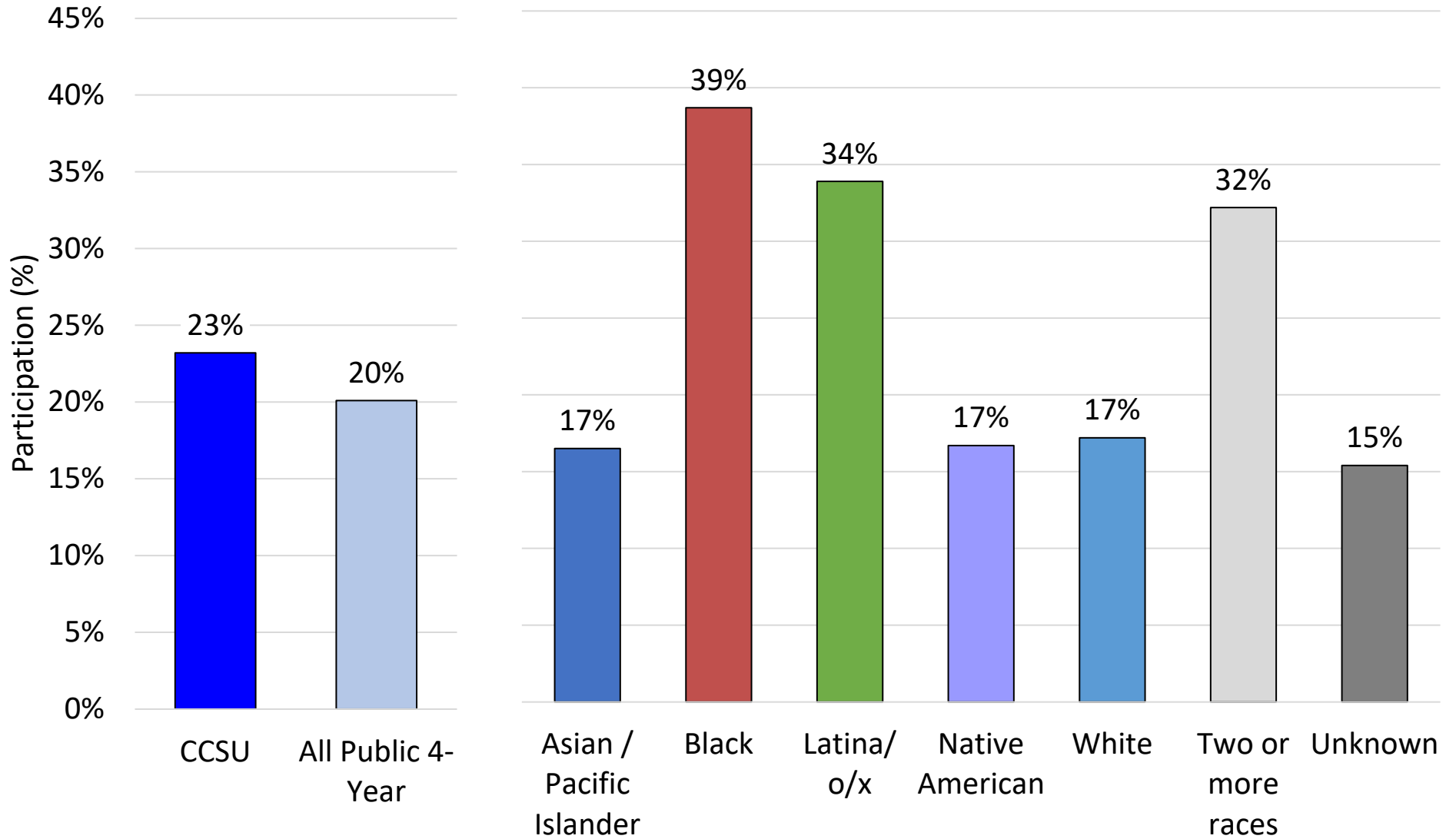
CCSU Student Thoughts about Diversity at Central (Strongly Agree/Agree)



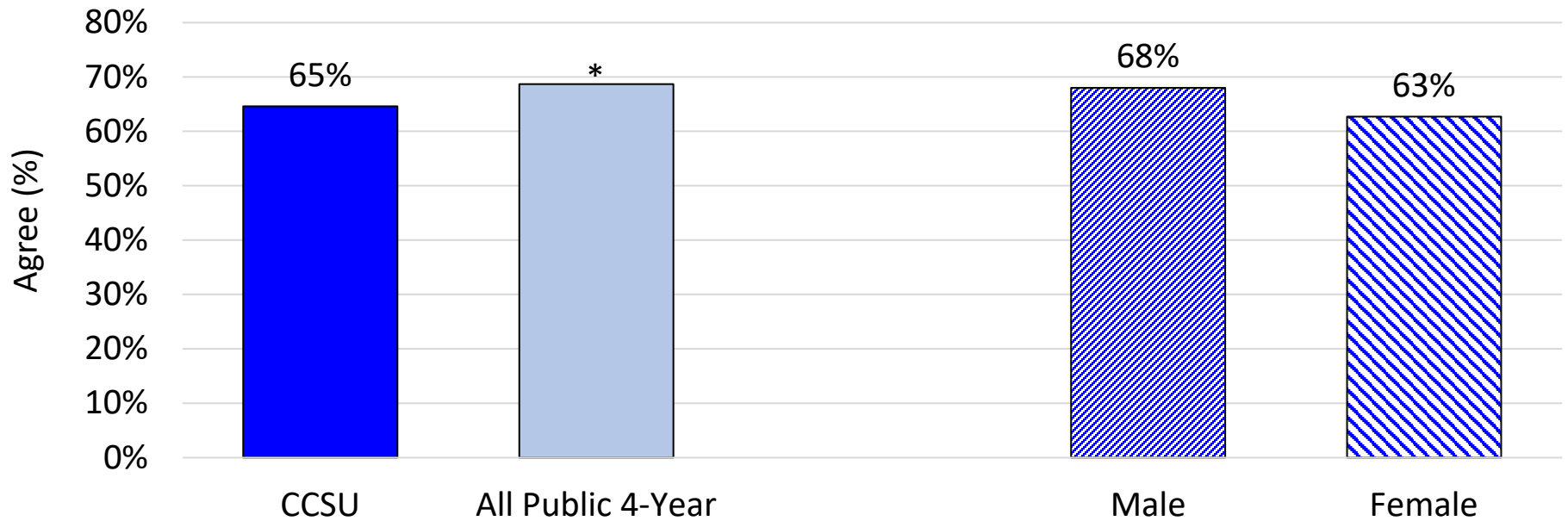

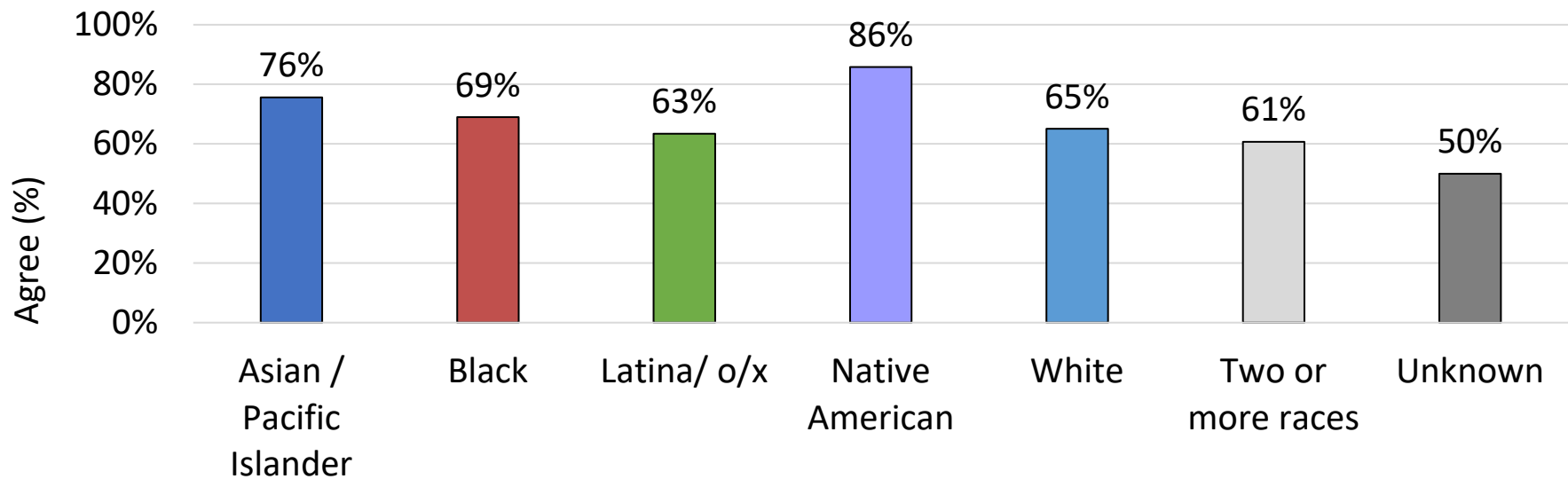
CCSU Student Participation in Campus Discussions on Race/Ethnic Issues (Very Often/Often/Sometimes)



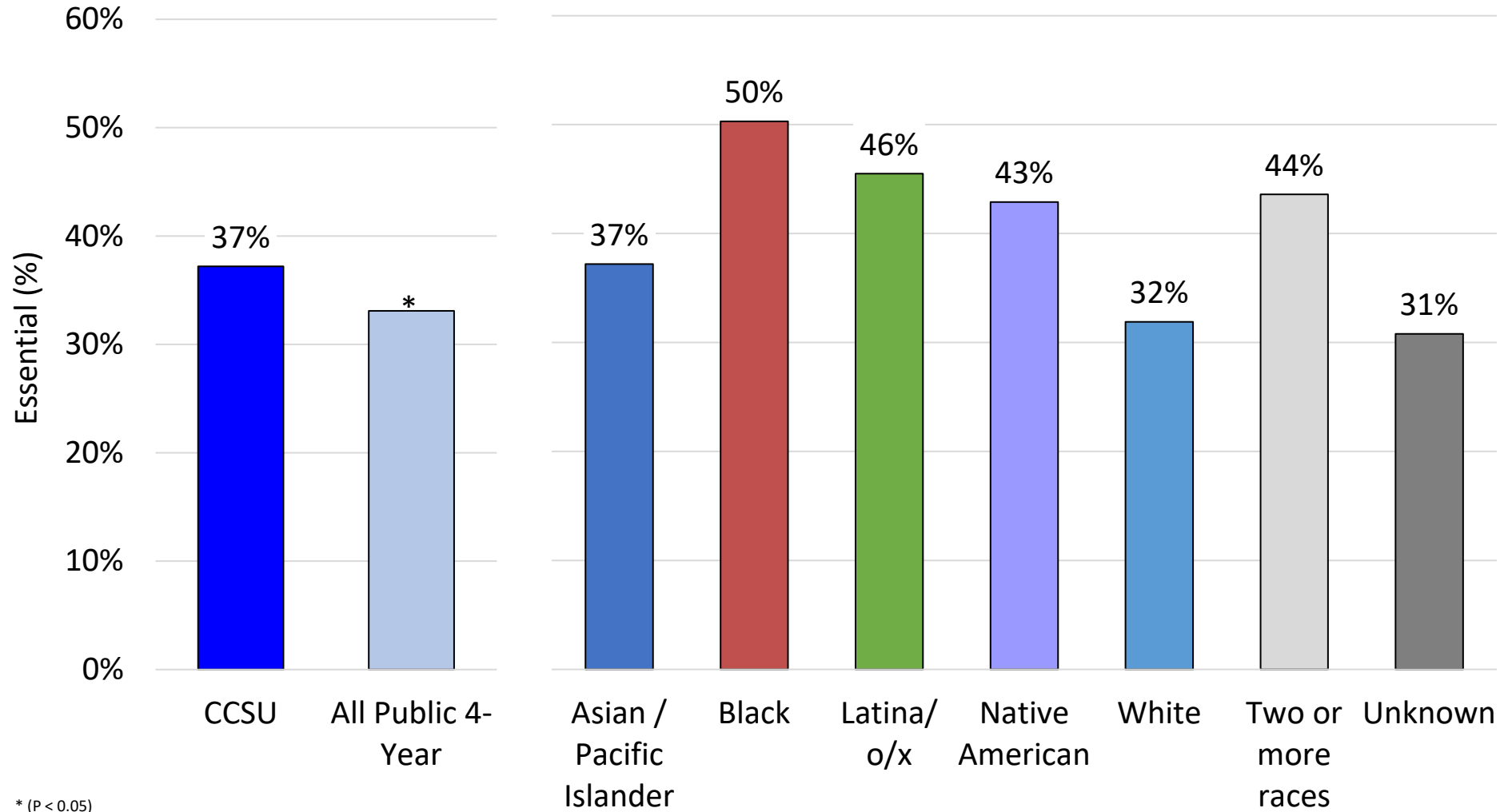

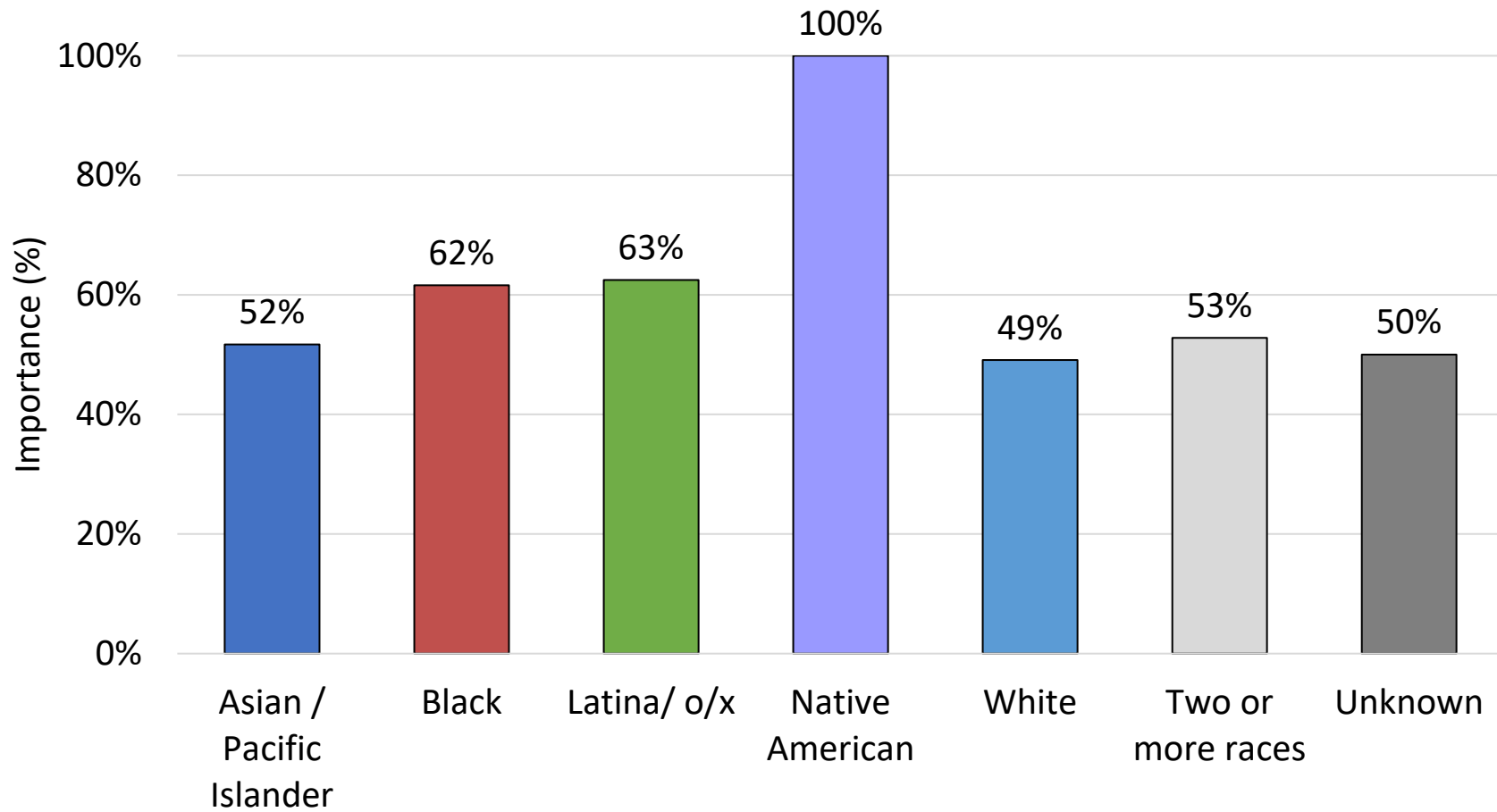


The Importance of Being Very Well-off Financially is Essential

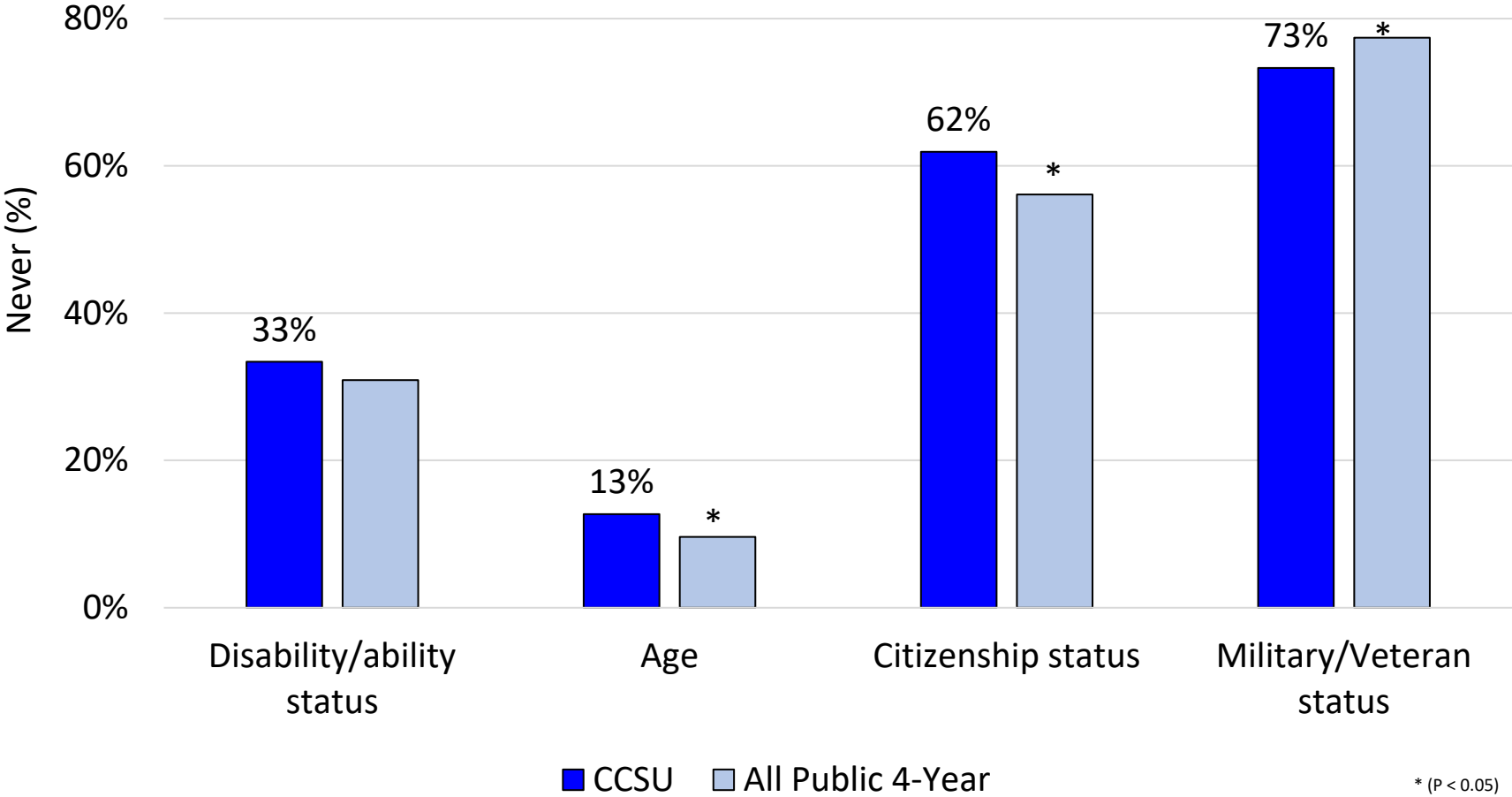

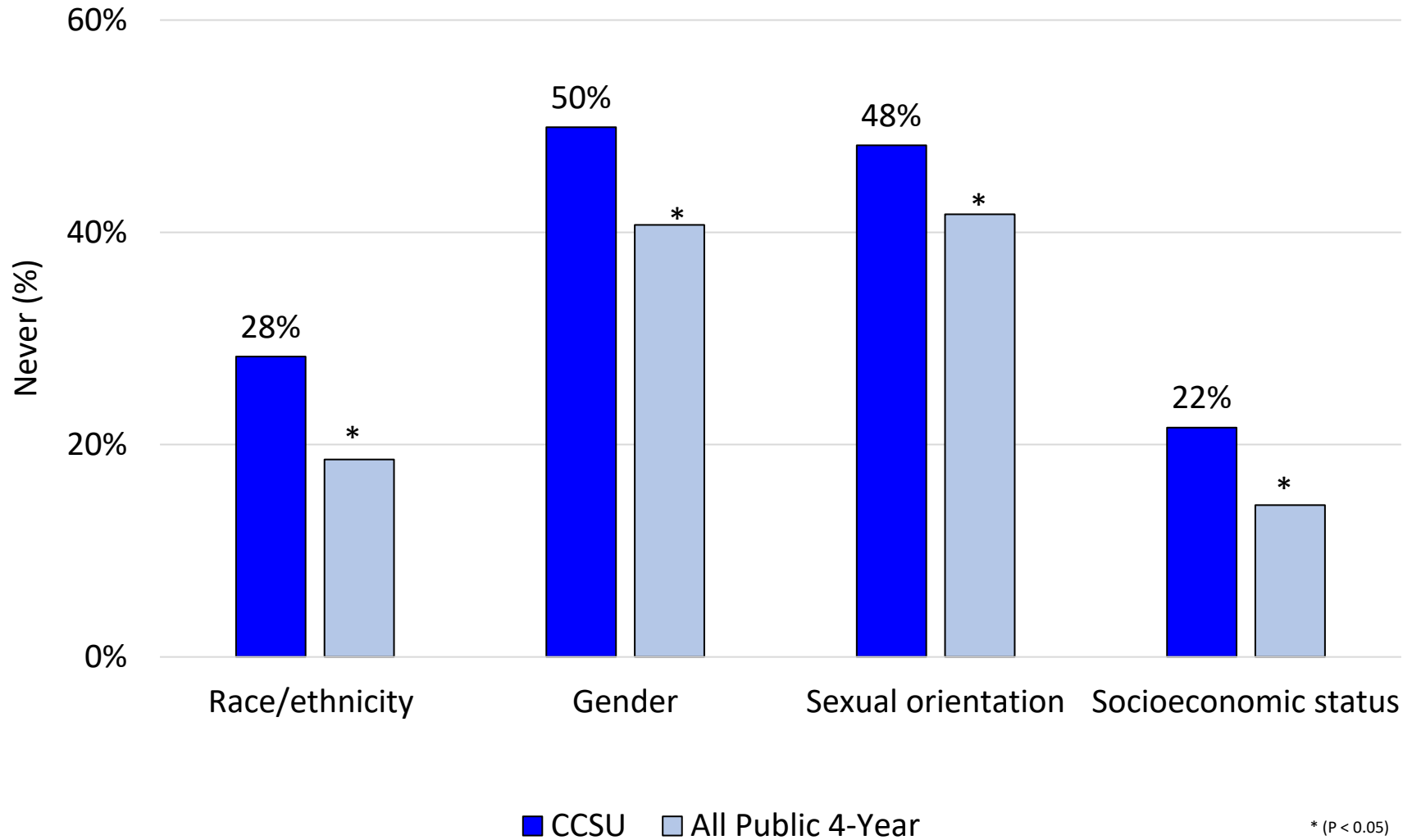

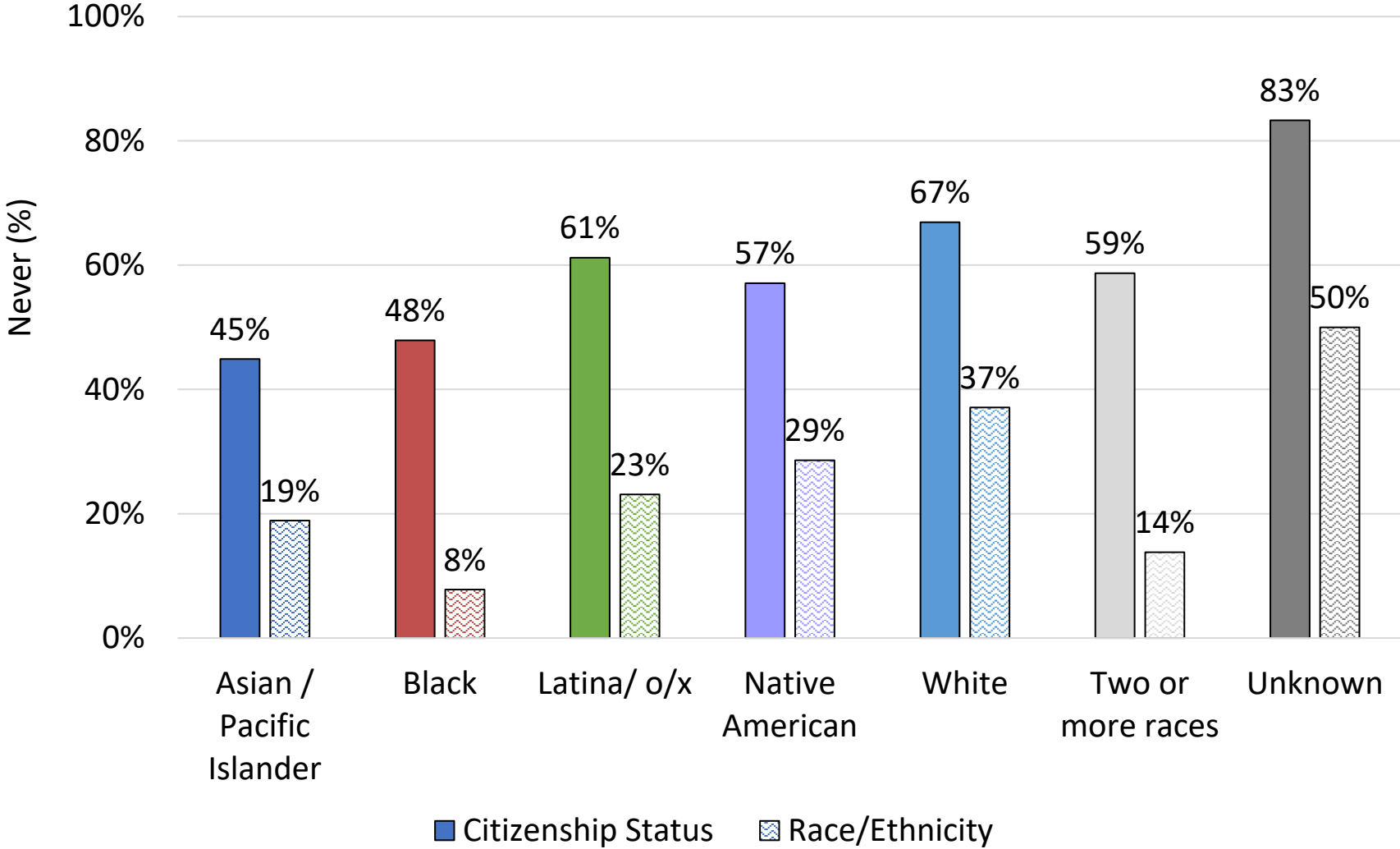
In the Past Year, How Often Students Thought about Their:

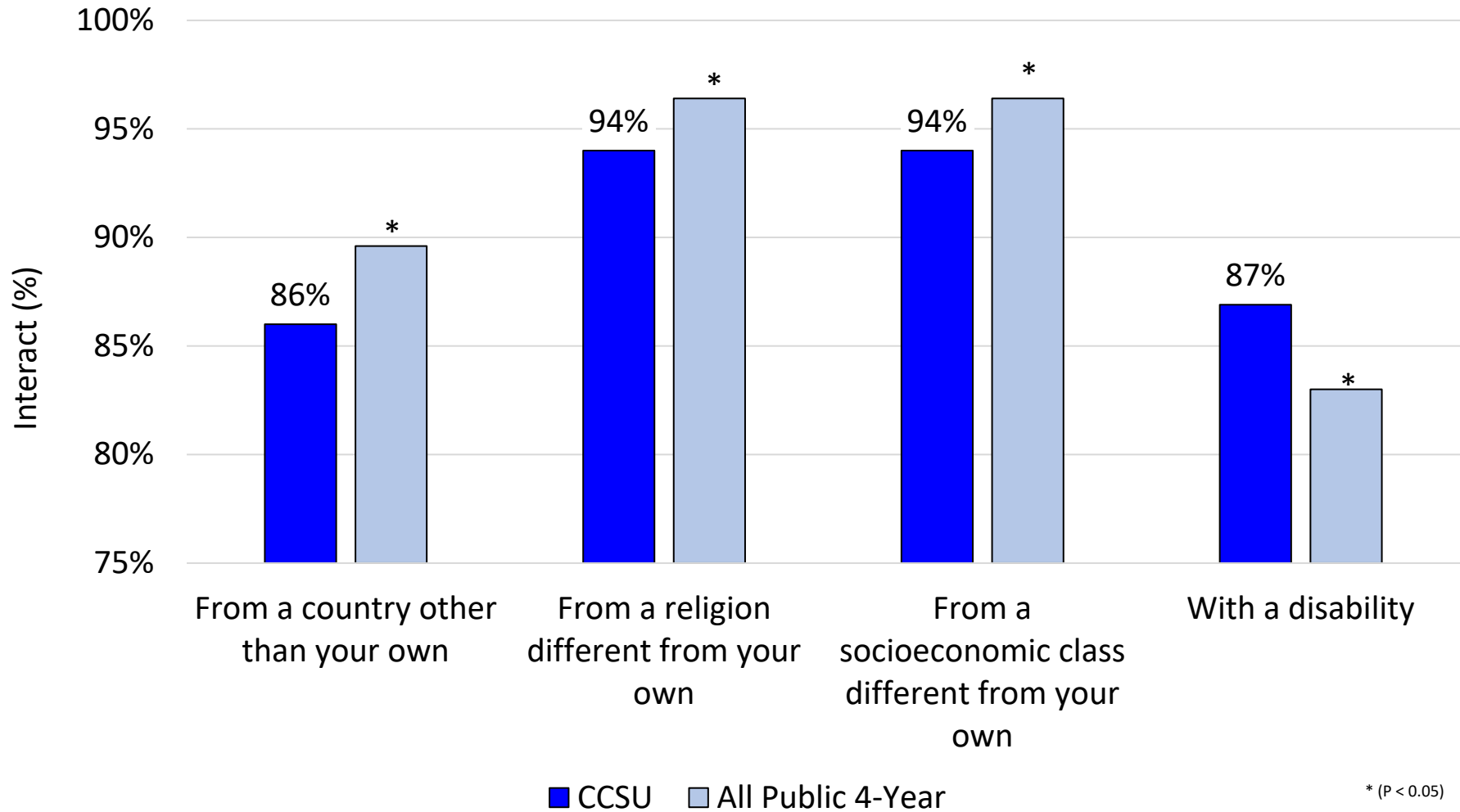

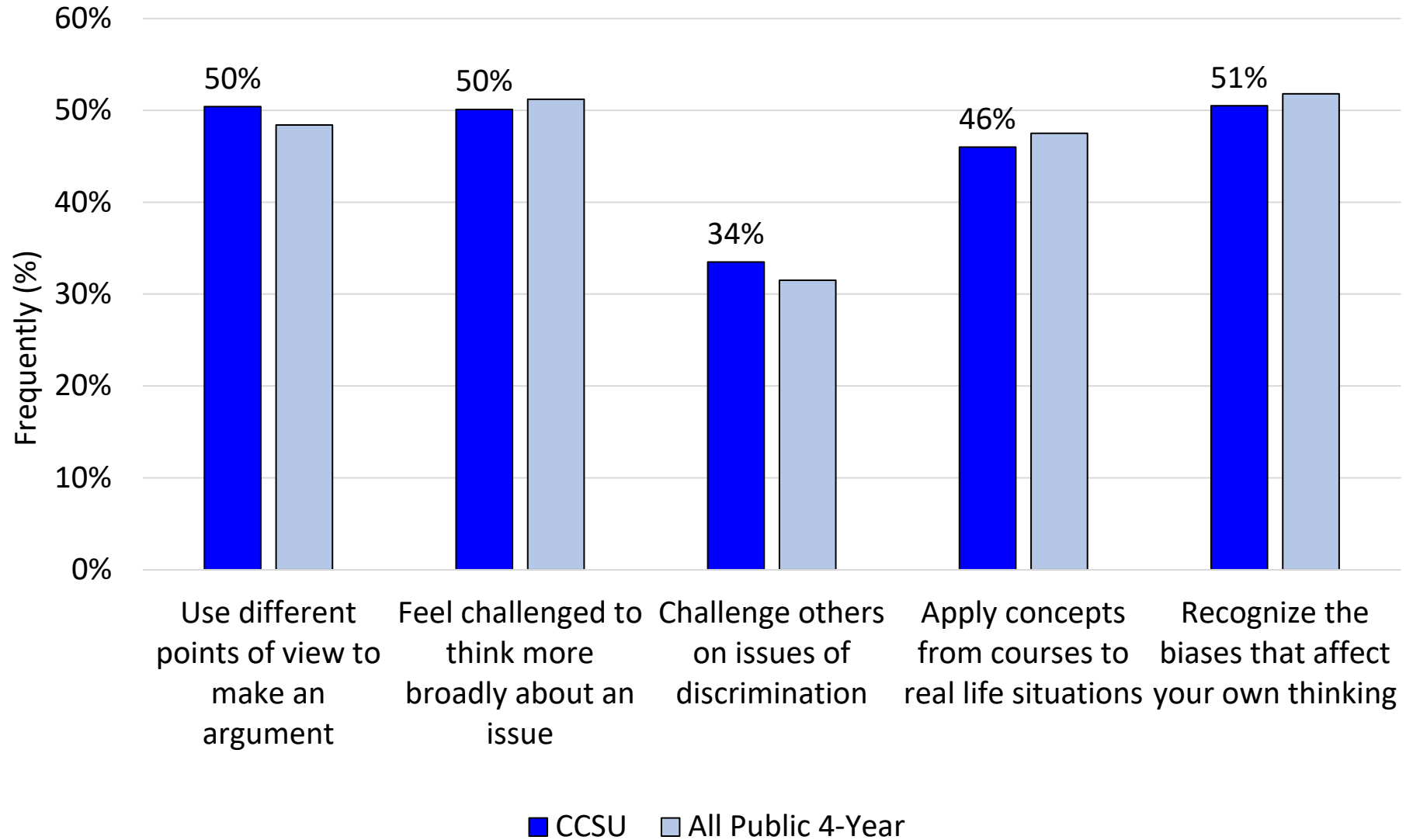

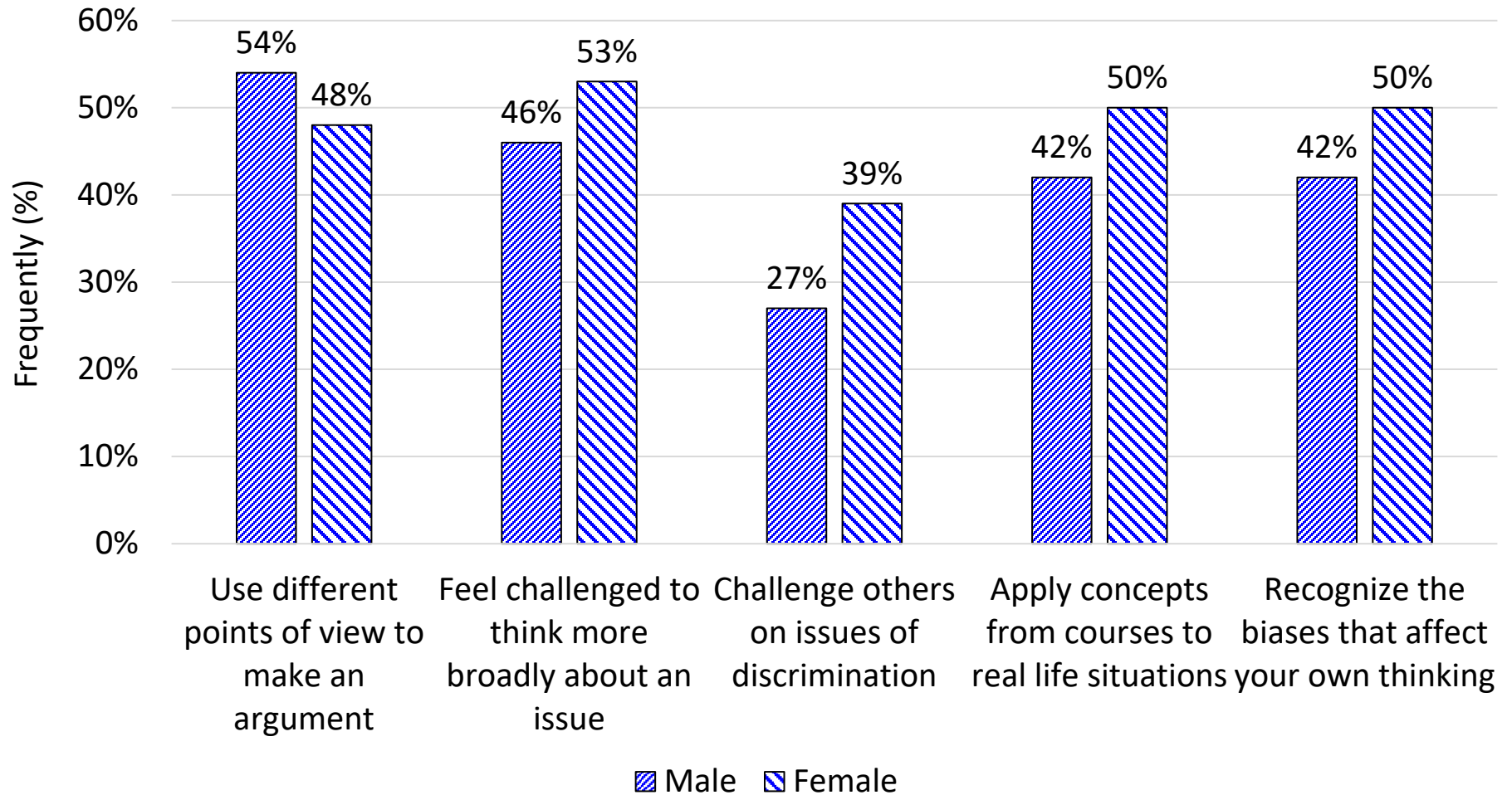
How Often in the Past Year did you Interact with Someone: (Frequently/Occasionally)



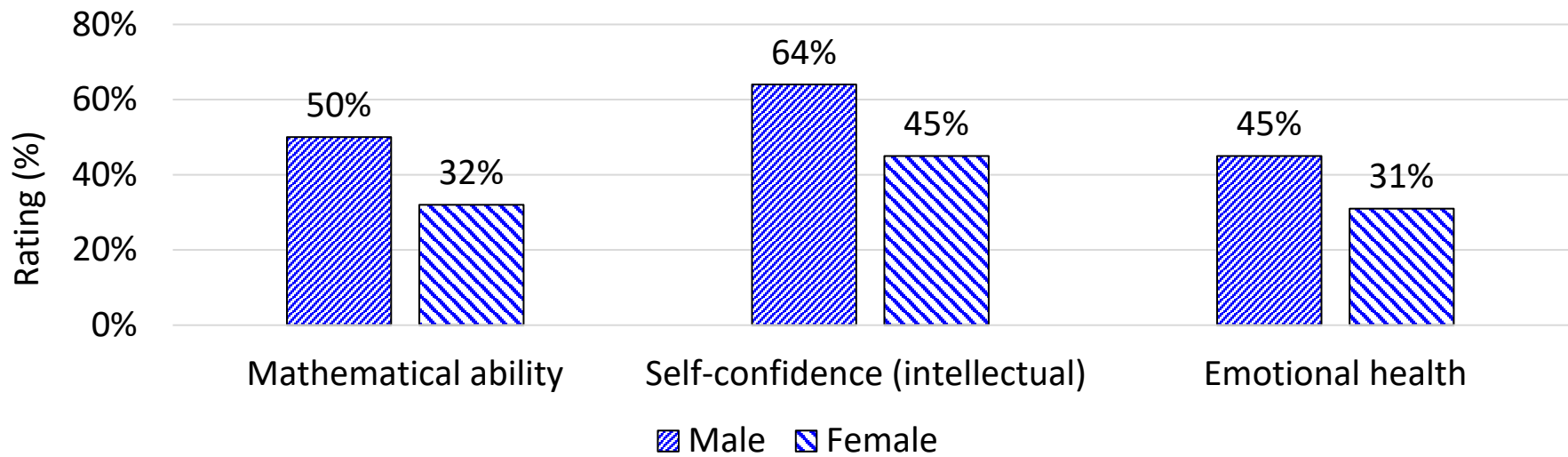
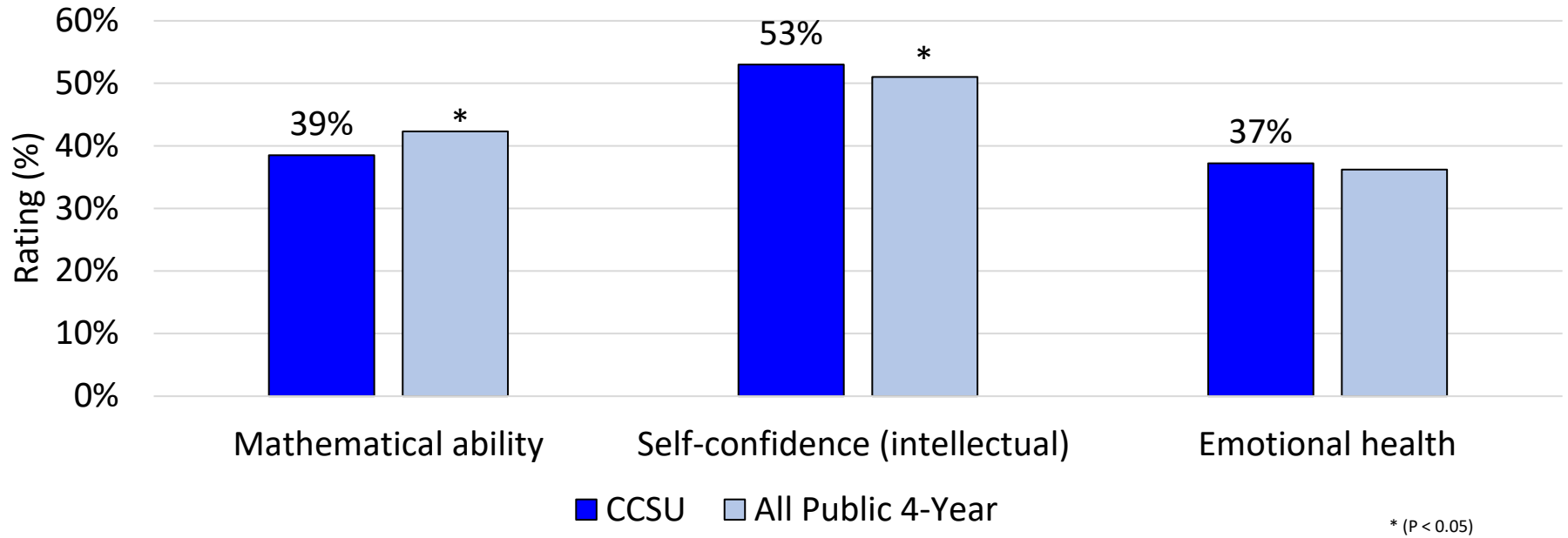

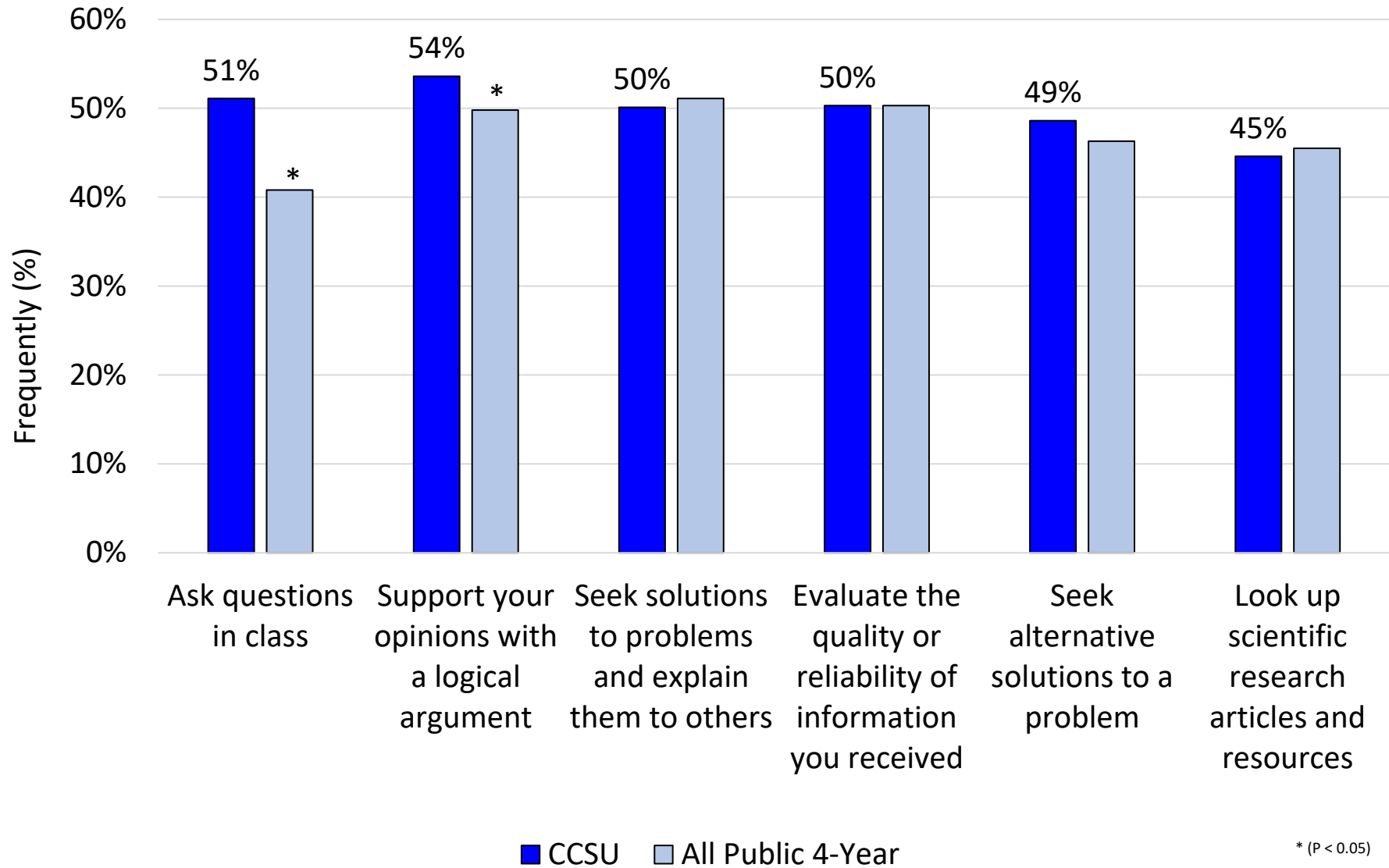

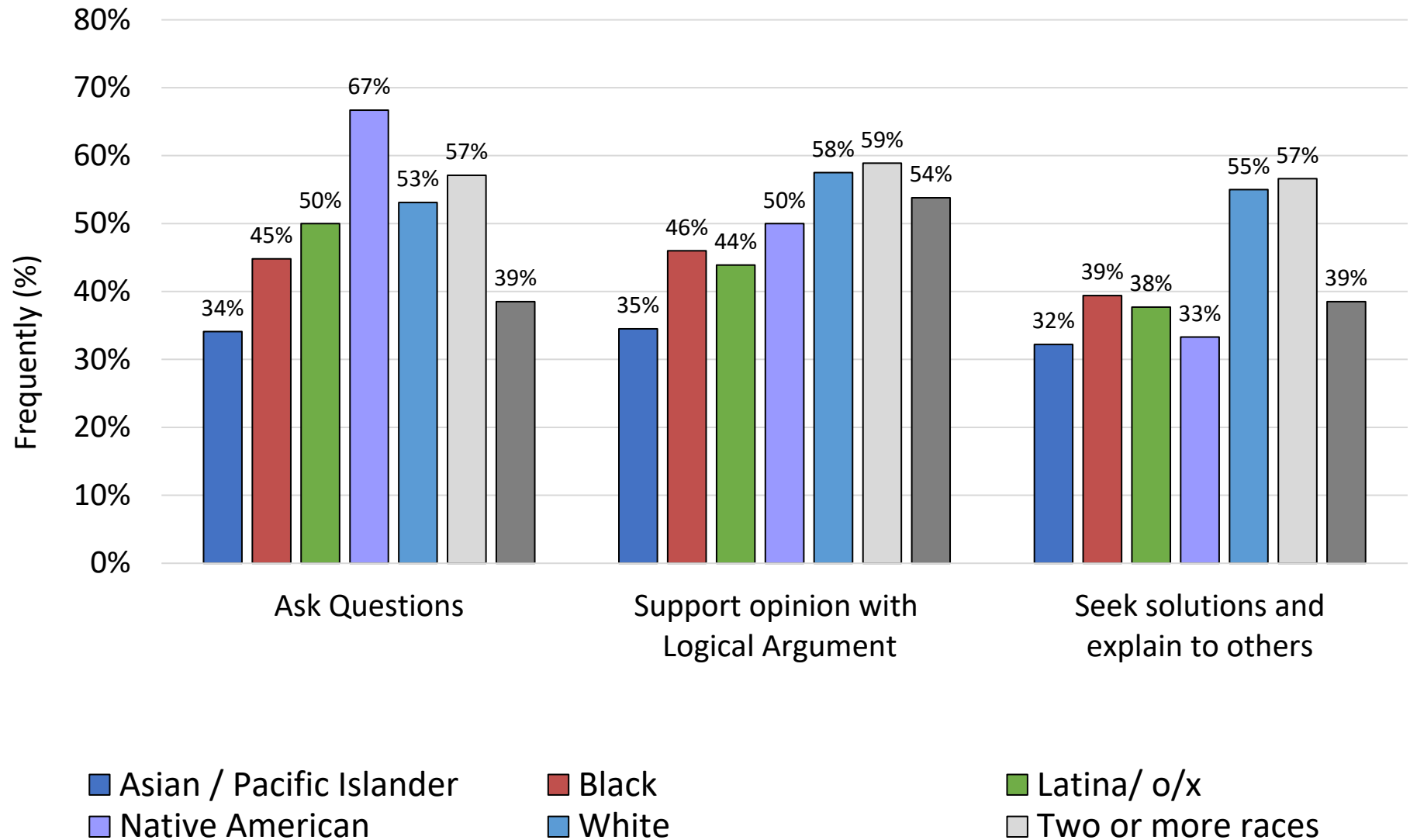
CCSU Students Compared Themselves to Other Students Their Age (Highest 10%/Above Average)



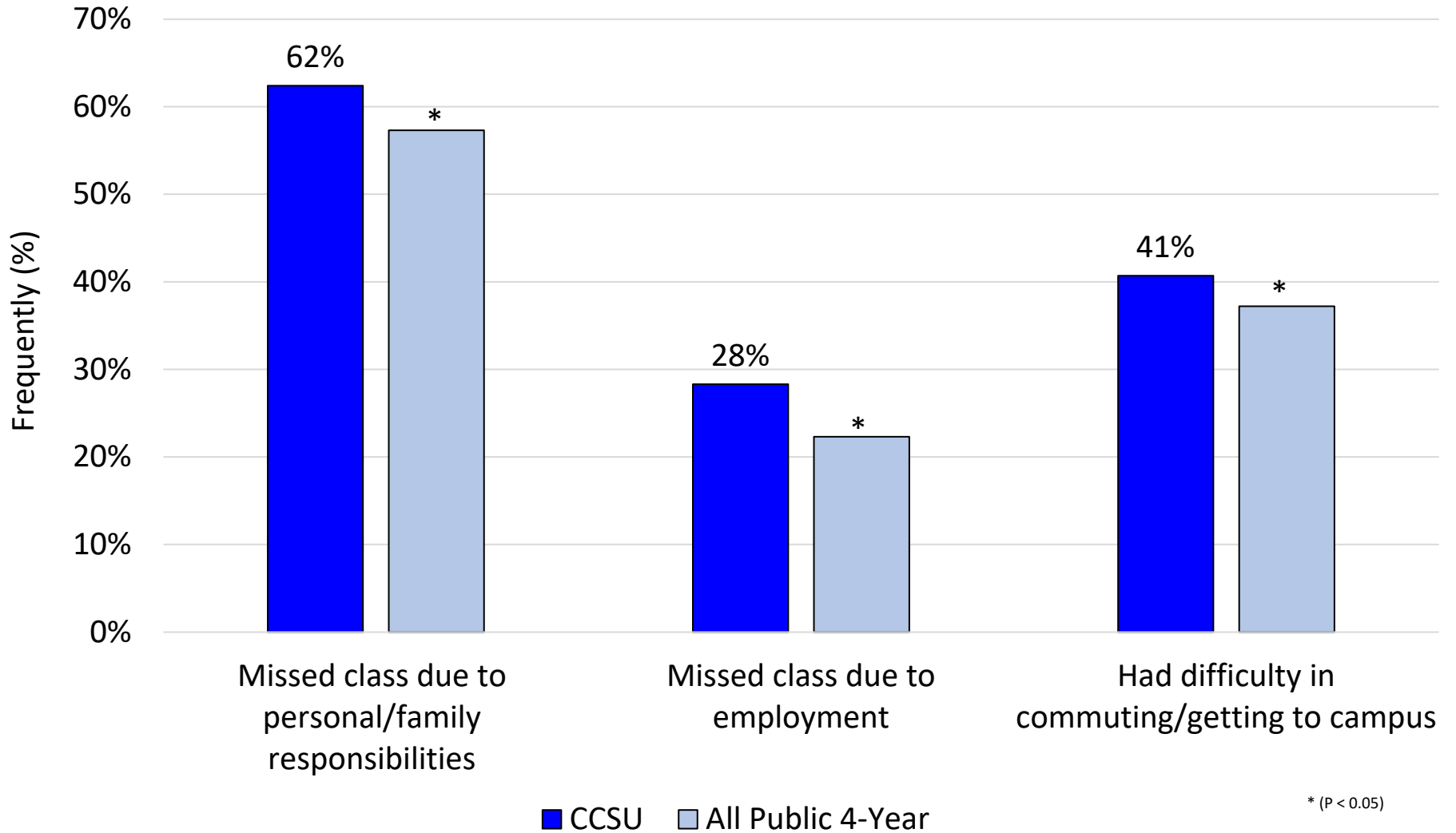

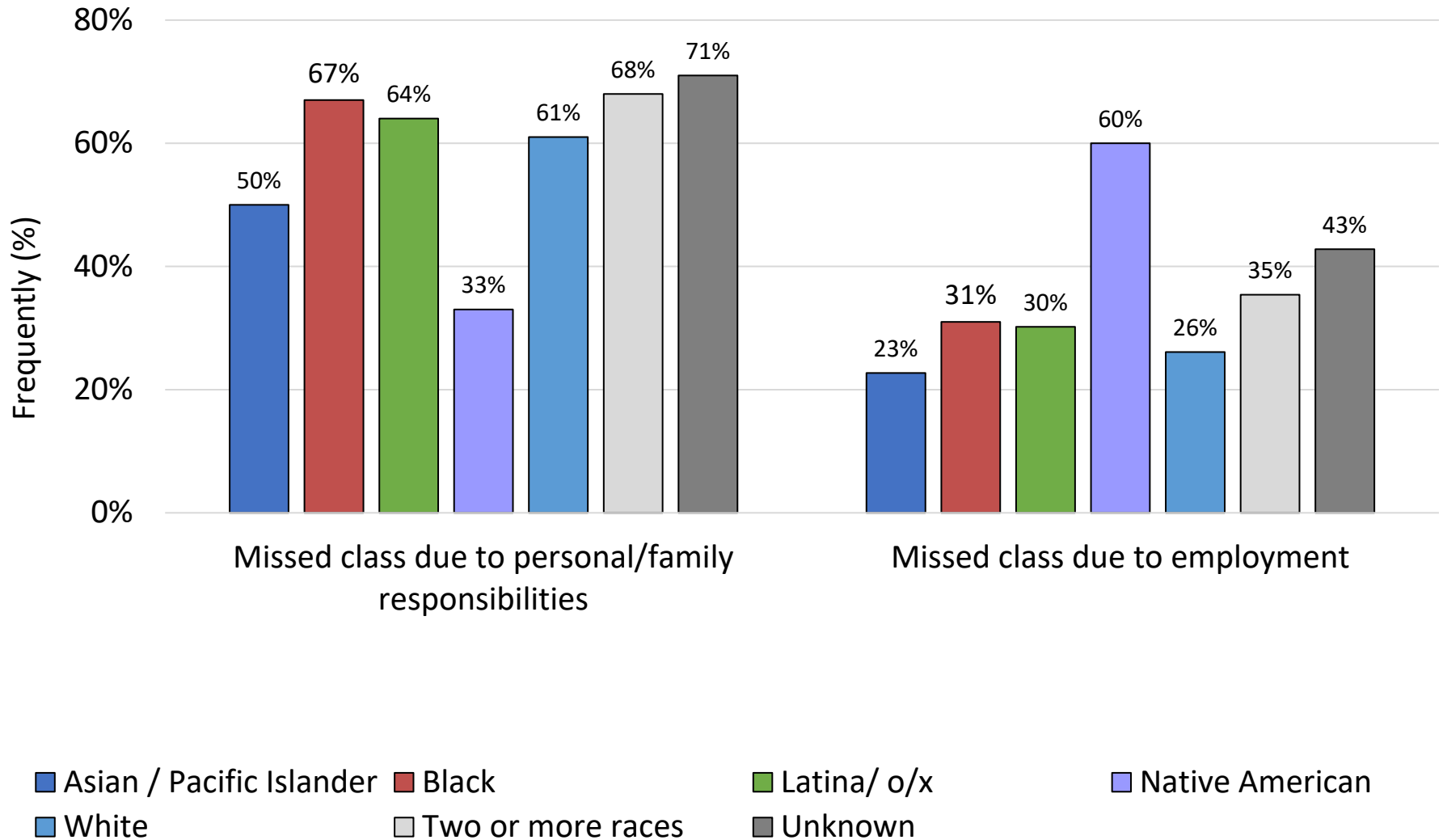

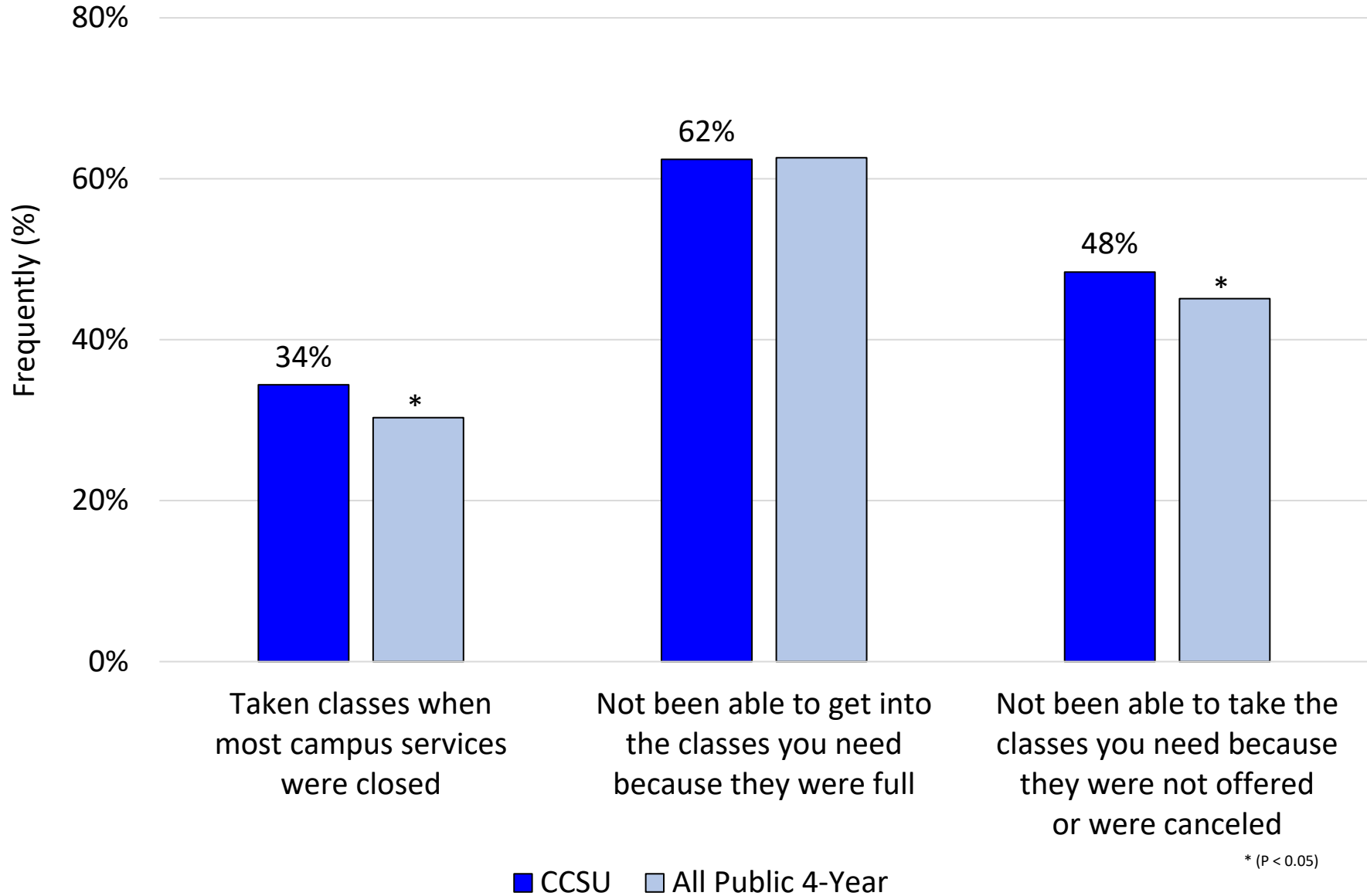

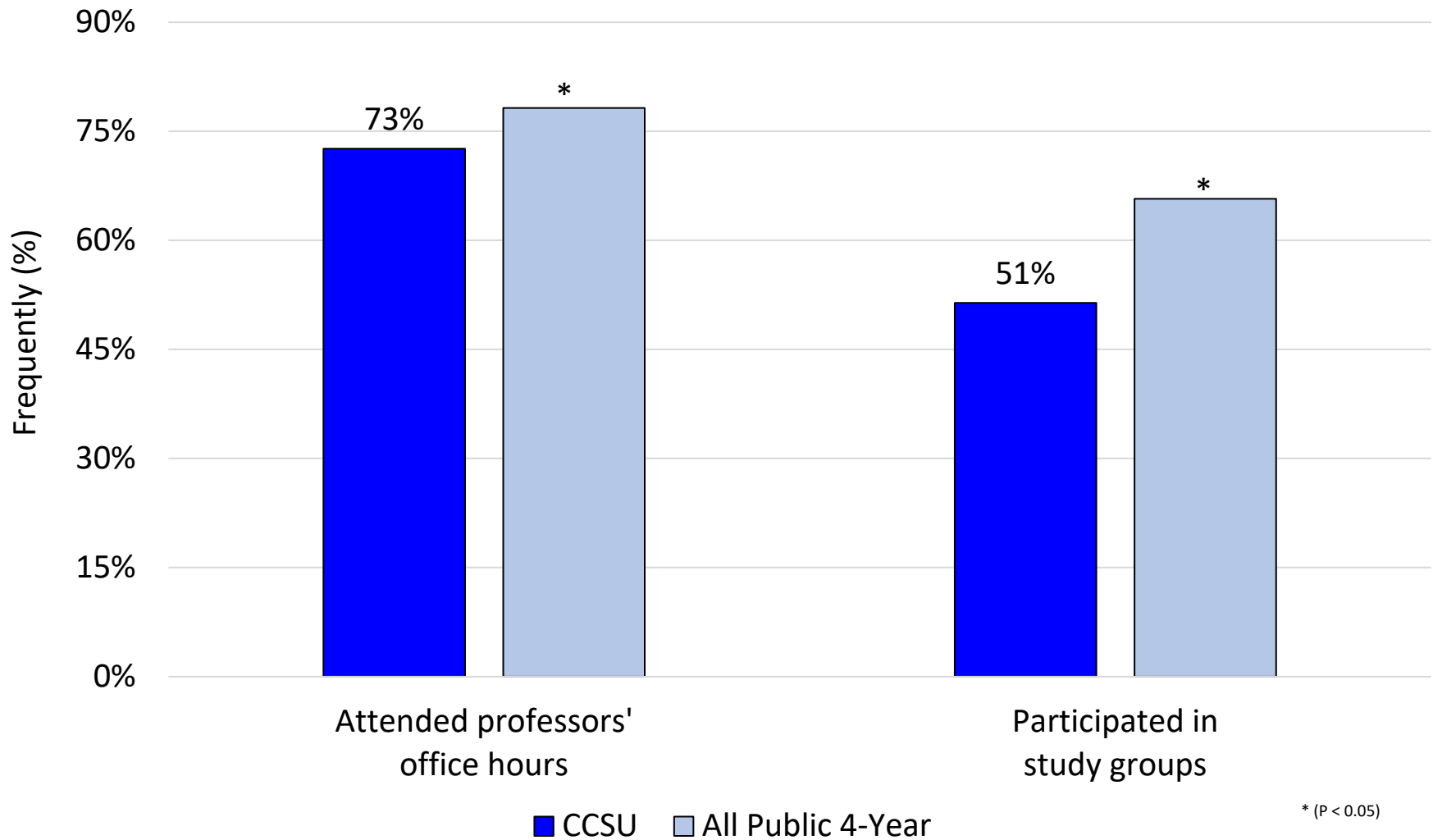

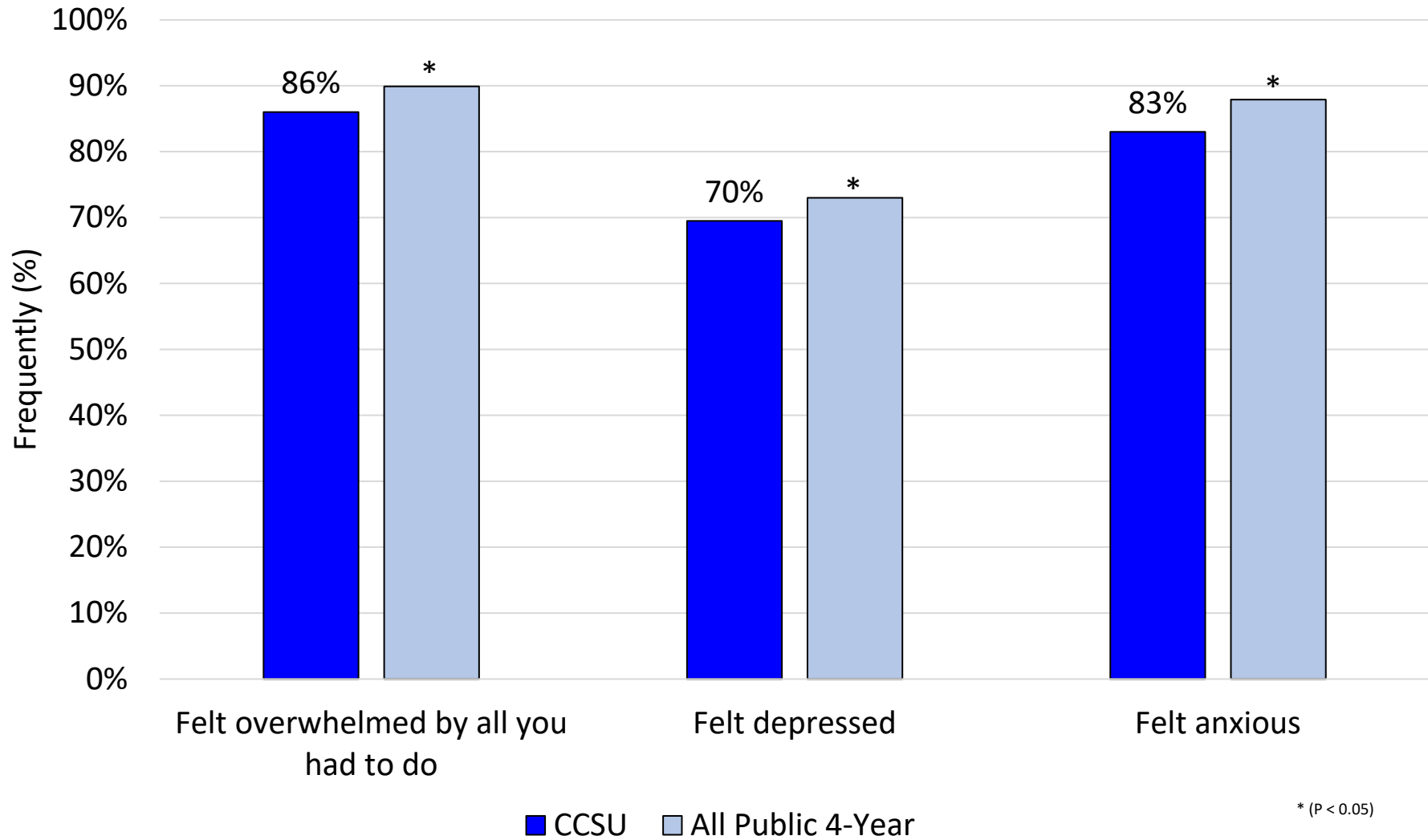

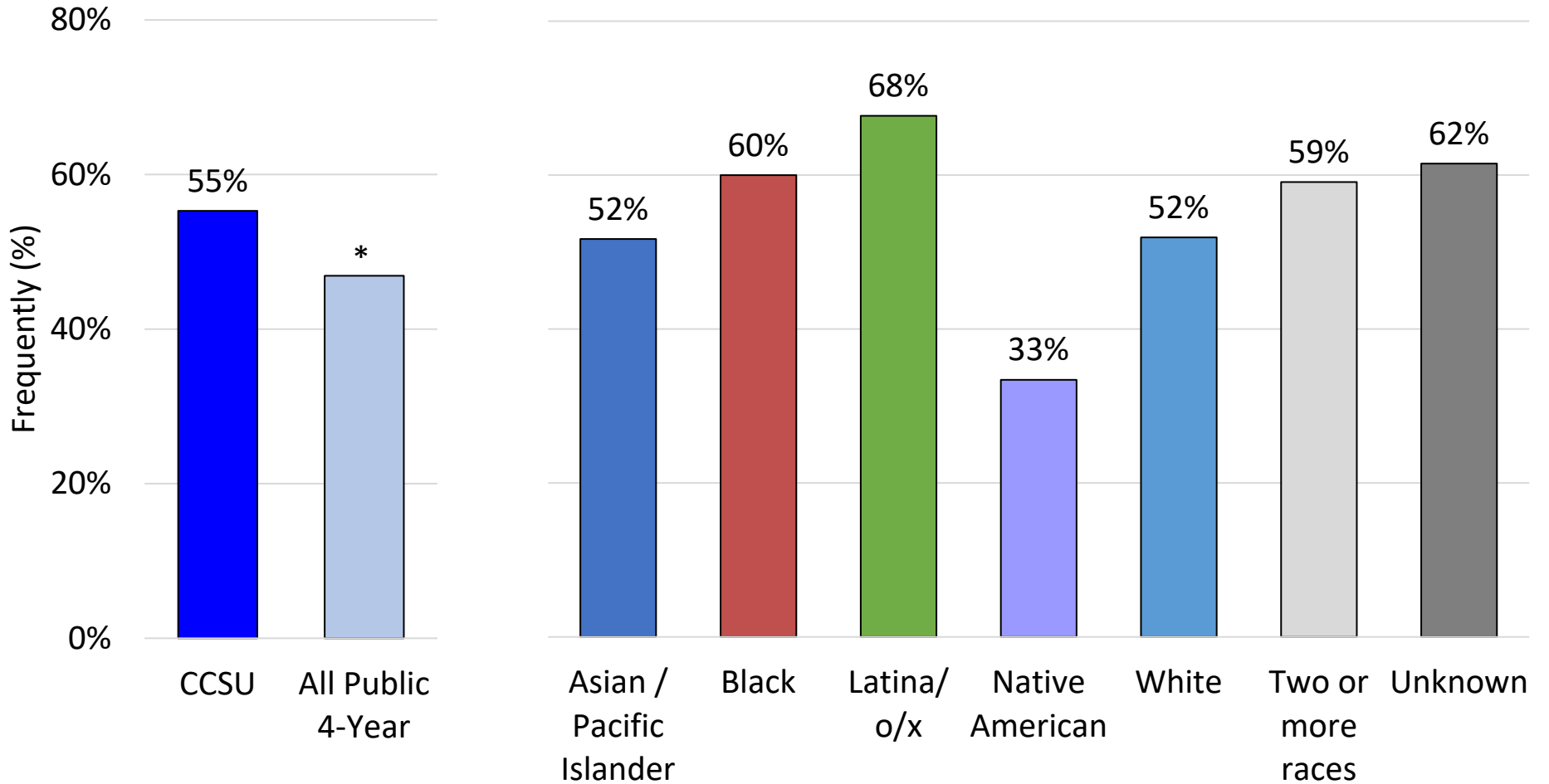

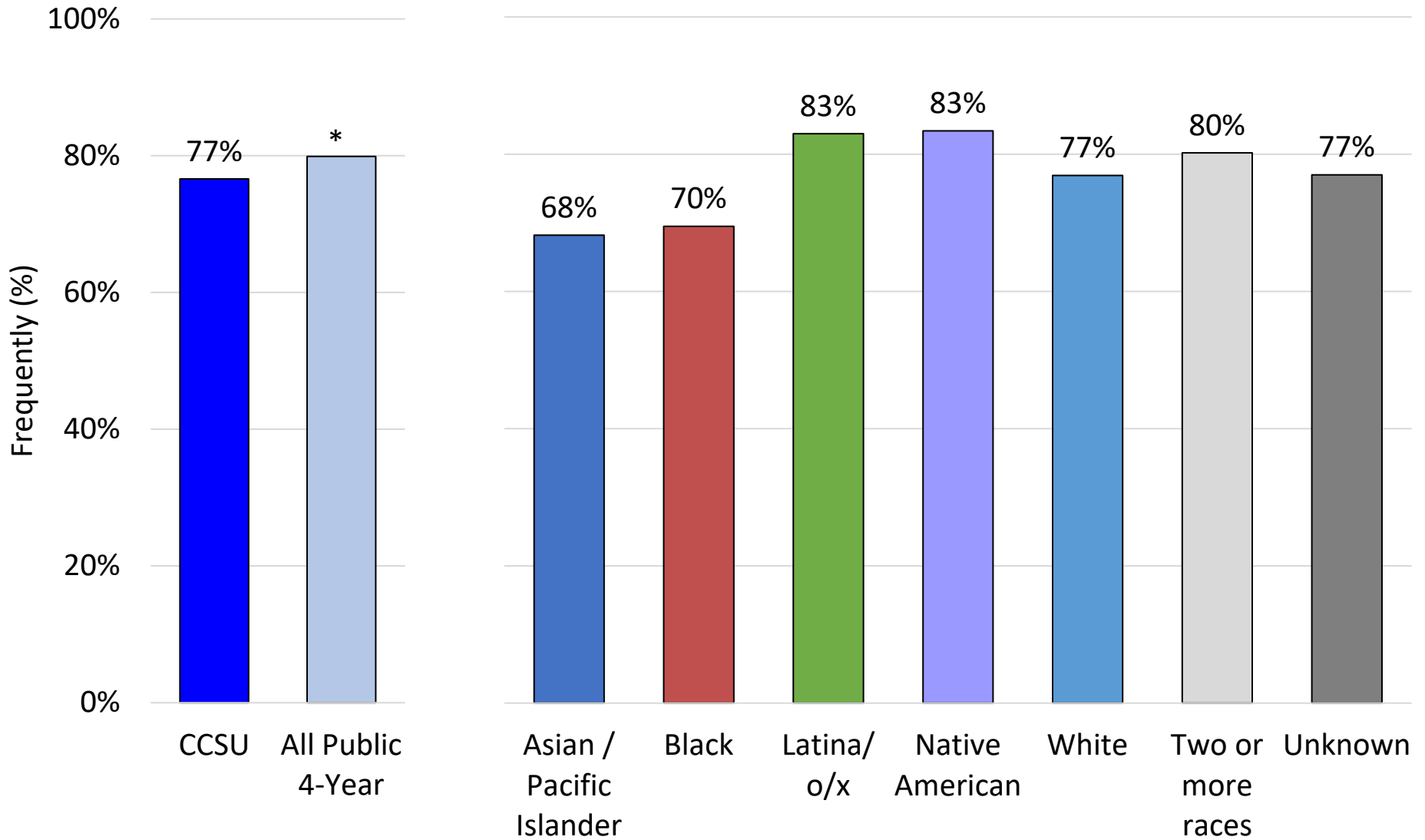


Since Entering this College, how Often Have you Contributed Money to Help Support Your Family? (Frequently/Occasionally)



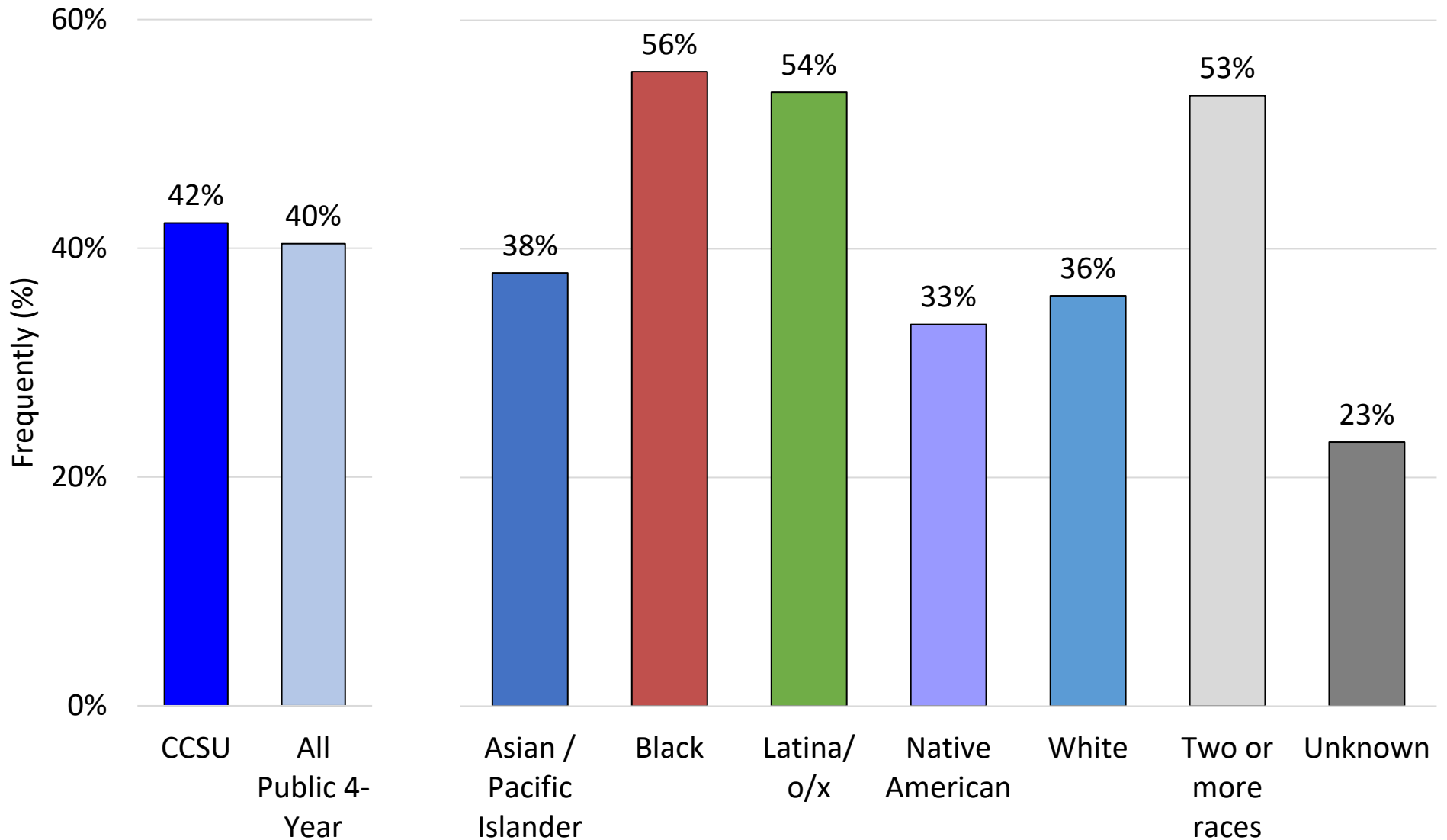

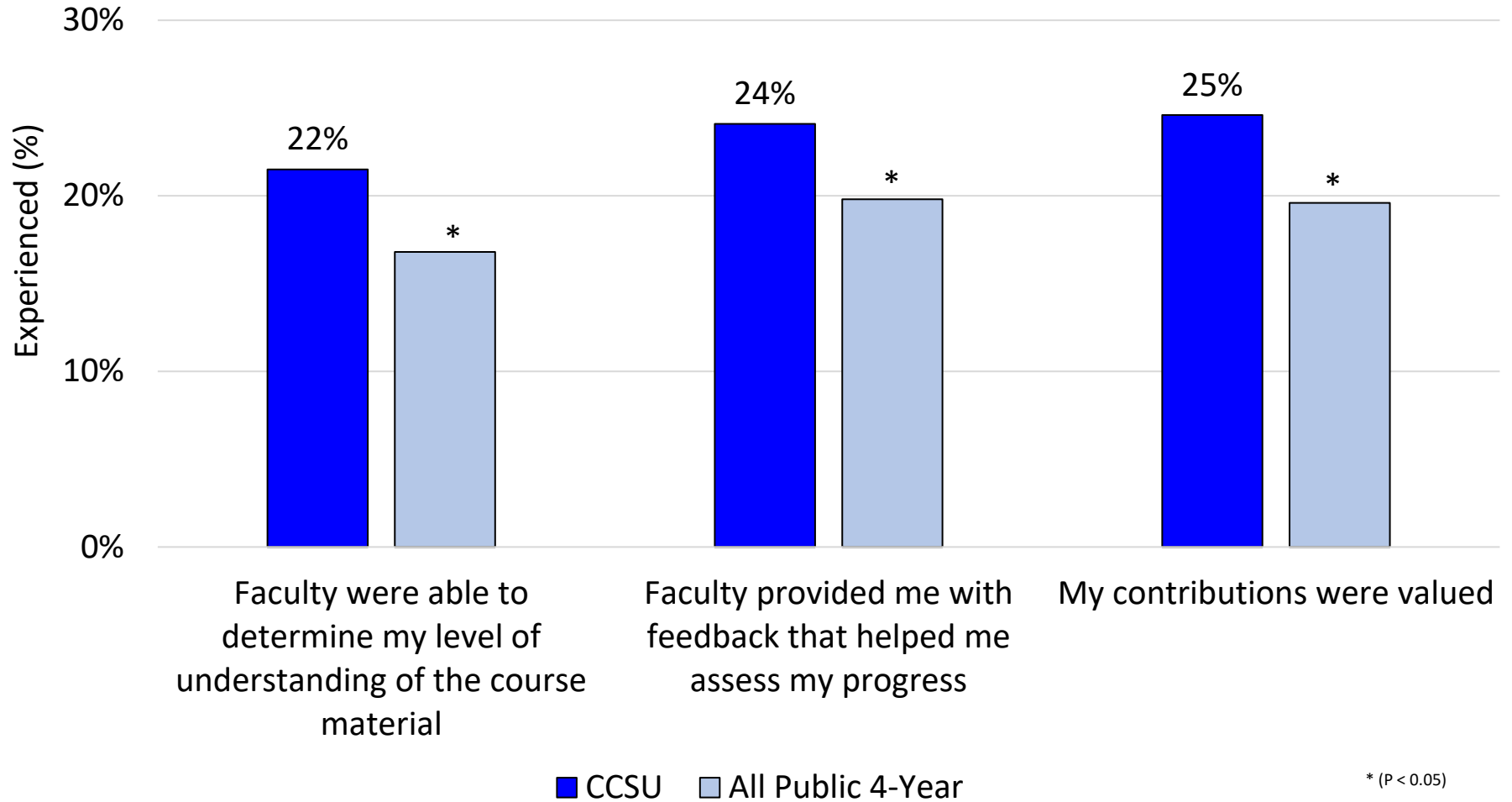

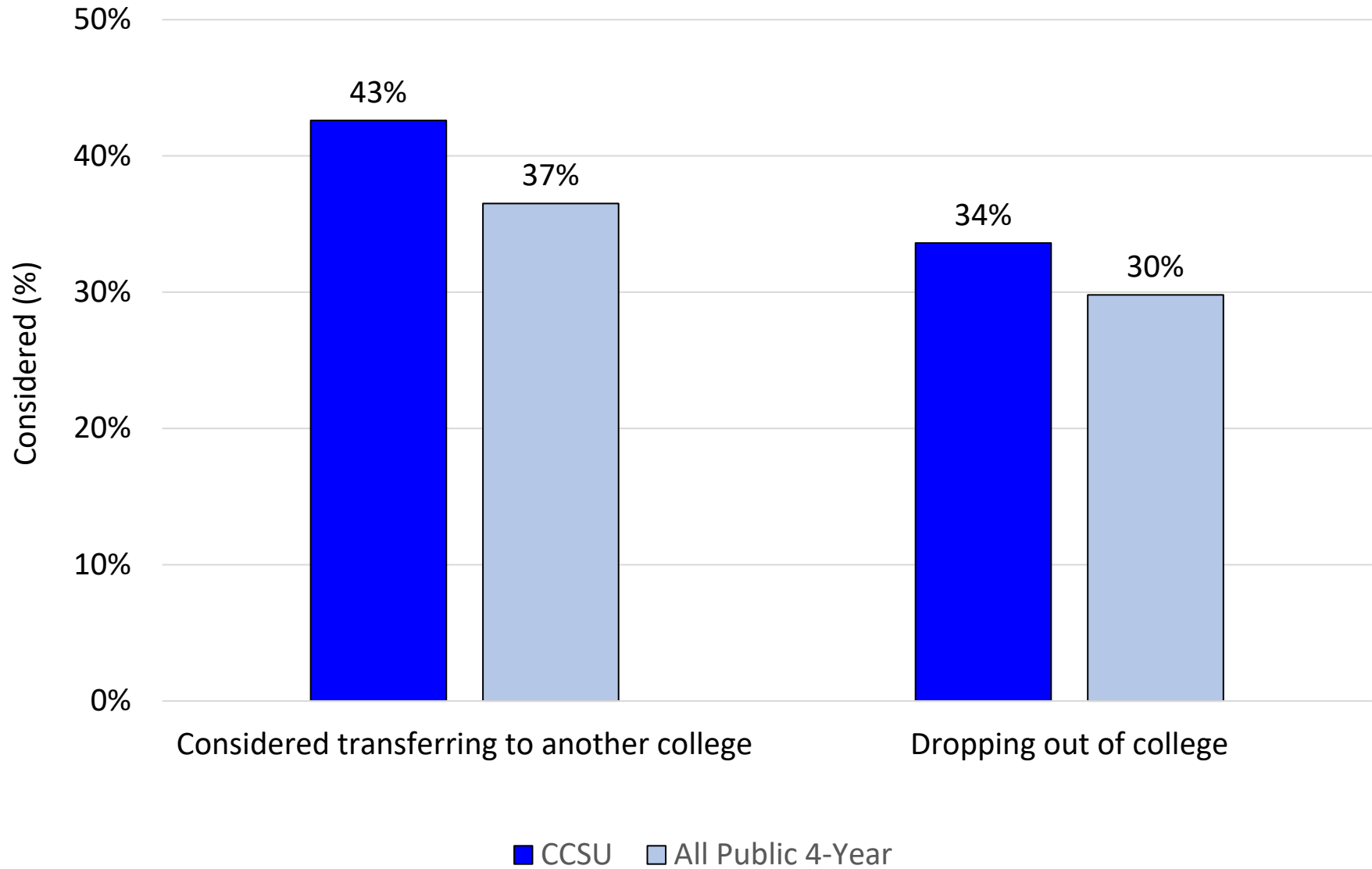

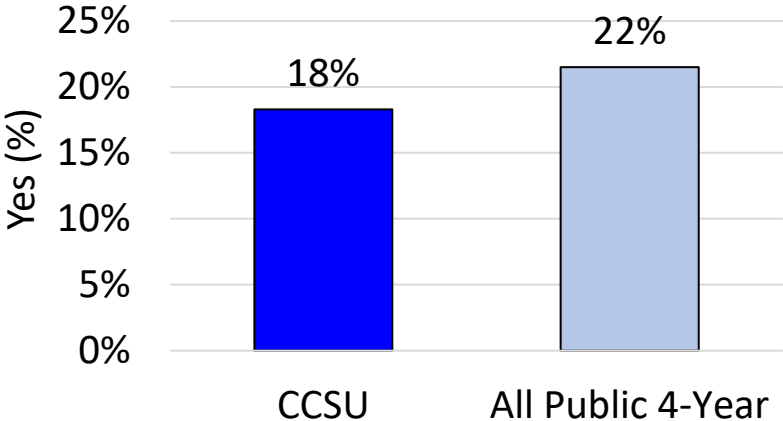
How Often Have Students Experienced the following in class at this college:
(Very Often)



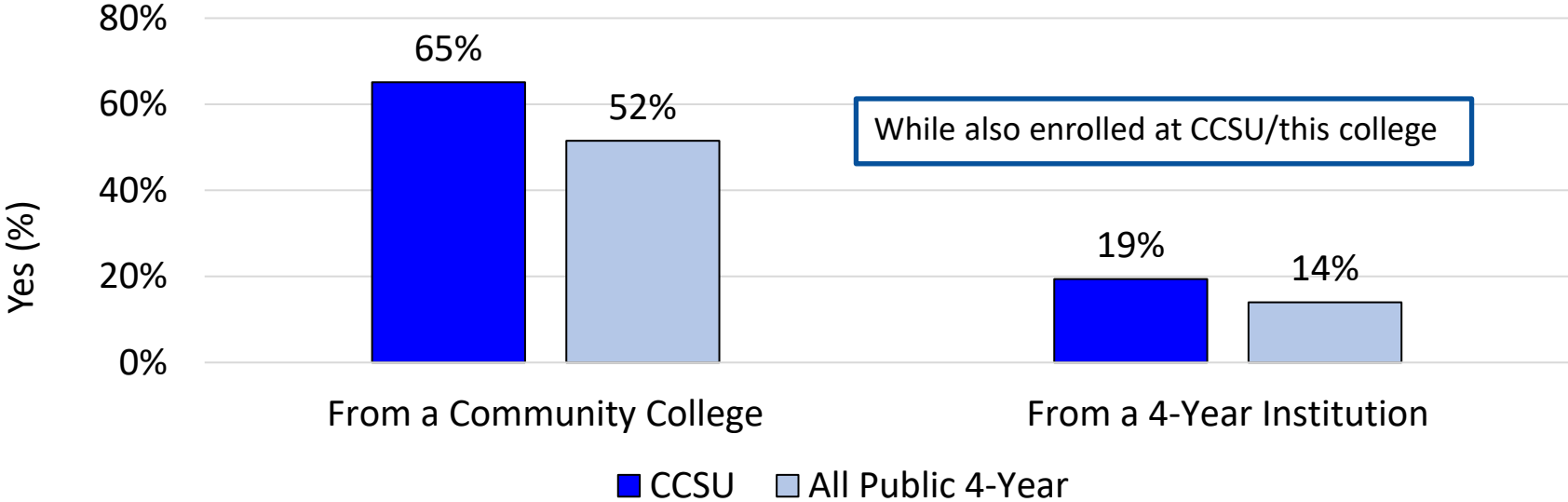
Since entering this college, to what extent have you:
(Great or Some Extent)



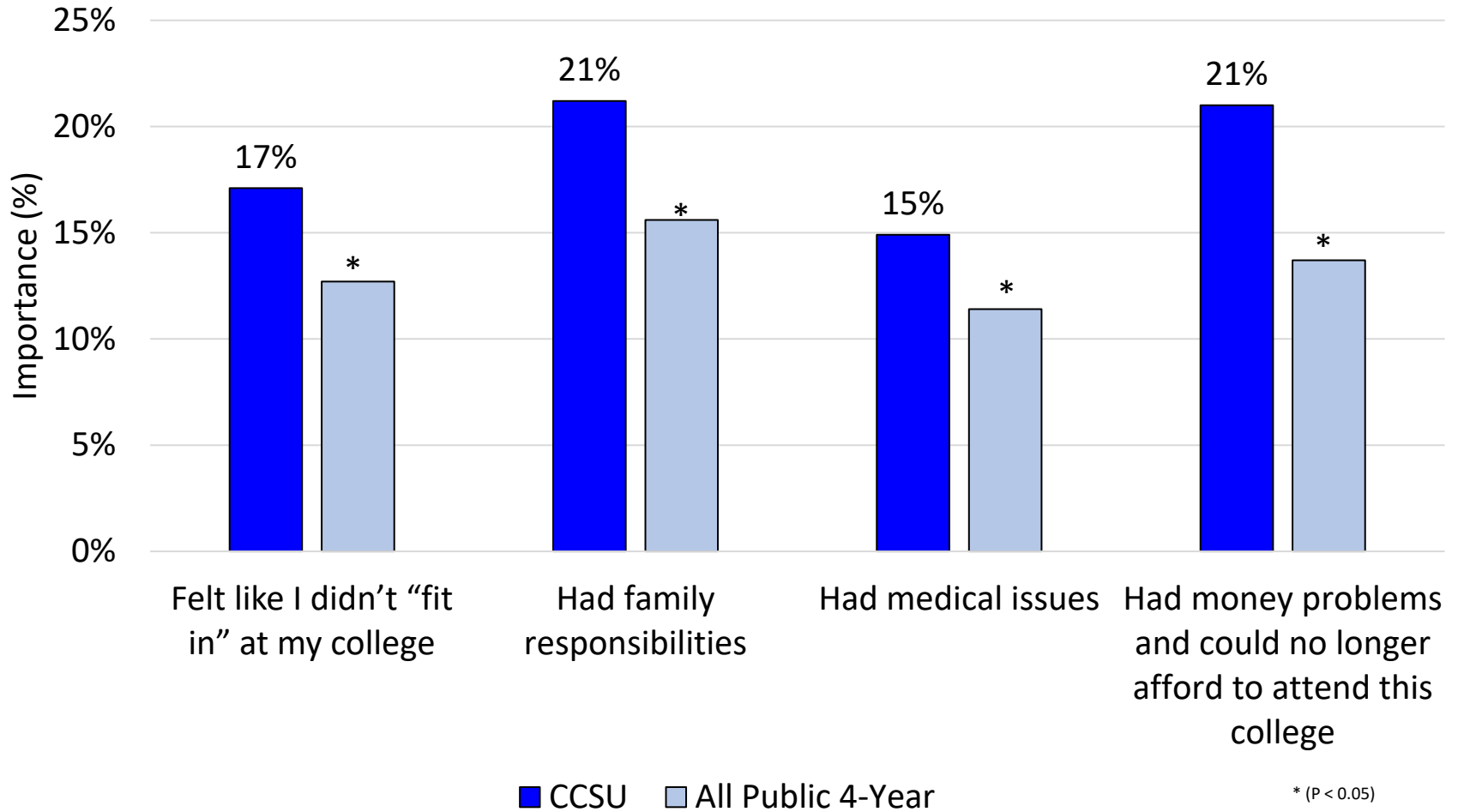
Since Entering this College Have You Taken a Course from Another Institution?



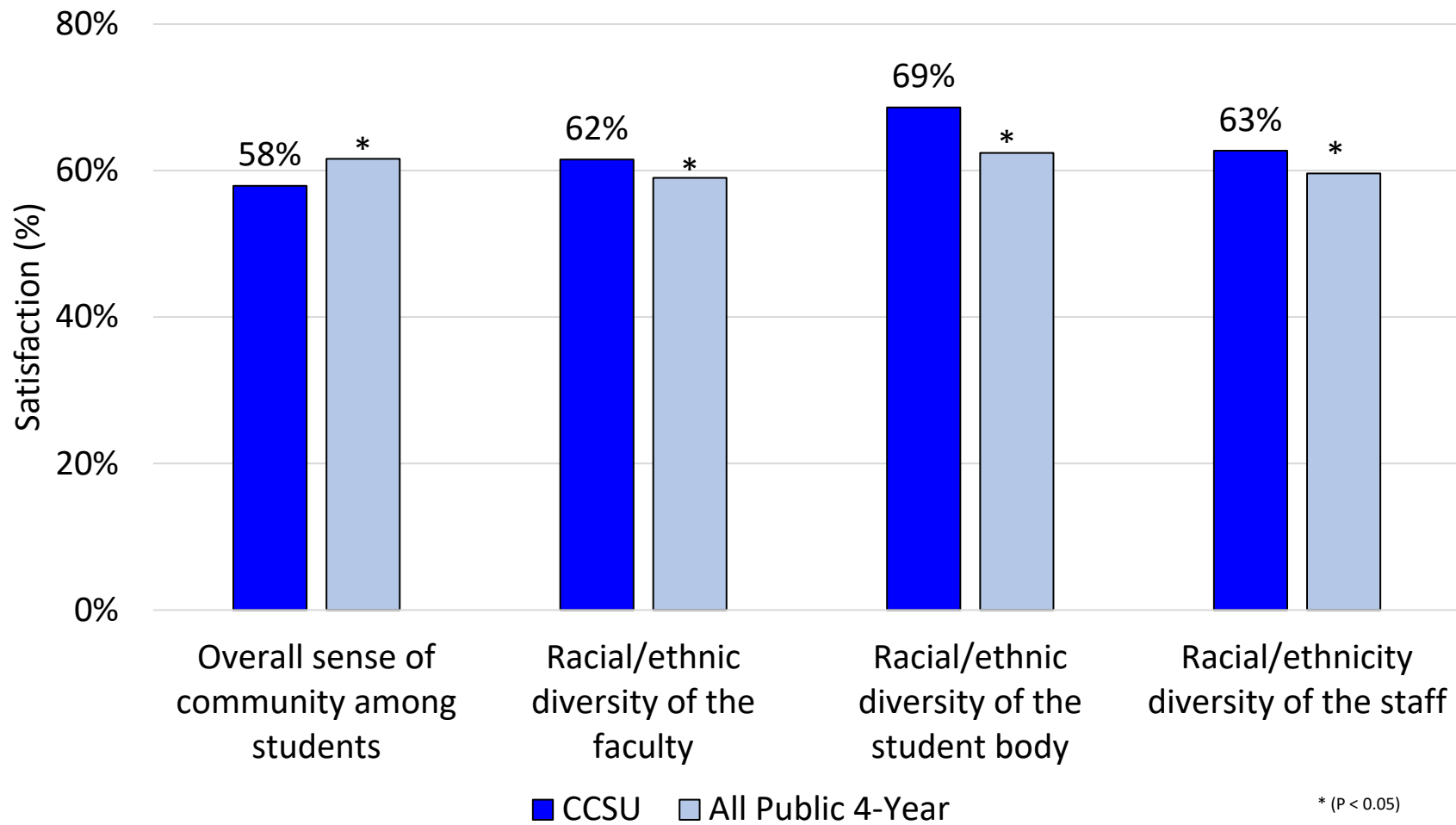

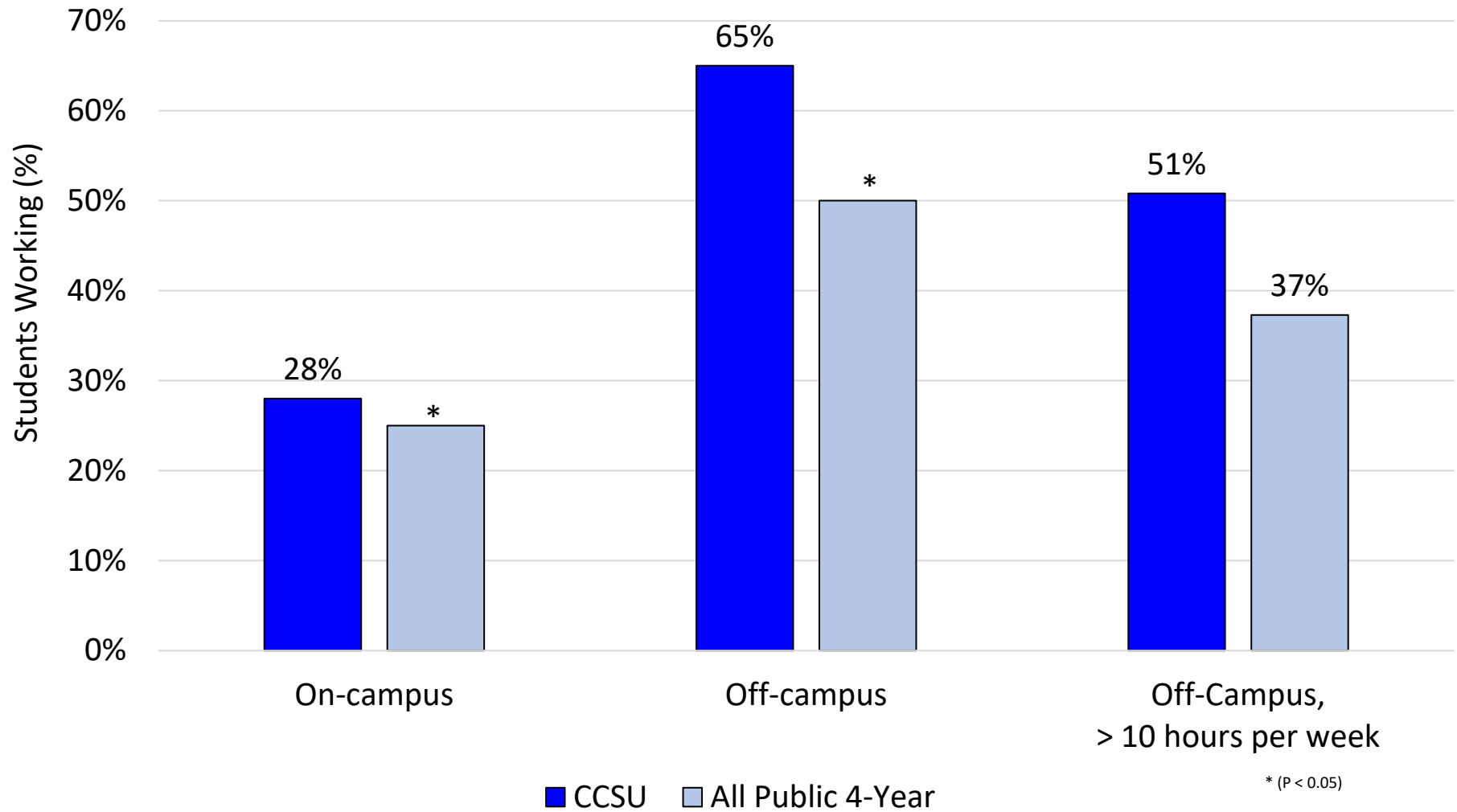
In deciding to take courses at another institution, how important were each of the following reasons? (Essential/Very Important)



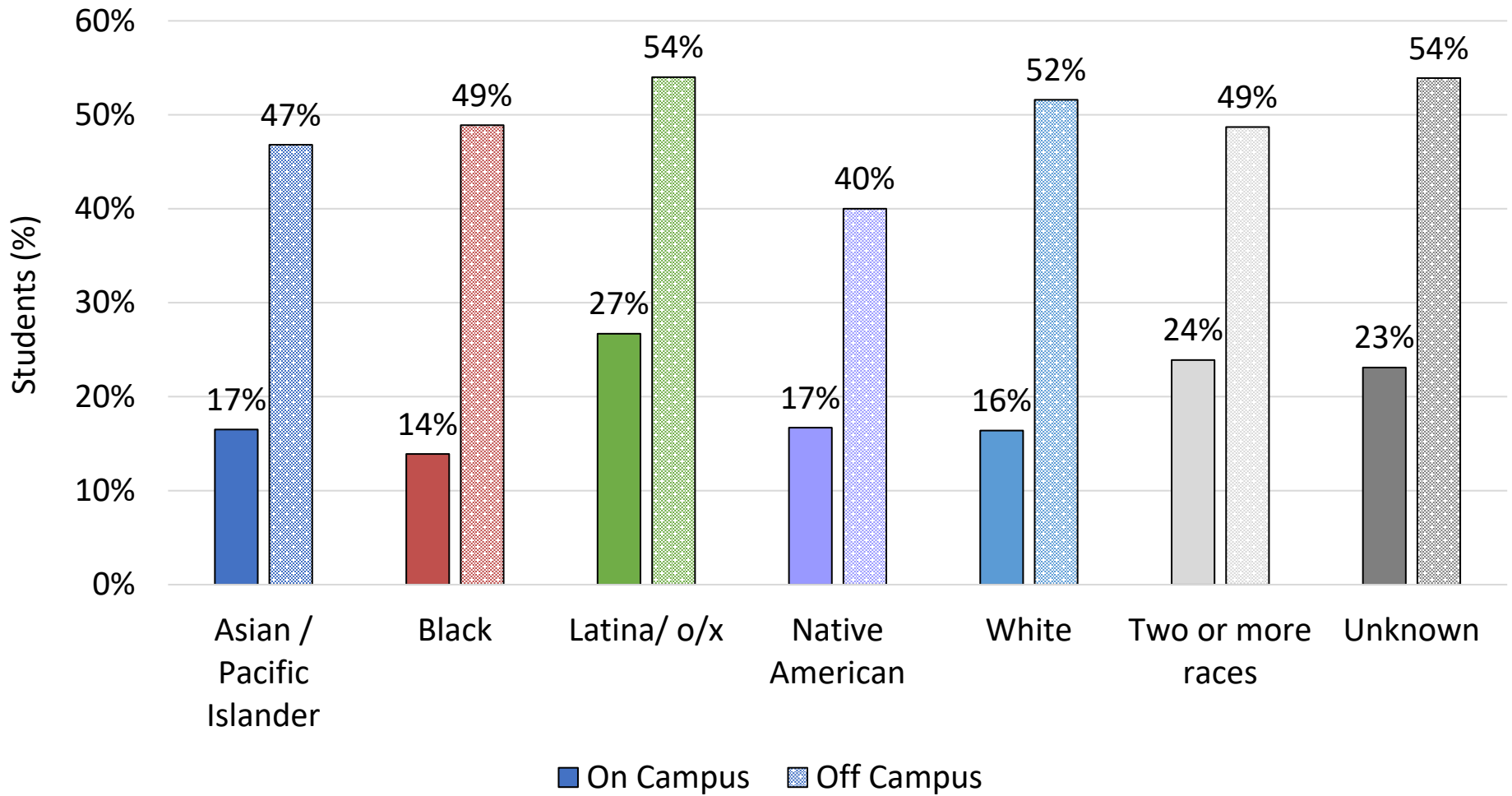

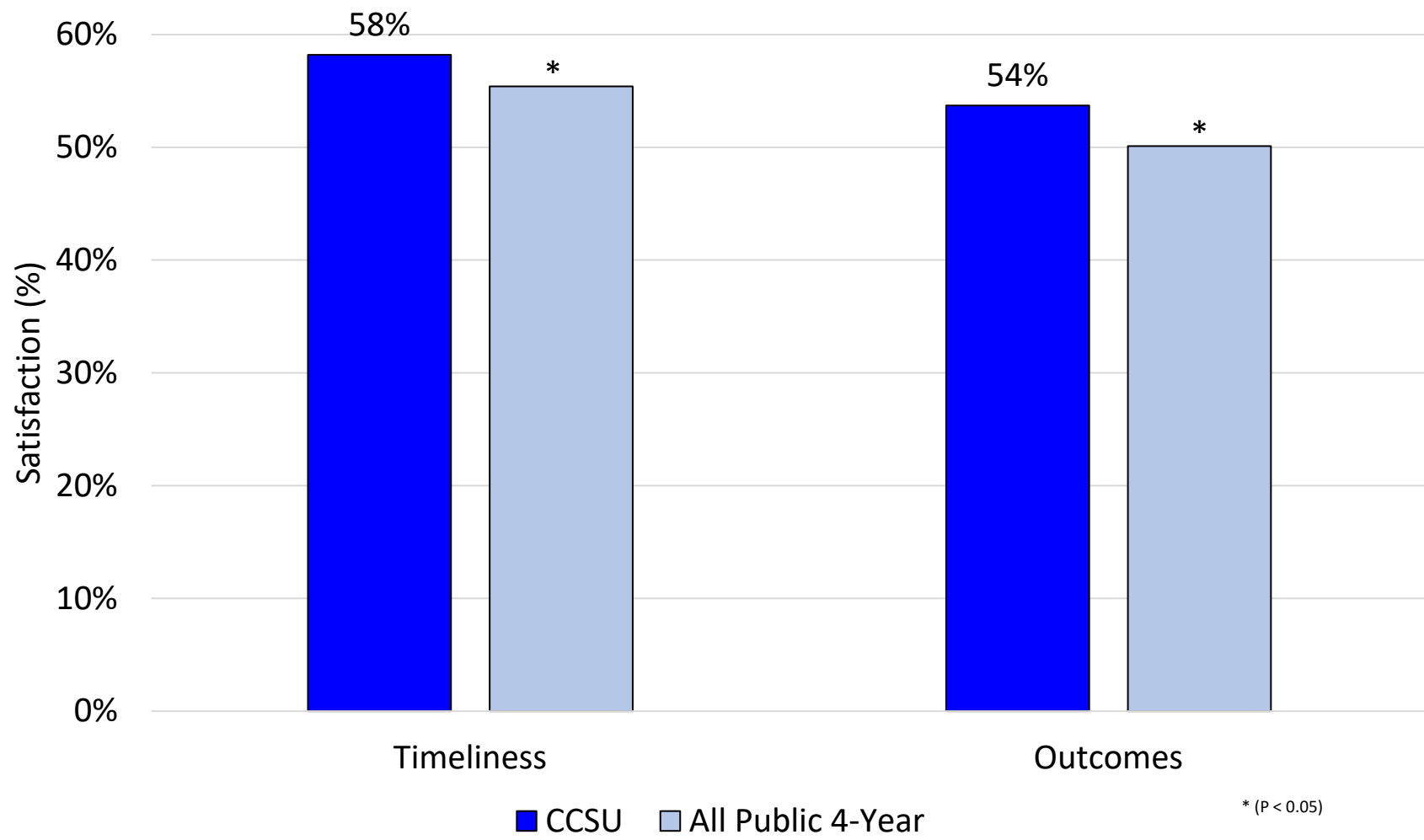
Do Students Work for Pay? (1+ hours/week)



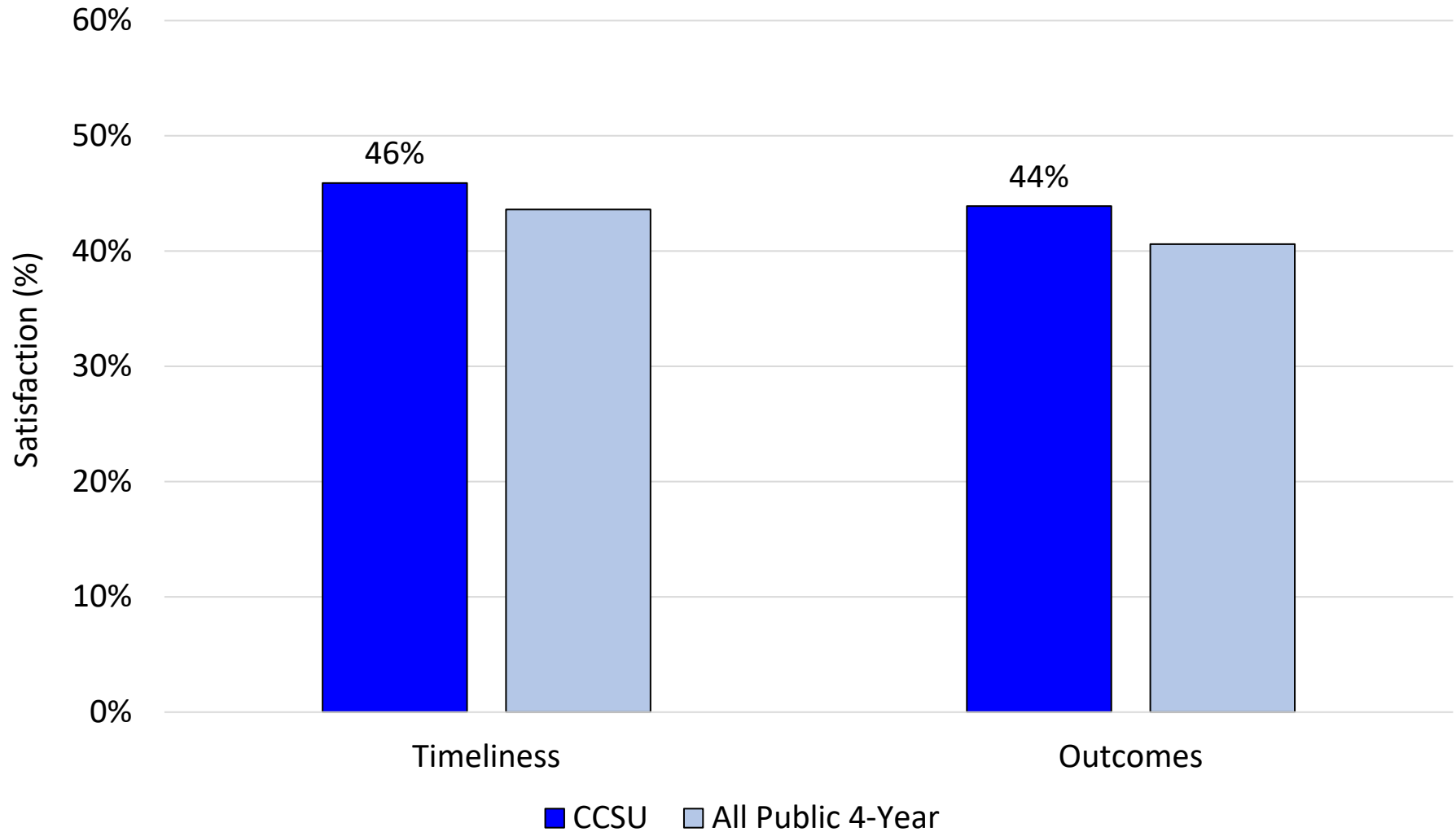
CCSU Students who Worked > 10 Hours Per Week



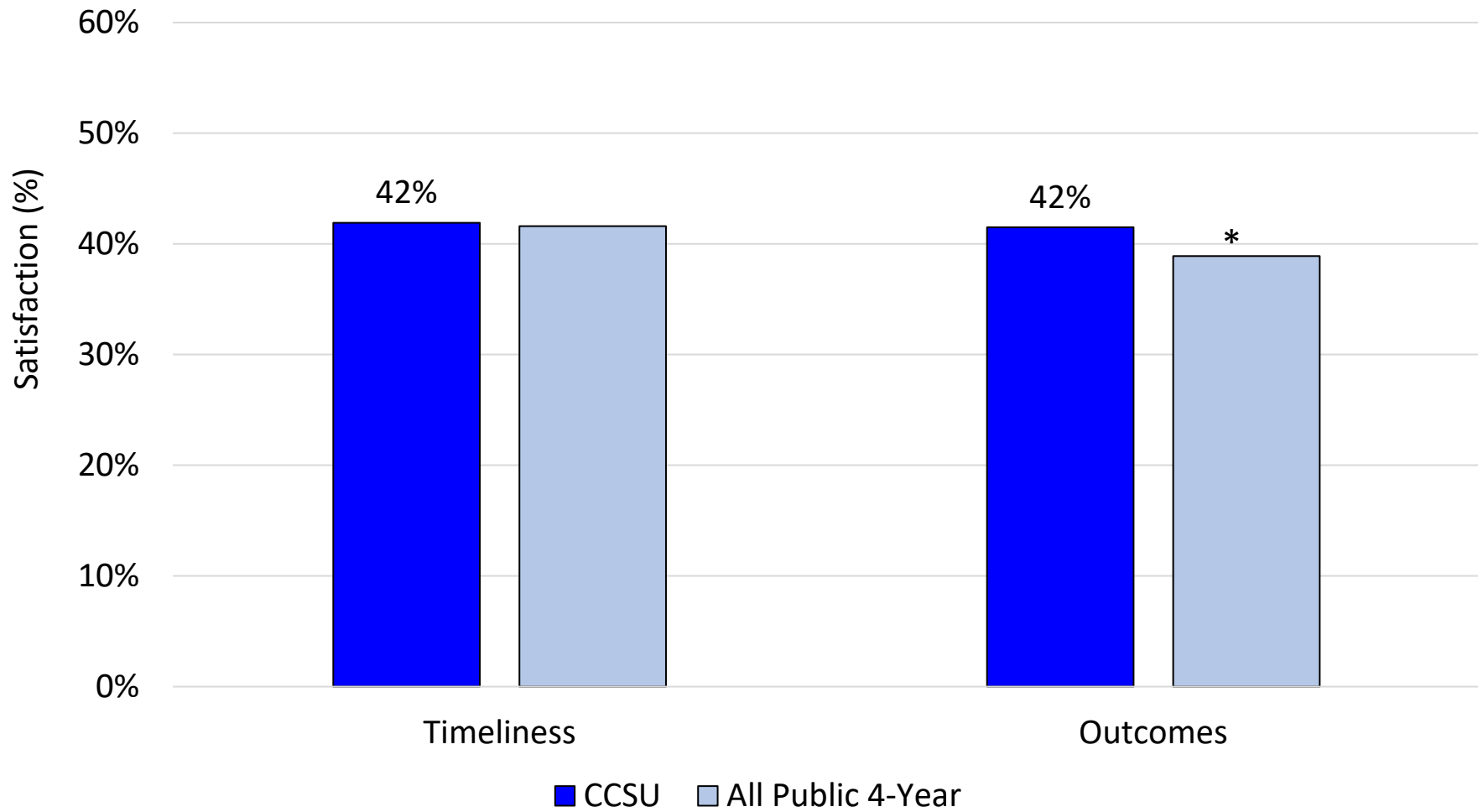
Administrative Response to Campus Emergencies: (Very Satisfied/Satisfied)



Administrative Response to Incidents of Sexual Assault: (Very Satisfied/Satisfied)



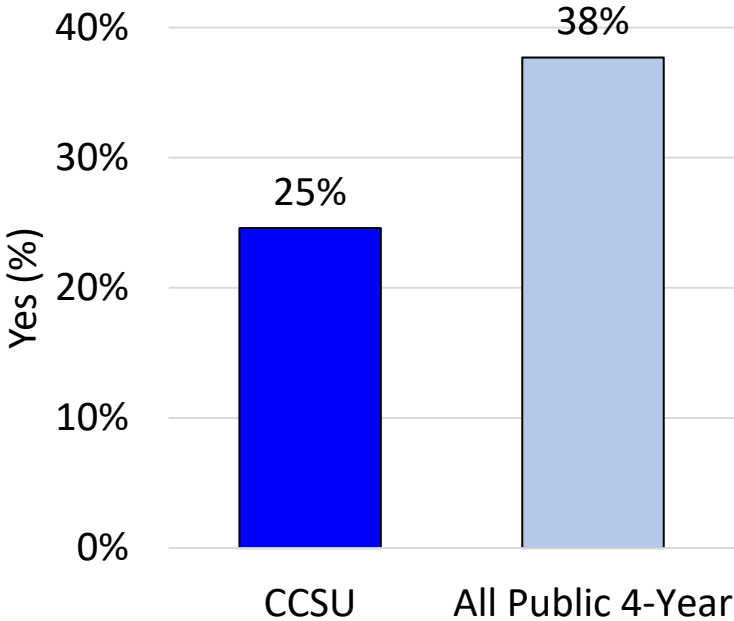

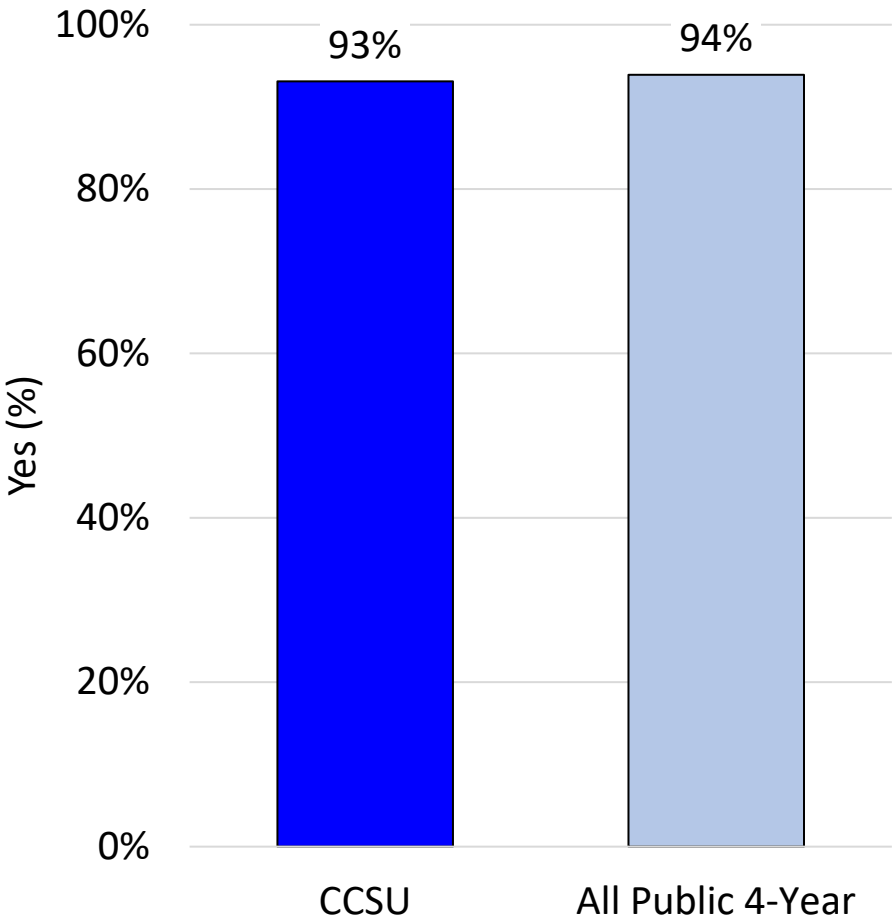

Students Who Don't Speak English at Home

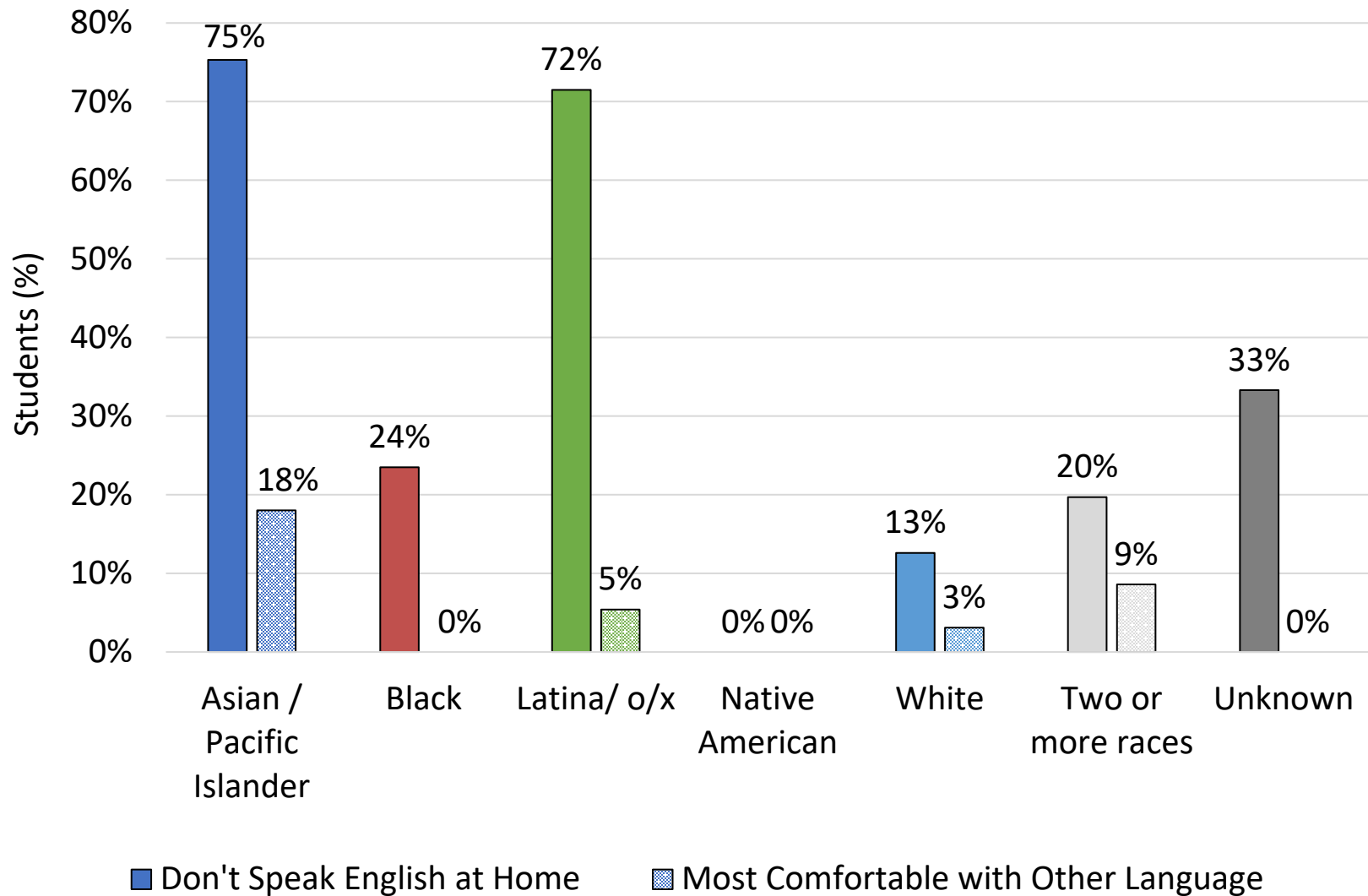

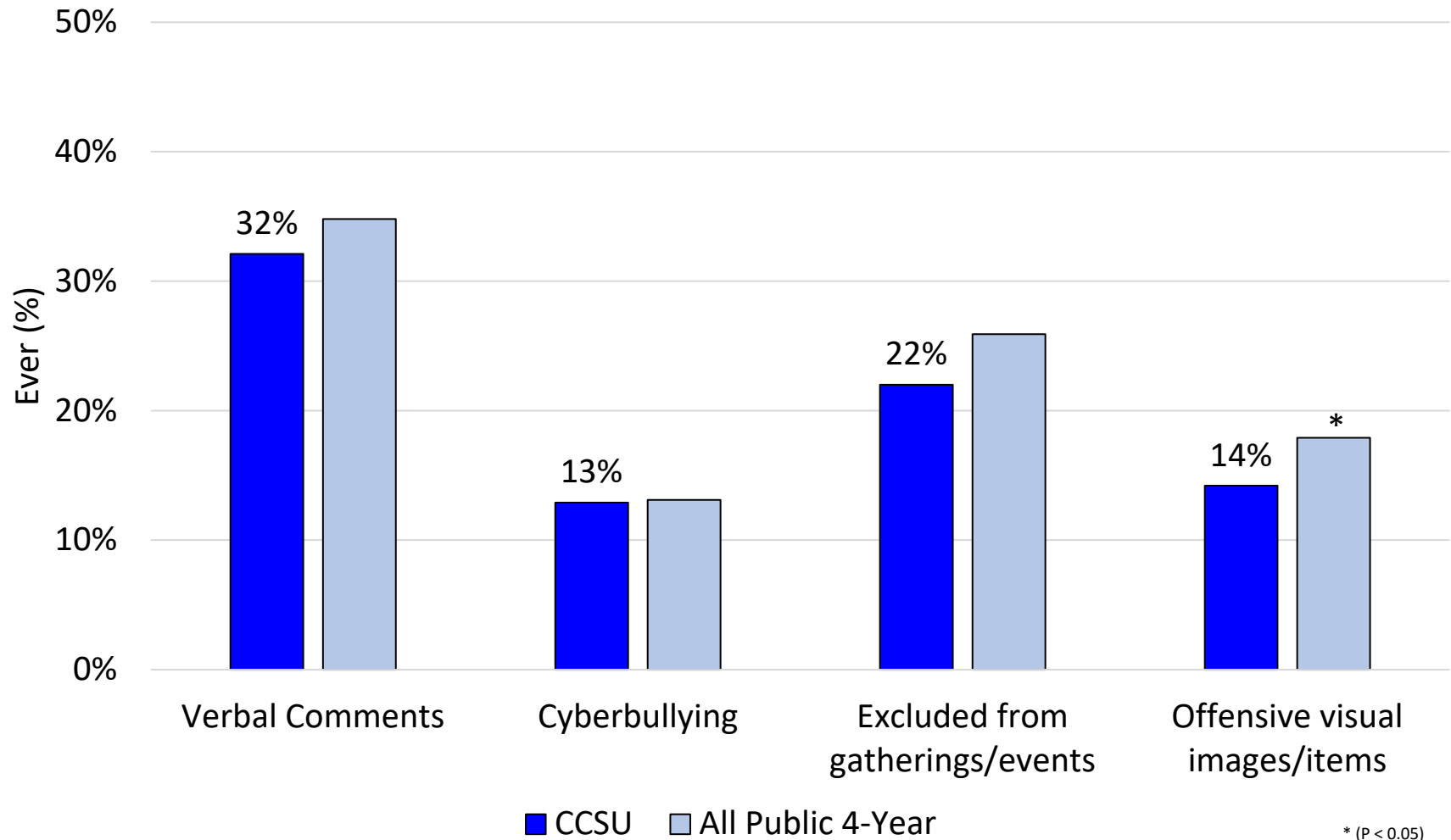

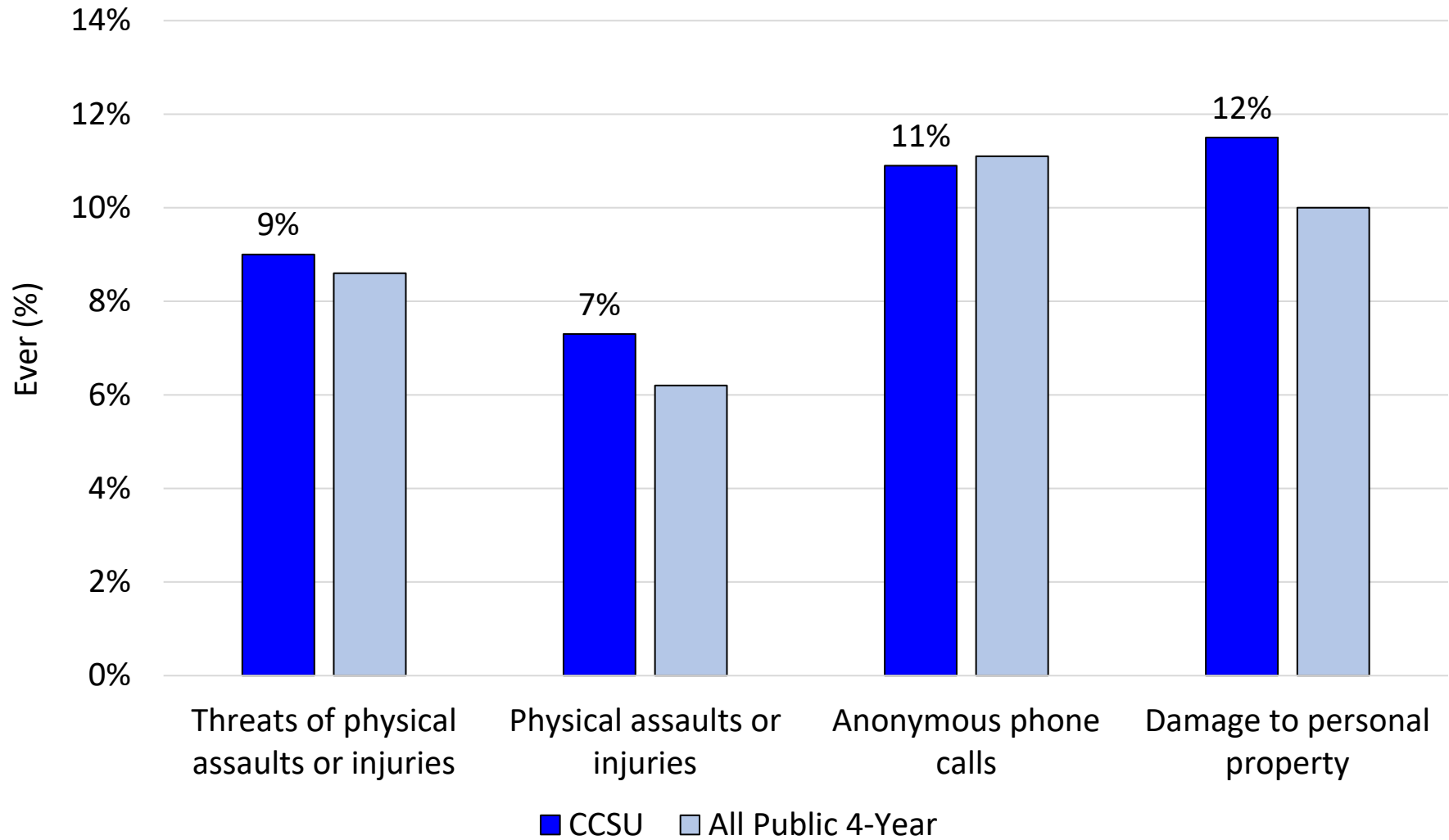

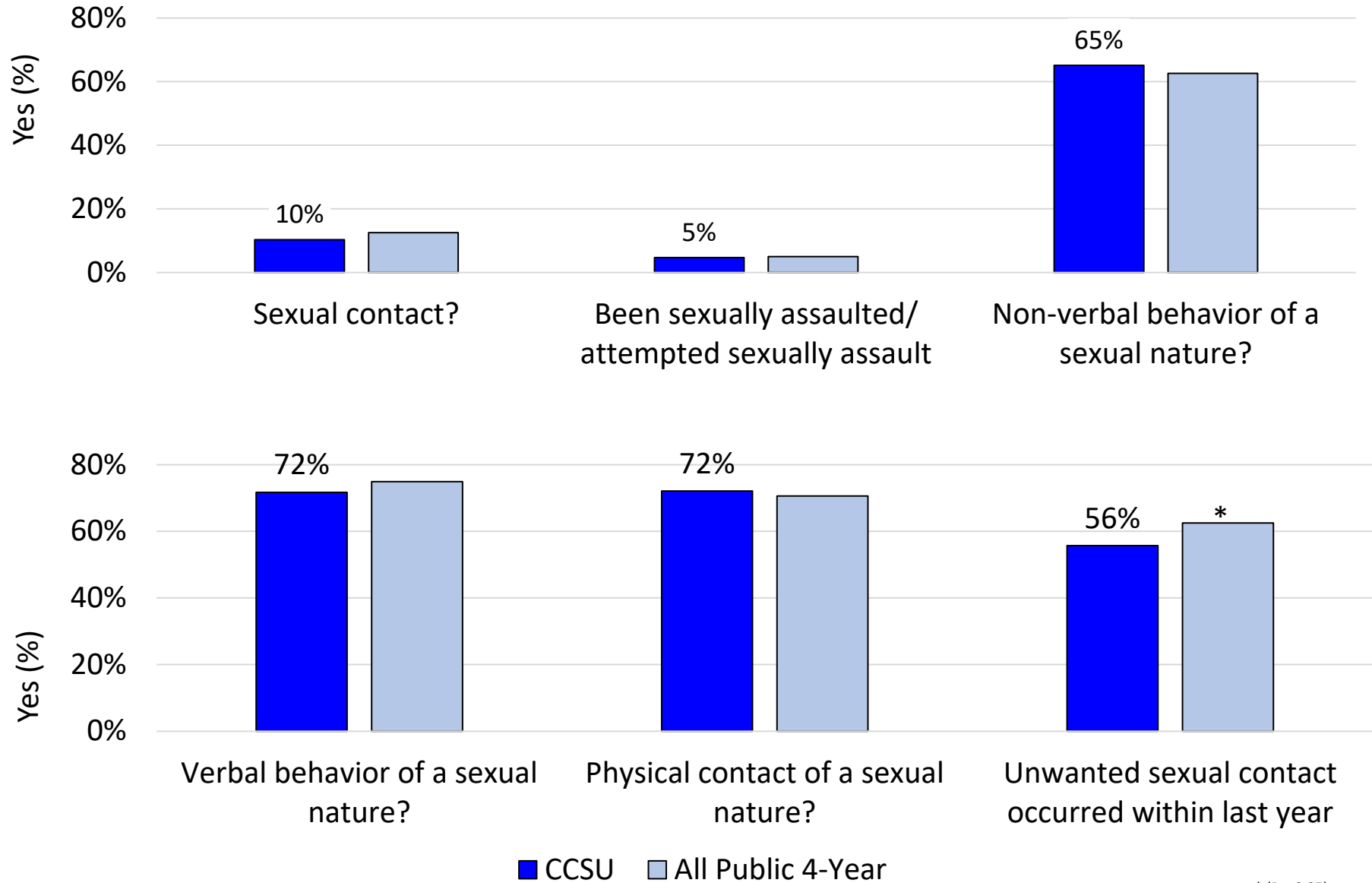

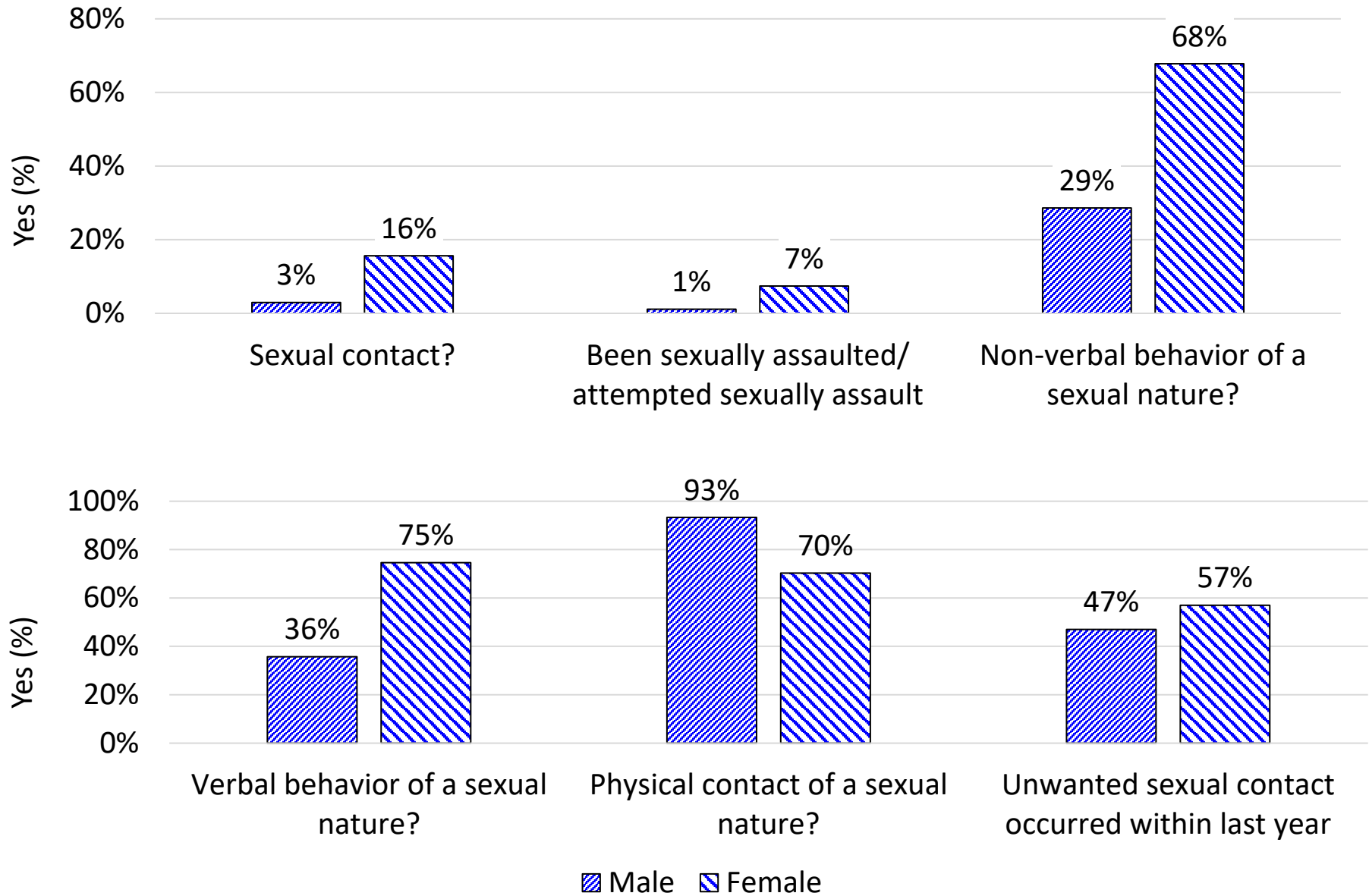

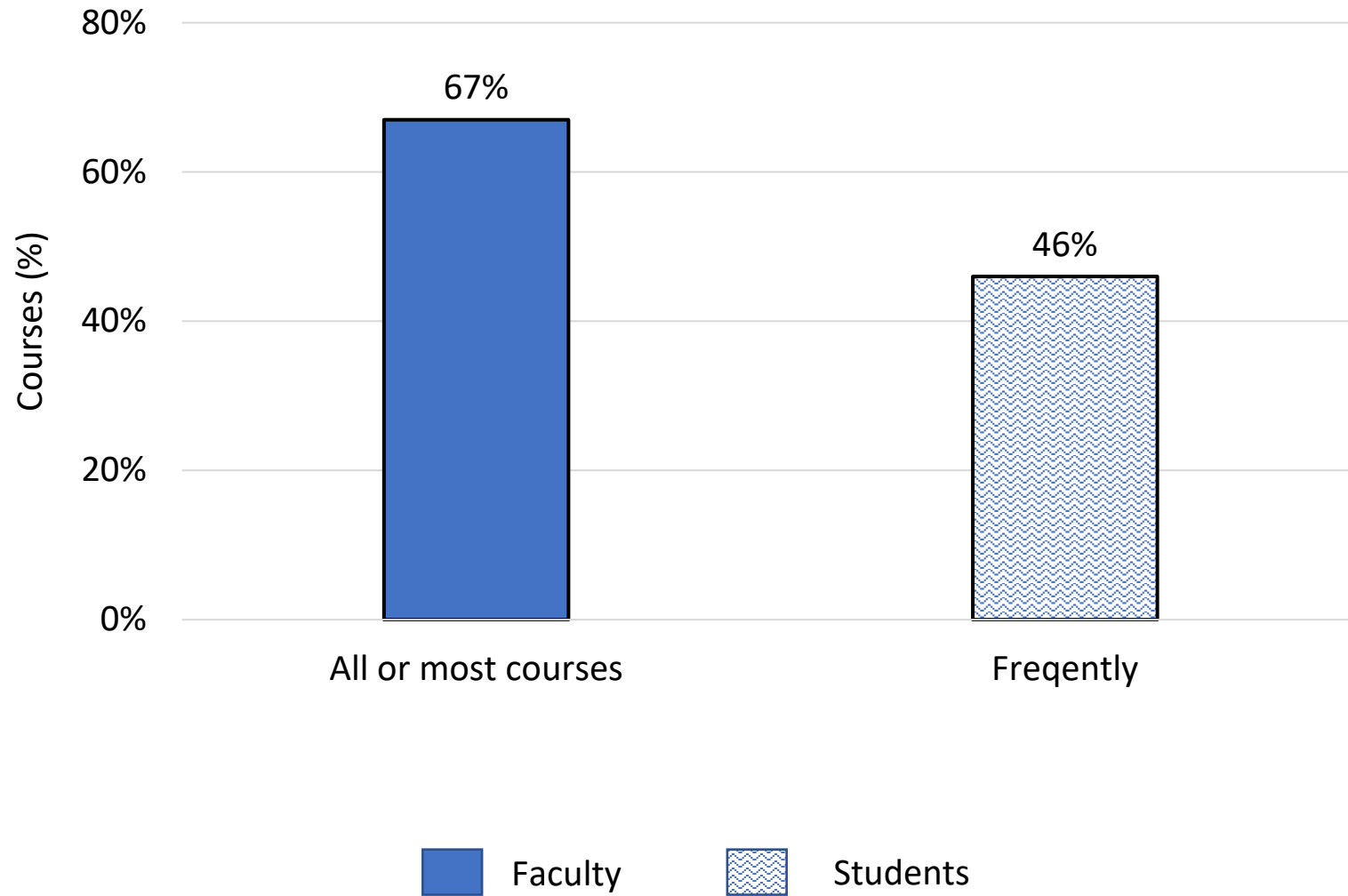

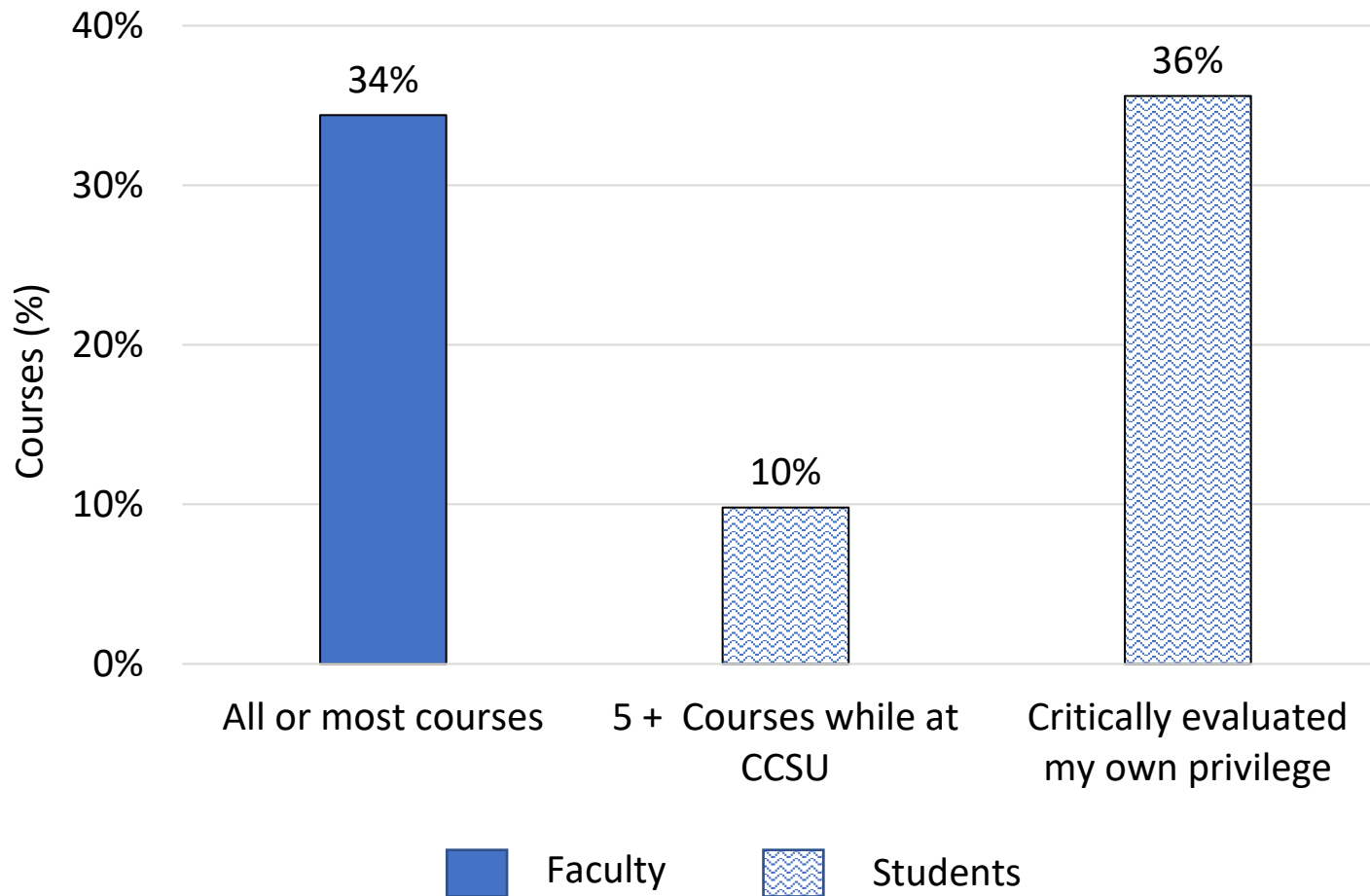

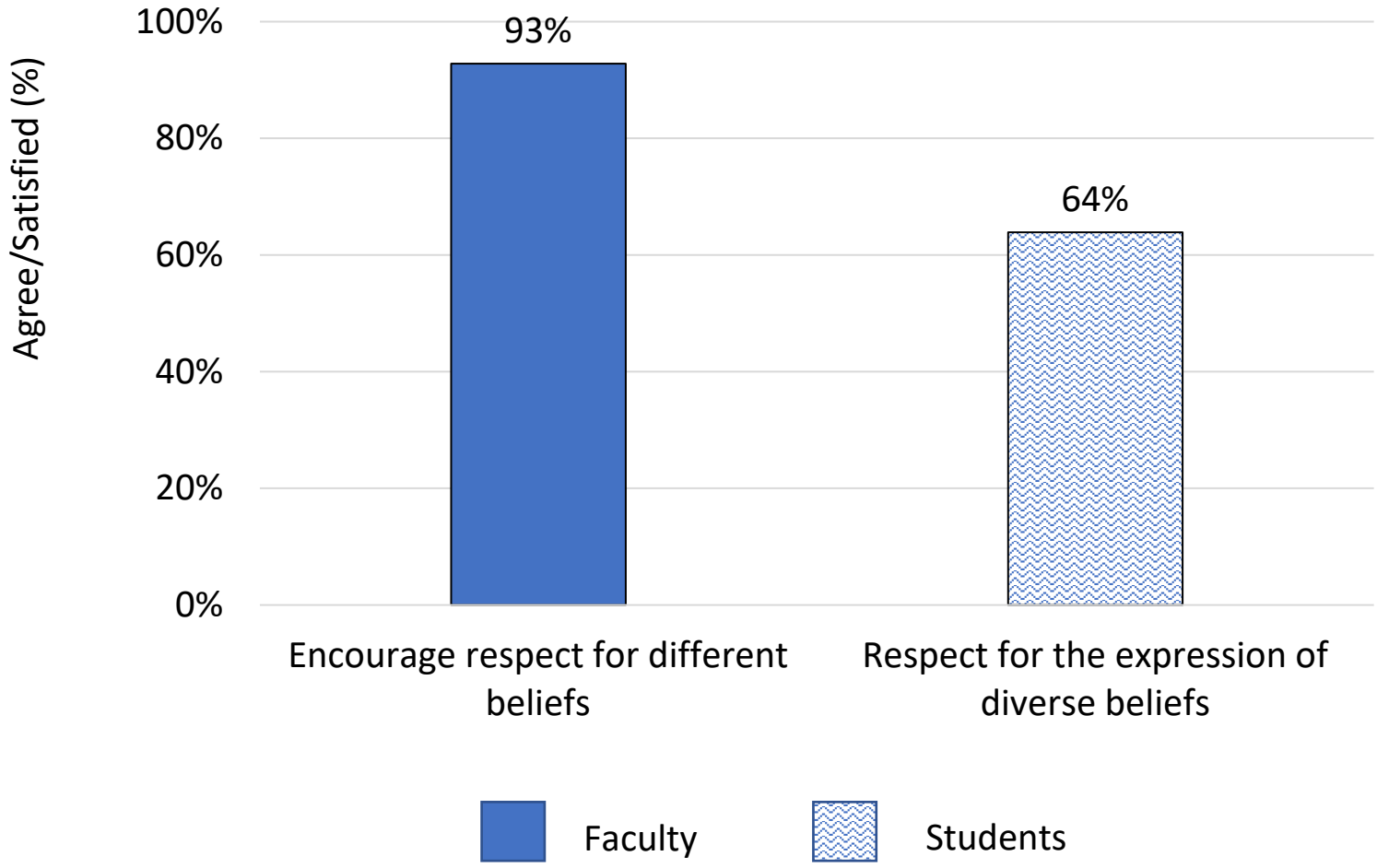

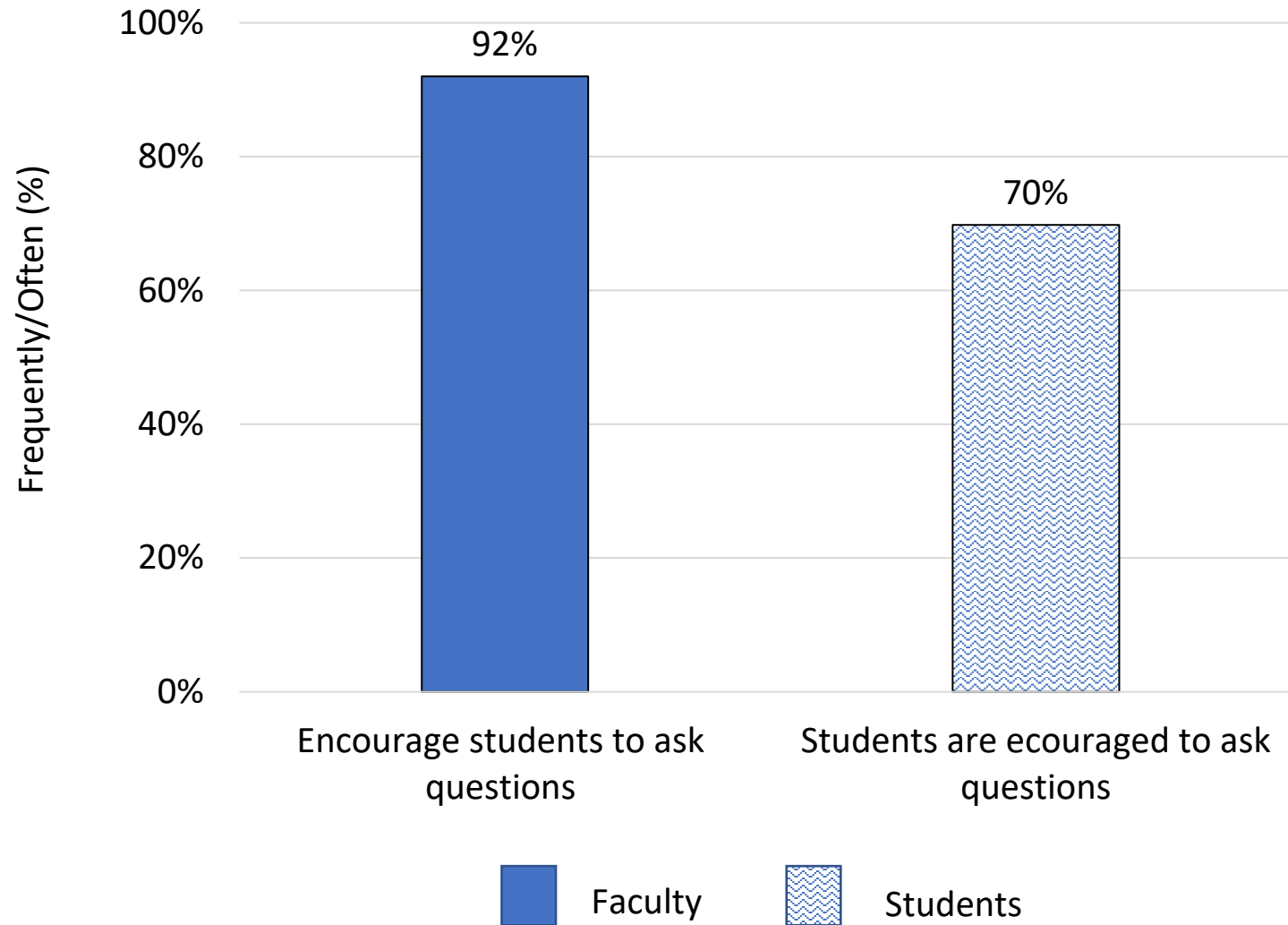

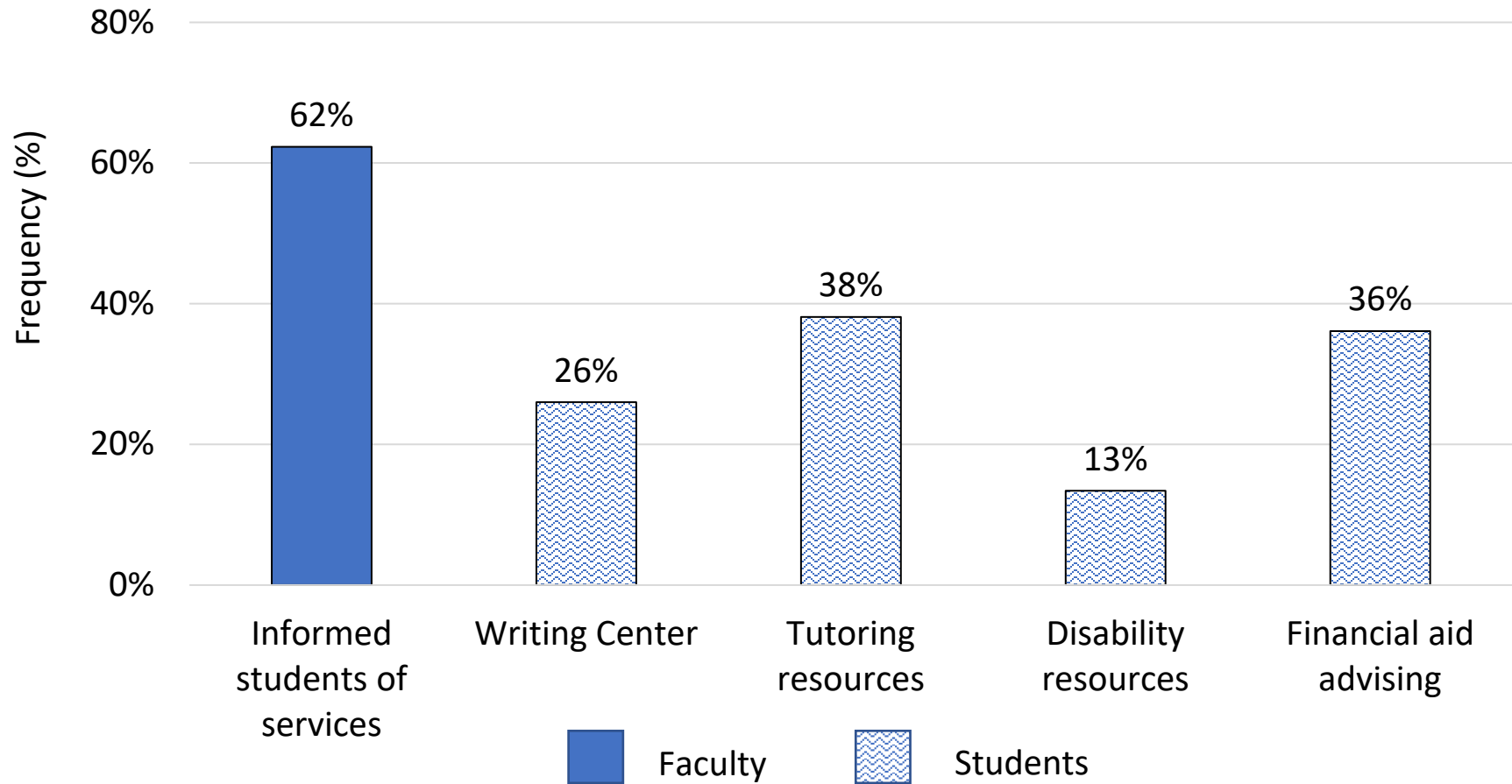
Faculty Agreement it is Their Role to Encourage Respect vs Student Satisfaction with Respect for Different Beliefs at CCSU



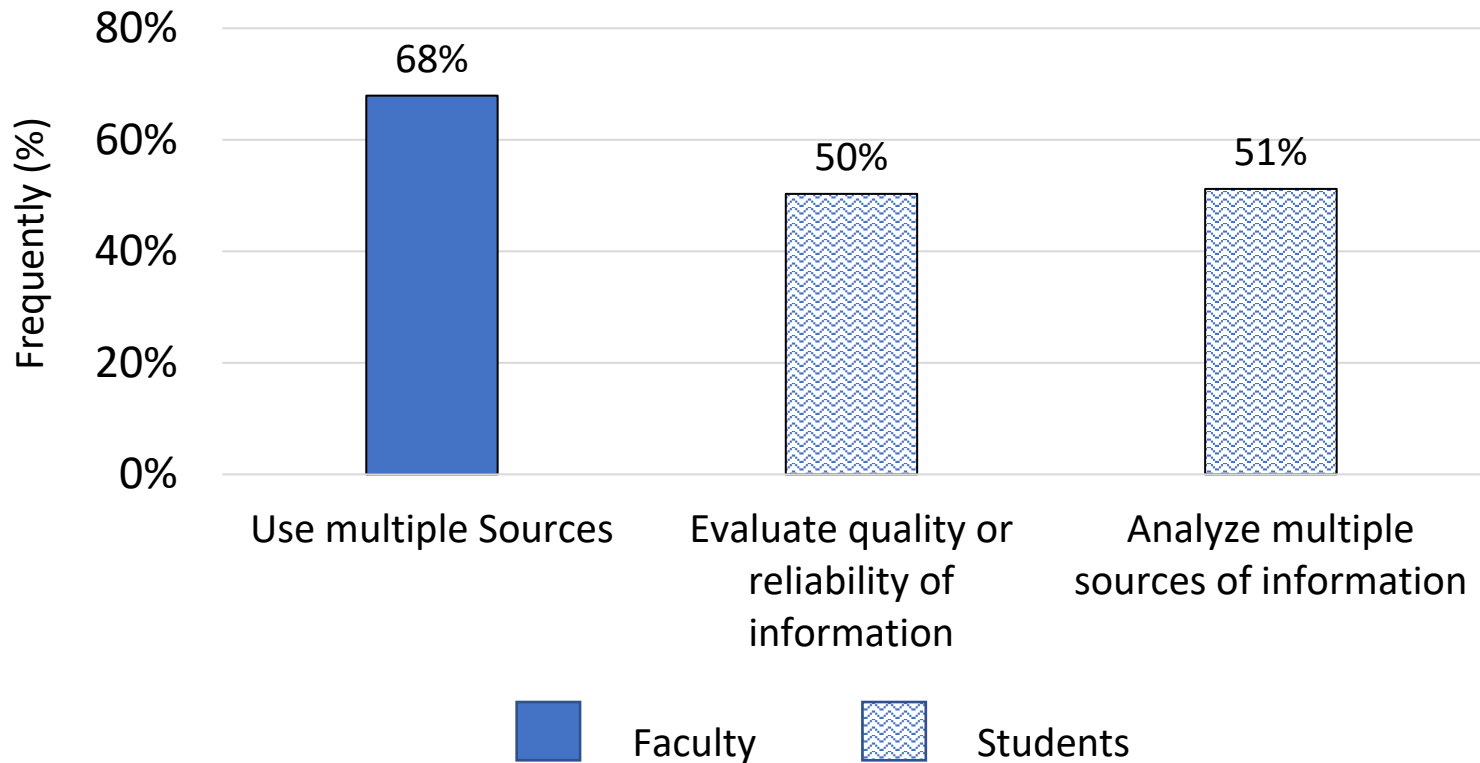
Perception of Faculty & Students with respect to Encouragement for Students to Ask Questions in Class



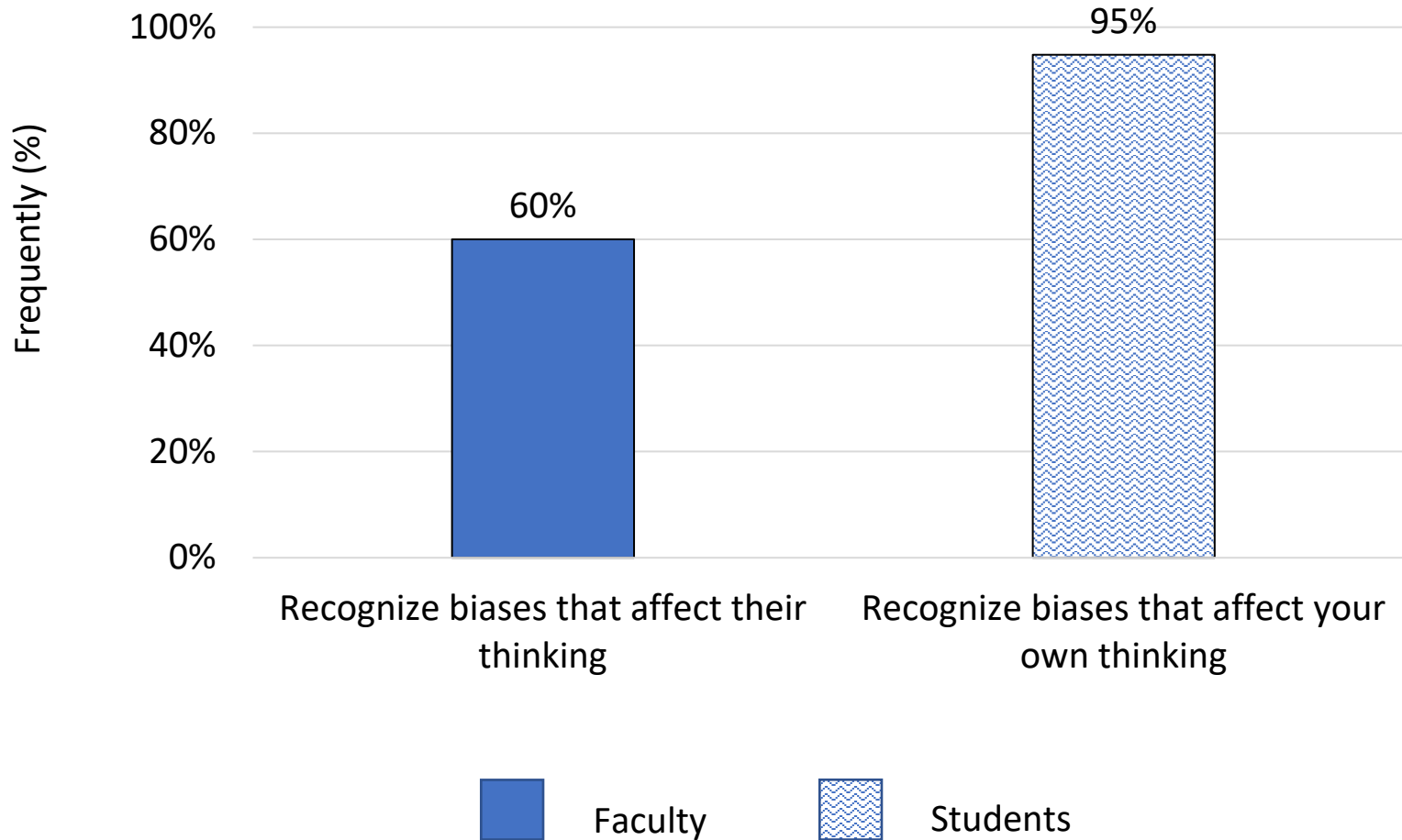

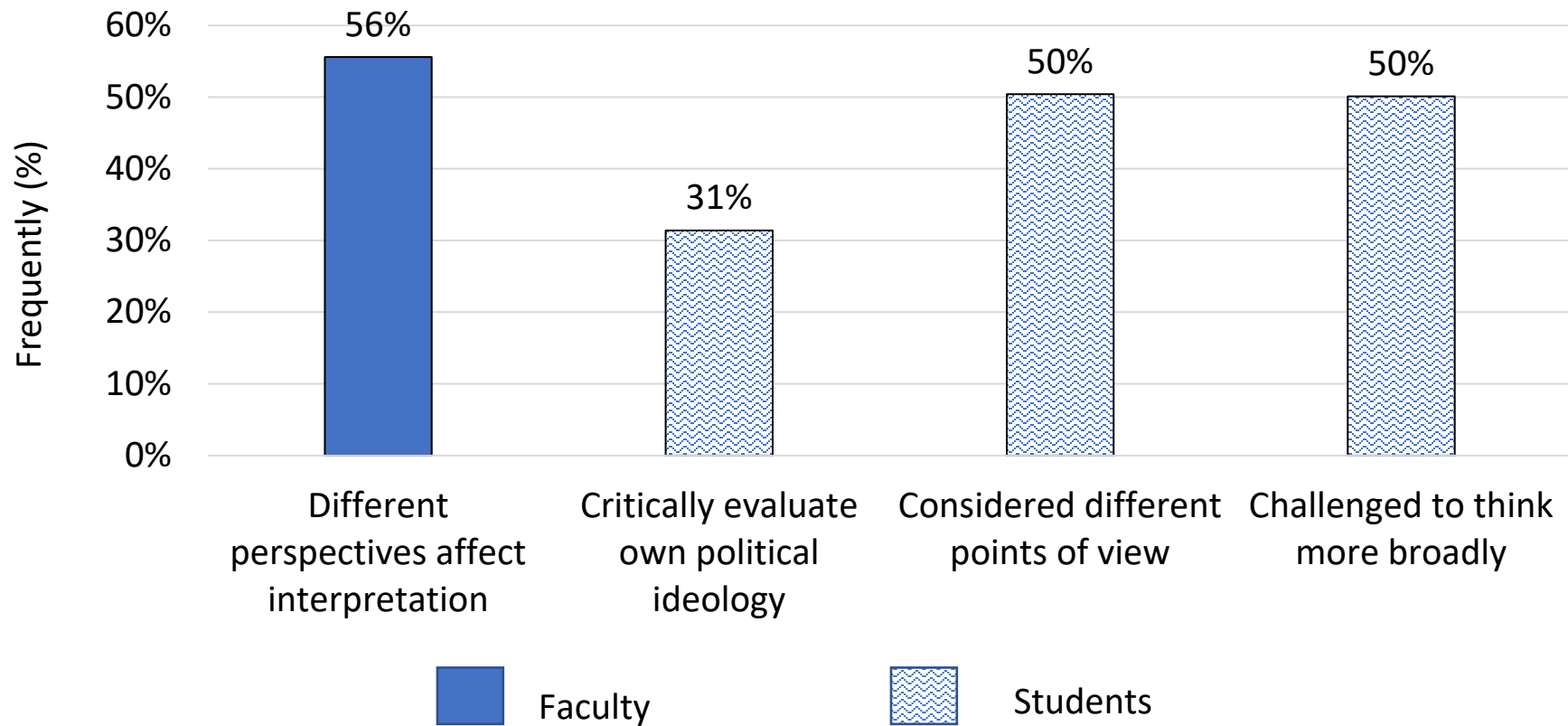
In the Past Year: Faculty Encouragement of Students to Analyze Multiple Sources of Information vs Student Assessment of Information (Frequently)



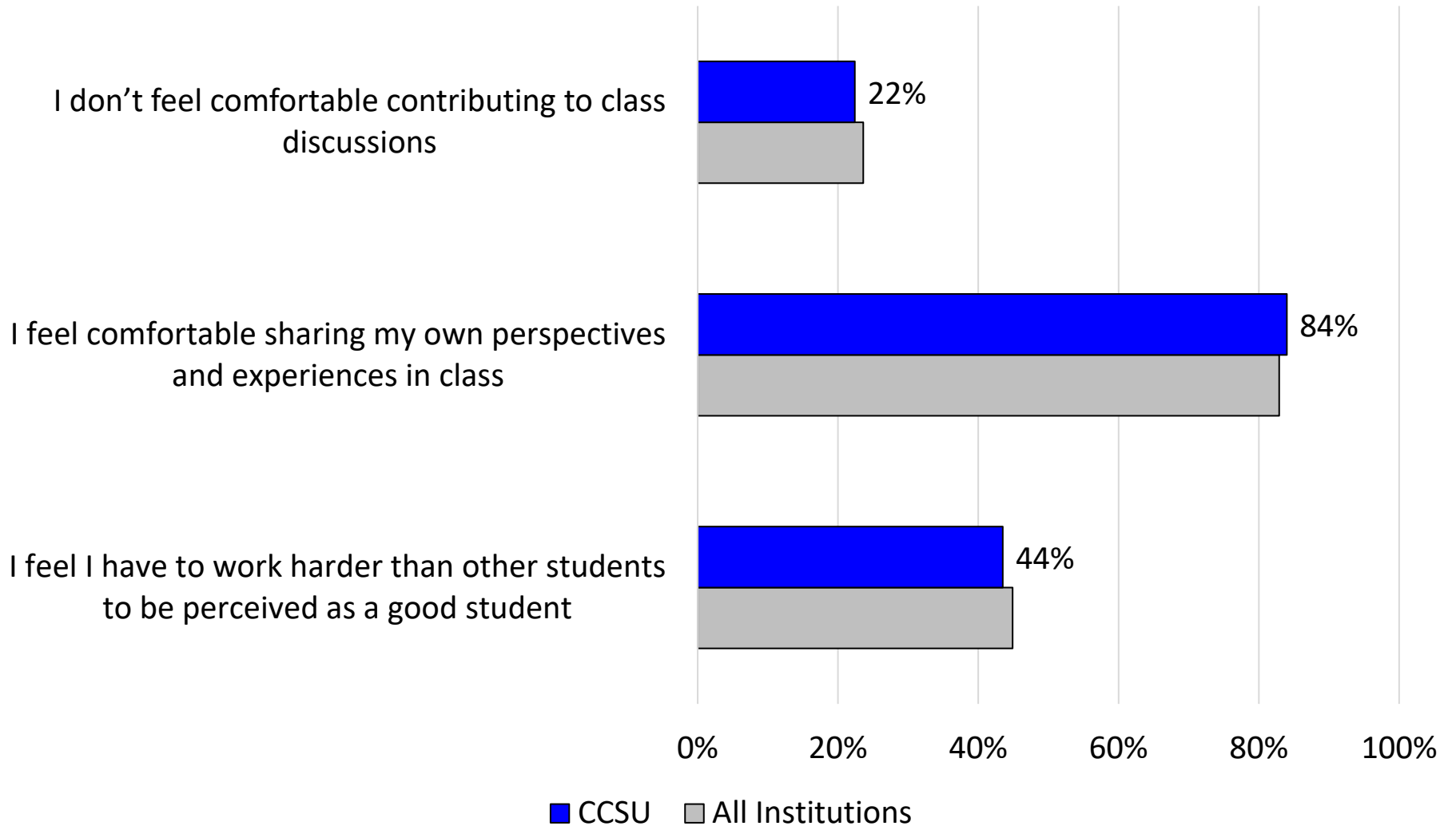

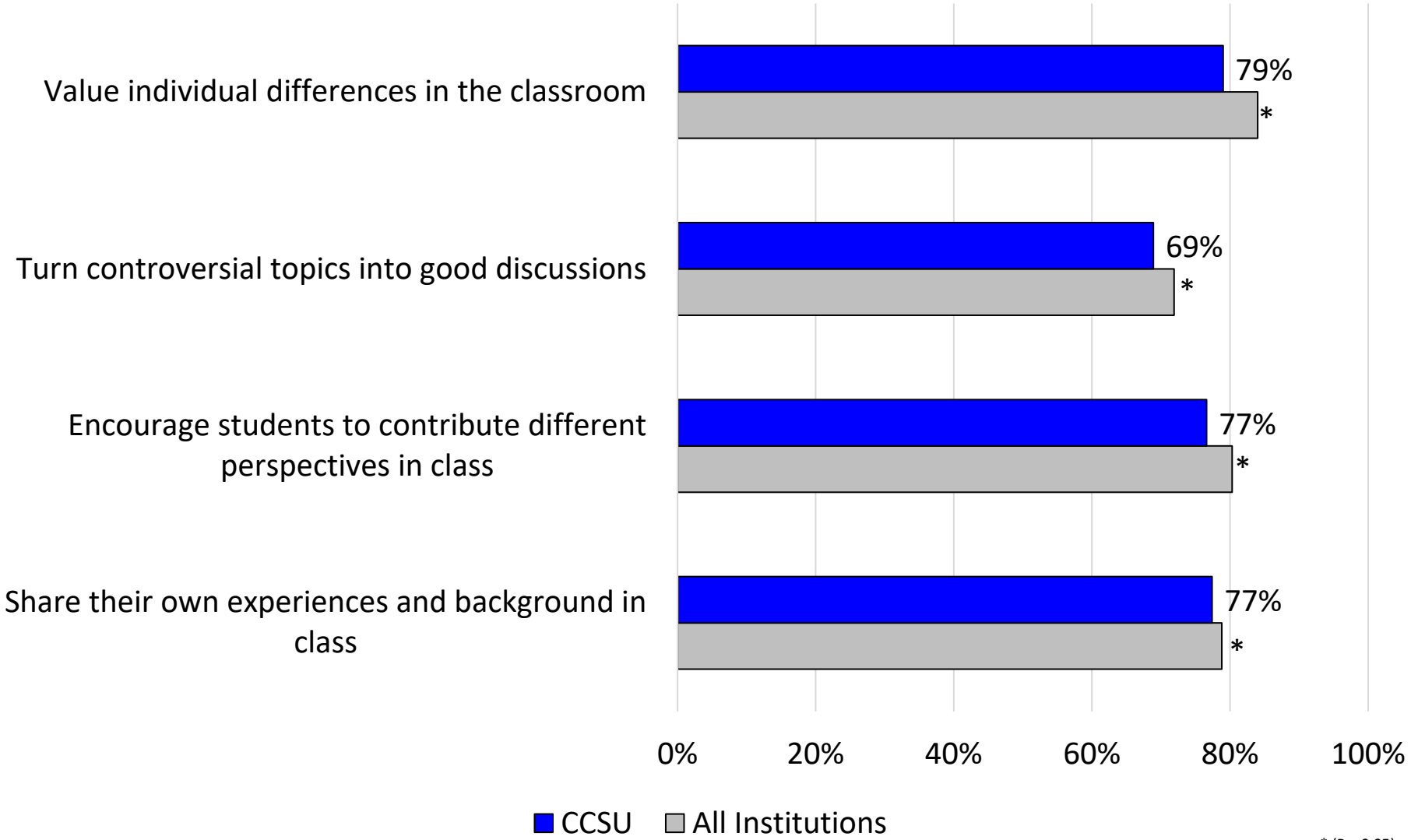

Full-time Student Agreement about Their Experiences in the Classroom (Strongly Agree/Agree)

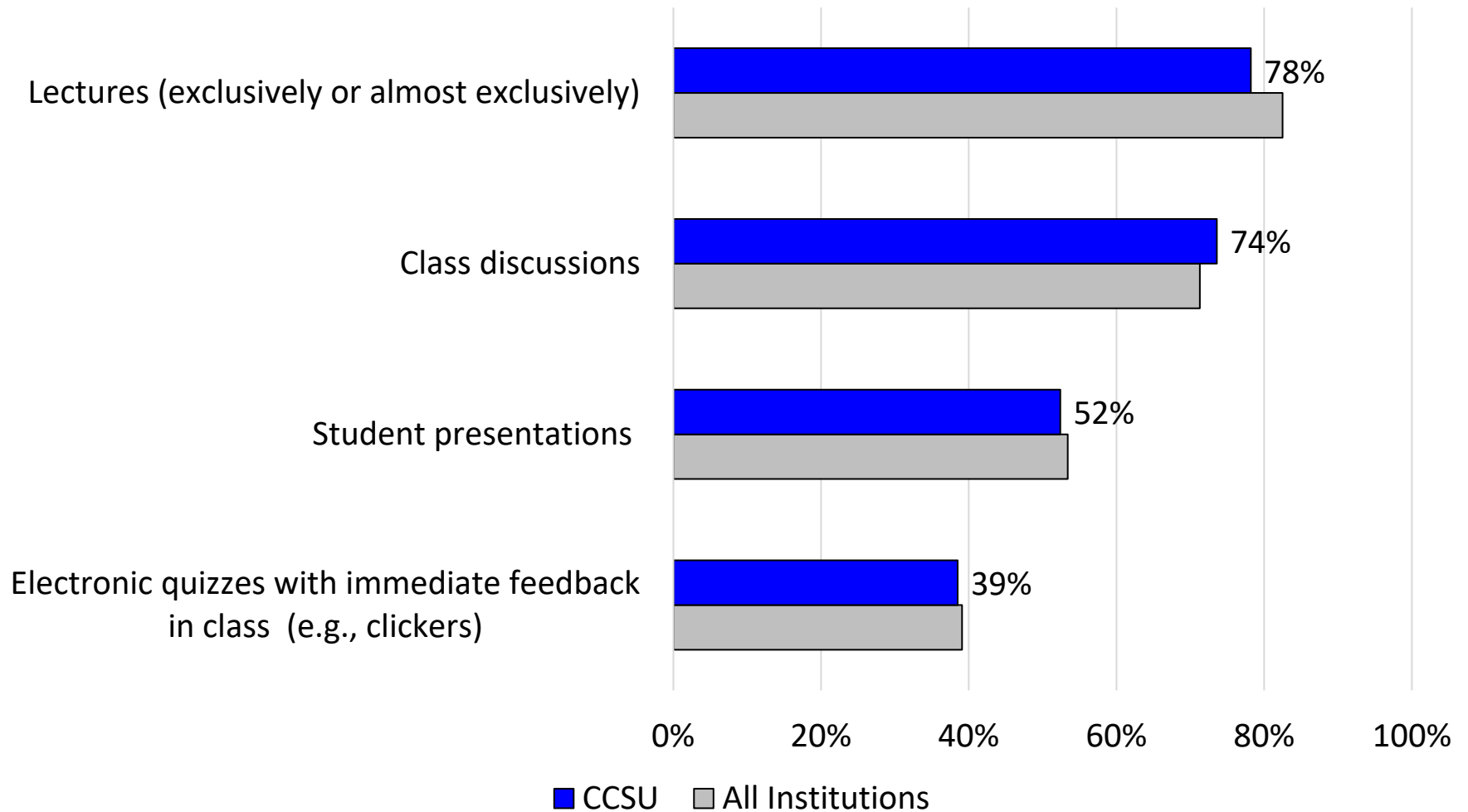


Full-time Students Say how Many Instructors at this Institution: (All/Most, but not All)

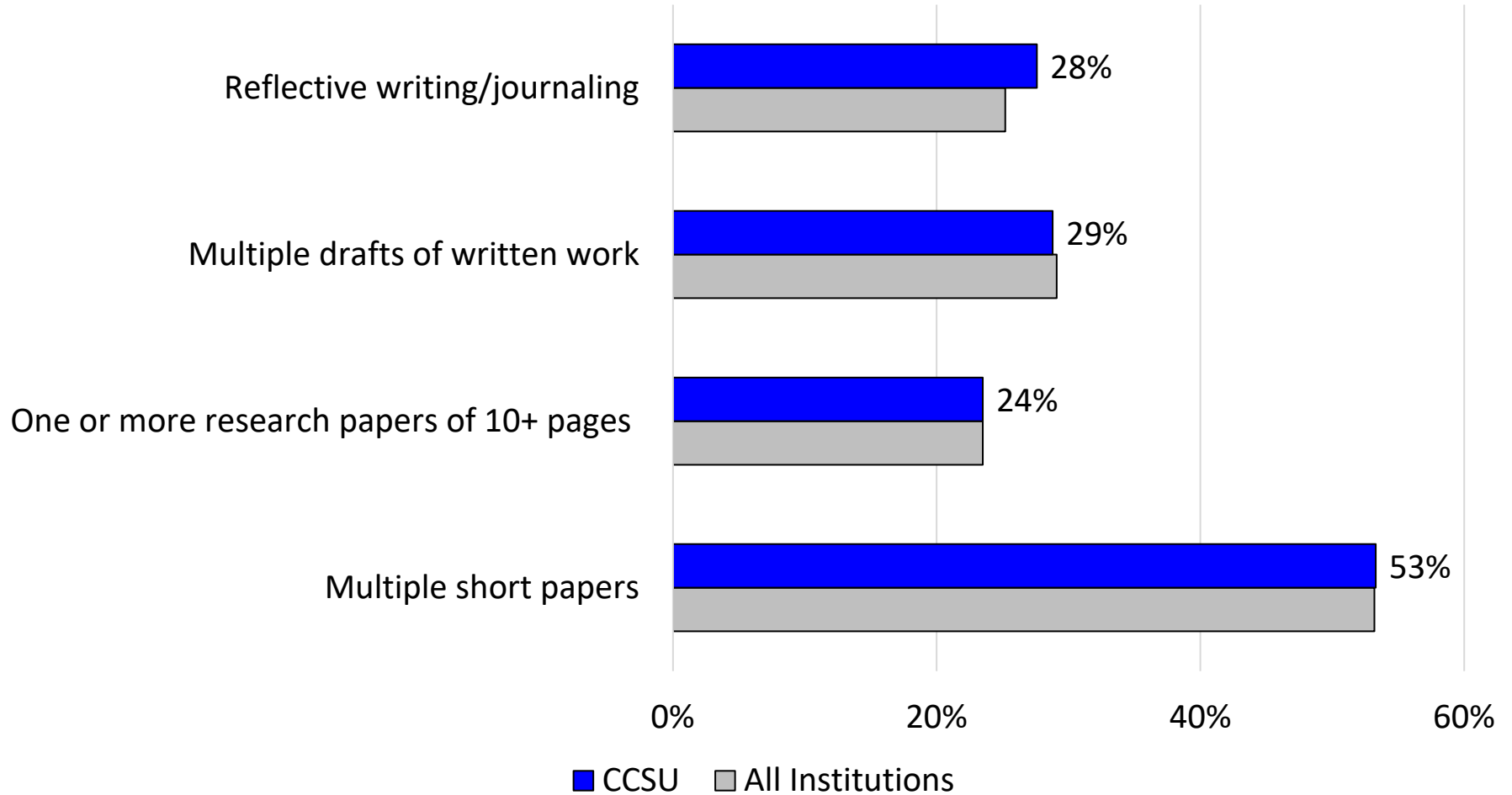

Key Takeaways

Highlights:

- ✓ CCSU students are more satisfied with campus response to
 - Campus emergencies
 - Incidences of sexual assault
 - Incidences of discrimination/bias
- ✓ CCSU students experience less discrimination than students at the comparison institutions
 - Race/ethnicity, age, gender identity, socioeconomic class
- ✓ CCSU students have witnessed fewer incidences of discrimination

Key Takeaways

Areas for Improvement

- ✓ Encourage students to make greater use of resources
 - Fewer CCSU students take advantage of the services offered
 - Faculty office hours
 - Student health and wellness
 - Advising
 - Career Counseling
 - Tutoring
 - Increase CCSU student confidence about their mathematical aptitude
 - Encourage CCSU students to participate in study groups
- ✓ Improve communication about available resources regarding food insecurity

Key Takeaways

Areas for Improvement

- ✓ CCSU students miss more class due to personal reasons
 - Family responsibilities, work, difficulty getting to/from campus
- ✓ CCSU students contribute money to support their families while feeling less supported by their families
- ✓ More CCSU students think about transferring or dropping out
 - Didn't "fit in"
 - Lack of community among students
- ✓ More students work for pay than at comparison institutions (related to their desire to be very well-off financially?)
